Section III covers analysis of feedback obtained from teachers.

Section I: Students Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus

Feedback on design and review of syllabus was collected from 18 students of MSc, BSc (Hons) and PhD Programs of the department. Analysis of the feedback is presented in Table 1.



 - Impact of curriculum on developing entrepreneurial skills (5.55%)
 - Co-Curricular and extra curricular activities (11.1%)

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

1. Students Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus

Feedback on design and review of syllabus was collected from 66 students of B. Tech. & M.Sc. Programs of the department. Analysis of the feedback is presented in table 1.

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
Student Feedback



- Quality of Content: 41 percent of students stated that the quality of content is excellent and 33 percent describes it very good respectively. Where, 26 percent describes it is good, Overall students were satisfied with the quality of content.
- Coverage and delivery of the syllabus: In the context of coverage and delivery of the syllabus, it is found that 47 percent respond to it as excellent, 30 students found it very good and 21 percent good and 1 percent satisfactory respectively. While not even a single student recommended improvement in the coverage and delivery of the syllabus. Overall students were satisfied with the coverage and delivery of the syllabus.
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 42 percent of students
 describes it as excellent whereas 32 per cent and 26 per cent of students described
 programme outcomes and learning outcomes as very good and good respectively, no student
 suggested for further improvements in this area.
- The curriculum enhances learning.: The majority (38 per cent) of students stated that curriculum enhances learning. Overall students were satisfied with the curriculum.
- The curriculum is relevant for employability: 33 per cent students regarded that the
 curriculum is excellent for students for gaining employability and, 37 per cent of students
 found it as very good and 26 per cent of students stated it as good. Overall students were
 fulfilled.
- Impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills: 39 percent students found the
 curriculum is excellent where, 35 per cent of students described the curriculum as very good
 for developing analytical skills among the students, whereas, 21 per cent described as good.
 No student recommended need for improvement in the curriculum. Overall the students were
 appeased with the curriculum on developing analytical skills.
- Impact of curriculum on developing industrial oriented skills: 29 per cent of students claimed
 the curriculum is excellent for developing entrepreneurial skills among the students and, 36
 percent describes as very good and 36 per cent described it as good and 4 per cent as
 satisfactory.







- Impact of curriculum on developing entrepreneurial skills: 41 per cent of students claimed the curriculum is excellent for developing entrepreneurial skills among the students and, 23 per cent described it as very good,27 as good and 9 per cent as satisfactory.
- Impact of curriculum on the holistic development of students: Majority of students with 33 per cent marked curriculum for the holistic development of students as excellent, whereas.
 26 per cent claimed it as very good and 31 percent as good respectively.
- Co-Curricular and extracurricular activities: In the context of co-curricular and extracurricular 23 percent of students describes as excellent. And, 32 per cent students stated it as very good and 39 percent describes as good. 6 percent were satisfied.


2. Alumni's Feedback on University

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Overall Analysis of Alumni's Feedback


The response of the alumini with regard to design and review of syllabus has been found to be excellent and very good in most of the cases, few points like curriculum is relevant to employability, impact of developing industrial oriented skills, and impact of curriculum in developing entrepreneurial skills and Cocurricular and extra curricular activities have been graded to be satisfactory by few alumni.

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
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Overall Analysis of Teacher's Feedback for BSc (Hons) and MSc Curriculum

1. Students Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus



- Quality of Content: 42% percent of students stated that the quality of content is excellent and very good respectively. Where 27% percent describes it is good and 2% percent described it as satisfactory and 4% students suggested for further improvement in this area. Overall students were satisfied with the quality of content.
- Coverage and delivery of the syllabus: In the context of coverage and delivery of the syllabus. It is found that 35% percent of students stated that the coverage and delivery of the syllabus is excellent and very good respectively. Where 35% percent describes it is good and 4% percent described it as satisfactory and 7% students suggested for further improvement in this area. Overall students were satisfied with the quality of content
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 33% percent of students stated that the appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcome is excellent and very good respectively. Where 38% percent describes it is good and 9% percent described it as satisfactory while not even a single student recommended improvement in the coverage and delivery of the syllabus.
- The curriculum enhances learning: 29% percent of students stated that the curriculum enhances learning is excellent and very good respectively. Where 31% percent describes it is good and 16% percent described it as satisfactory while 2% students suggested for further improvement in this area.
- The curriculum is relevant for employability: 36% percent of students stated that the curriculum is relevant for employability is excellent and very good respectively. Where 35% percent describes it is good and 7% percent described it as satisfactory while 7% students suggested for further improvement in this area.
- Impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills: 24% percent of students stated that the impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills is excellent and very good respectively. Where 3,5% percent

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describes it is good and 15% percent described it as satisfactory while 5% students suggested for further improvement in this area.

