This SLM Steering Committee may be shouldered the responsibility to co-coordinate with all the stakeholders i.e. faculty members, outside experts, consultants, printers/publishers etc. for the timely development of SLMs. The committee will ensure timely preparation of SLMs content and further delivery of SLM content in multiple modes e.g. print/digital/online e-learning based Learning Management System. The committee will be central nodal agency of this entire task of SLM content development and delivery in above said multiple modes:

The Meeting started with a review of UGC Expert Committee visit held on 11 & 12 December 2013. Various points which came into notice during UGC committee's visit were analyzed. The most important issue which UGC committee highlighted was Self Learning Material of our DEP. After discussing the said issue holistically the following observations & recommendations are made:

- 1. PTU must address certain shortcomings of existing SLMs. They were neither developed nor monitored by our in-house faculty of DDE but were developed by total outsourcing at the level of AIPTUDEP Associates & Printers. Most of these SLMs do not bear the authors' names and details of content development teams. This was specifically objected by UGC committee. Also said printers are contesting with PTU about copyright/publishing issues for the same. Although we need to defend our position for using these existing SLMs, at the same time we need to aggressively start new SLM development under the new paradigm of our overhauled DEP system wherein all IPRs and Copyrights shall solely belong to PTU.
- 2. The new SLM development will require certain key questions to be addressed. First, PTU should limit the number of courses to be offered. An already constituted committee for DEP courses review and closure will give its final recommendations about new condensed list of courses.
- 3. The next vital question is role of DEP faculty at the head quarter. UGC Committee has categorically pointed out poor interface of our faculty with present SLMs and content development. Lack of ODL exposure and training to our faculty was pointed out by the committee. Since entire task of SLM development is now to be steered by PTU, role of faculty needs to be revisited and revised. The Faculty needs to be put on 24X7 ODL mode. They need to be fully channelized for SLM development work and trained upon ODL platform.
- 4. Having a condensed list of courses to be offered and DEP faculty geared up to take on the challenge, PTU can move on to achieve its first goal of new SLMs development as per following targest:
 - First target will be to print and distribute SLMs of first semesters of all the new courses specifically in IT & Management Streams on or before 28-2-2014. This deadline has been fixed on the assumption that new admissions

- might be open by the end of January 2014. When PTU will register new students, all such students will be in their first semesters and within a month of their admission, they will be delivered SLMs developed by the PTU Faculty.
- Next target will be development of further SLMs for next semesters over the period of time. So that before the first new batch completes degree (in two to three years), the PTU will have completed development of its own SLMs for all courses of all semesters. The estimated completion time for this job will be between one to two years.
- Meanwhile our already enrolled students will continue to use the existing SLMs.
- 5. In the new paradigm of overhauled DEP, PTU will be delivering SLM in dual mode. First mode will be instant uploading of SLMs on PTU website/supply of print version (Hard Books). The second mode will be the E-Learning mode (Tablet enabled interactive Learning Management System LMS, e-content along with PTU DEP online portal).
- 6. Whereas the printing job is just a week's exercise, the major challenges are twofold; First, Content Development of SLMs and Second, developing Tablet enabled interactive LMS based on this content. While modalities for content development are of purely academic nature, LMS generation needs high end professional expertise based on software/technology & content digitization experience. The content development will be hosted by PTU itself whereas for printing hard copies as well as digitization/LMS will need outsourcing of this job to external professional agencies/publishers/printers. For this PTU needs to clearly & strictly lay down quality standards and fine detail all requirements to get this job done professionally. For this purpose the method followed by some reputed contemporary organizations can be emulated or even tender can be floated.
- 7. For content development of SLMs, the entire project needs to be piloted by PTU only, through a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) which will be executed as per prevailing norms of ODL regulatory bodies like UGC or prevailing practices of reputed ODL institutes e.g. IGNOU.
- 8. In light of above proposed SLM Content Development SOP is presented as follows:
 - i. PTU will run limited number of courses in a total of Six Streams viz: IT, Management, Paramedical, Hotel Management, Media &Multimedia and Fashion.
 - Each Stream will have such courses as are being offered through regular mode also. So BOS as well as syllabi are to be same as for corresponding regular courses.



- CDC of every stream will be headed by a Stream Coordinator (PTU Faculty) who will be Chairman of his CDC as well as ex-officio DEP Member Coordinator in respective BOS. This stream coordinator will be the pilot of his stream's content development project. He will coordinate with Subject Coordinators who again will be PTU Faculty from different specialization areas of the stream. Further down the line there will be Subject Experts drawn from same specialization area as of Subject Coordinator. These Subject Experts will be external faculty drawn from affiliated colleges of PTU/other reputed universities/institutes/Industry Experts/Members of concerned BOS and will be in order of preference; A. Professor or

 - B. Associate Professor or
 - C. Assistant Professor with Ph.D or
 - D. Assistant Professor with at least 10 years of teaching experience
- The Stream Coordinator, Subject Coordinators and Subject Experts will work in mutual consultation and prepare Master Plan of SLM development. This will include activities like Segmentation/Delineation of Syllabus into Units, then Units into Chapters. Logical sequencing of chapters in each Unit and then sequencing of all Units in the entire syllabus. Incorporation of Self Instructional features at all levels.

- Since these people may not have sufficient ODL orientation, they will be vi. imparted general ODL and specific SLM Content Development Training. This part will be undertaken by Directorate of Distance Education as well as SLM
- After finalizing the master plan of SLM development, CDC will identify vii. authors for script writing. The identified authors will be shortlisted on the basis of reasonable screening criteria. After finalizing the authors, the CDC will get the scripts written in SLM/SIM format by working in tandem with the authors. CDC will then review the manuscripts/drafts submitted by authors, vet/edit it wherever needed and ultimately finalize after due iterations.
- This way complete subject wise SLMs will be prepared and after approval viii