Where 31% percent describes it is good and 20% percent described it as satisfactory while 15% students suggested for further improvement in this area.

Where 36% percent describes it is good and 9% percent described it as satisfactory while 16% students suggested for further improvement in this area.

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

Overall alumni were satisfied with the quality of content.
- Coverage and delivery of the syllabus: In the context of coverage and delivery of the syllabus. It is found that 54% percent of alumni stated that syllabus is excellent and very good respectively. Where 15 % percent describes it is good and 8% percent described it as satisfactory while not even a single alumni recommended improvement in the coverage.
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 54% percent of alumni stated that the appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcome is excellent and very good respectively. Where 8% percent describes it is good. While not even a single recommended to satisfactory and 15% alumni suggested for further improvement in this area.

It is found that 71.4% percent of teacher stated that syllabus is excellent and very good respectively. Where 14.3 % percent describes it is good While not even a single recommended to satisfactory and needs no improvement in this area.
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 42.9% percent of teacher started that the appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcome is excellent and recergood

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respectively. Where 42.9% percent describes it is good. While not even a single recommended to satisfactory and needs no improvement in this area.

- The curriculum enhances learning: 71.4% percent of teacher stated that the curriculum enhances learning is excellent and very good respectively. Where 14.3% percent describes it is good. While not even a single recommended to satisfactory and needs no improvement in this area.
- The curriculum is relevant for employability: 71.4% percent of teacher stated that the curriculum enhances learning is excellent and very good respectively. Where 14.3% percent describes it is good. While not even a single recommended to satisfactory and 7% recommended improvement in this area.
- Impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills: 57.1% percent of teacher stated that the impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills is excellent and very good respectively. Where 28.6% percent describes it is good, while not even a single recommended to satisfactory and needs no improvement in this area.

Where 57.1% percent describes it is good while not even a single recommended to satisfactory and needs no improvement in this area.
- Co-Curricular and extracurricular activities: 57% percent of teacher stated that the Co-Curricular and extracurricular activities is excellent and very good respectively. Where 14.3% percent describes it is good and 14.3% percent described it as satisfactory while 14.3% teacher suggested for further improvement in this area.

4. Conclusion:

The feedback indicates that syllabus is more than 90% satisfactory and above in ranking except for Impact of curriculum on developing industrial oriented skills as per both students & Alumni feedback. Need for improvement is also felt by nearly 15% students for Impact of curriculum on holistic development of students & Co-Curricular and extra-curricular activities. The 2 out 13 (15%) Alumni also felt need for improvement in Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes & Quality of Content. All the 7 teachers are atleast satisfactory with all the parameter except 1 teacher felt the need for improvement Co-Curricular and extra-curricular activities. It is recommended to take up the mentioned issues/findings in the next meeting of BoS Civil Engineering for further necessary actions.

Section 3 explains the analysis of feedback obtained from alumni. Section 4 covers analysis of feedback obtained from teachers and Section 5 presents the analysis of feedback obtained from industry experts who are potential employers.

1. Students Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus

Feedback on design and review of syllabus was collected from 19 students of MBA, BBA and PhD Programs of the department. Analysis of the feedback is presented in table 1.

Feedback on design and review of syllabus was collected from alumni students of BBA, MBA and PhD programs of the department. Analysis of the feedback is presented in Table 1.



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2. Student Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus B.Tech. CSE



- Coverage and delivery of the syllabus: In the context of coverage and delivery of the syllabus, it is found that 52 percent respond to it as excellent & very good and 42 percent good & satisfactory. Only 7 percent suggested for further improvement.
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 45 percent of students described programme outcomes and learning outcomes as excellent and very good along with 52 percent students found outcomes to be good and satisfactory.
- Curriculum enhances learning: 52 percent students were of the view that curriculum
 is well designed and enhances learning along with 38 percent of the view that it is
 good and satisfies there learning skills. Just 10 percent thought the improvement can
 be done in this.
- Curriculum is relevant for employability: Majority (75 percent) students curriculum
 is relevant for gaining the employment.
- Impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills: 21 percent students considered
 that the curriculum is excellent for students for developing analytical skills and 31
 percent found it very good and 42 percent of students stated it as good and
 satisfactory.
- Impact of curriculum on developing industry-oriented skills: More than 41 percent
 of students described the curriculum as excellent or very good for developing
 industry oriented skills among the students whereas 7 percent recommended that
 there is a scope for improvement in curriculum.
- Impact of curriculum on developing entrepreneurial skills: 34 percent student claimed that curriculum is excellent for developing entrepreneurial skills among the students. 55percent described it as good and satisfactory.
- Impact of curriculum on holistic development of students: Majority (41 percent) of student marked curriculum for holistic development of students as excellent whereas 51 percent claimed it as good and satisfactory.
- Co-curricular and extracurricular activities: In the context of co-curricular and extracurricular activities 42 percent found it to be excellent and 48 percent considered it to be good and satisfactory, 10 percent asked for improvement.

2. Teachers' Feedback on Design and Review of Syllabus

Feedback faculty members of the department have been obtained regarding design and review of syllabus of three programs offered by the institute, namely B-Arch, M-Arch and M-Planning. Feedback was collected from 9 faculty members for B-Arch, 5 for M-Arch, 4 for M- Planning. Course wise analysis of the feedback is presented in tables 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3.

- Quality of content: 33.3 percent of teachers stated that quality of content is excellent and 44.4 percent state that it is very good where 22.2 percent stated that it is satisfactory.
- Coverage and delivery of syllabus: The coverage and delivery of syllabus are found as 33.3 percent excellent, 55.6 percent of teachers recommended very good in the Coverage and delivery of syllabus. Overall teachers were satisfied.
- Appropriateness of programme outcomes and learning outcomes: 22.2 percent of teachers described program outcomes and learning outcomes as excellent where 77.8 percent teachers suggested it as very good in this area.
- Curriculum enhances learning: Overall teachers were satisfied with the Curriculum for enhancing the learning abilities of students. As 88 percent stated it as very good.
- Curriculum is relevant for employability: The majority (66 percent) of teachers stated that curriculam is excellent for gaining the employability. Altogether the teachers were fully satisfied.
- Impact of curriculum on developing analytical skills: 66 percent teachers regarded
 the curriculum is very good for students for developing analytical skills and 34
 percent teachers stated it satisfactory.
- Impact of curriculum on developing industry-oriented skills: More than 44.4 percent of teachers described the curriculum as very good for developing industry-oriented skills among the students

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- Impact of curriculum on developing entrepreneurial skills: Almost 66 percent of teachers claimed the curriculum is good for developing entrepreneurial skills among the students. All in all teachers were fully satisfied with the curriculum.
- Impact of curriculum on holistic development of students: Majority of teachers i.e. 80 percent claimed it as very good. Overall teachers stated the curriculum as satisfactory concerning to develop holistic skills among students.
- Co-curricular and extracurricular activities: 22.2 percent teachers stated it as excellent. Altogether teachers suggested that there is no need for improvement in the context of co-curriculum and extra-curriculum activities for the students

- Fee structure: 14 percent of alumni stated that current fee structure needs improvement. 80 percent agreed that fee structure is good. Five percent stated that fee structure is excellent.
- Infrastructure facilities: Above the infrastructure facility 5 percent stated that it is excellent for 80 percent it is average and 15 percent stated that it needs improvement.
- Lab facilities in dept: More than 80 percent agreed that facilities provided are good. 20 percent need improvement in lab facilities.
- Faculty competence: More than 90 percent students stated that faculty competence is good. 10 percent need improvement.
- Coperation and support received by office members: Approximately 10
 percent stated that cooperation and support received from office members
 need improvement.
- Updated curriculum: About 10 percent alumni stated that updated curriculum
 is excellent. More than 70 percent are satisfied and about 14 percent need
 improvement.
- Academic ambience at IKGPTU: More than 80 percent found it to be good and about 14 percent need improvement.
- **Project guidance**: For Project guidance 10 percent found the guidance excellent and more than 70 percent found it good and 5 percent need improvement.
- Training and placement support: More than 70 percent describe it as average.
- **Library facilities:** 24 percent described library facilities are excellent. 34 percent stated it as good and average both.10 percent need improvement.
- Canteen facilities: 52 percent alumni need improvement in canteen facilities and rest found it to be satisfactory.
- Hostel facilities: For hostel facilities 50 percent stated it as average and 48 percent need improvement.
- Computer facilities: Computer facilities are good according to 60 percent of alumni
- Internet and Wi fi : The internet and Wi-Fi facilities said to be good according to 35 percent alumnus. About 62 percent need improvement.
- **sport facilities:** The sport facilities are good according to 45 percent alumnus. 50 percent need improvement.

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- Cultural activities: The Cultural activities need improvement according to 38 percent alumnus, whereas 60 percent found these to be good.
- Medical Facilities: About 35 percent of alumnus found medical facilities to be satisfactory while 60 percent need improvement.
- **Grievance redressal mechanism**: 33 percent need improvement and 60 percent found it to be good.
- Alumni association/Network of old friends: About 20 percent alumnus need improvement. 70 percent found it to be satisfactory.
- Overall rating of university: 34 percent alumnus rated the University as very good. About 55 percent rated it to be satisfactory.

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
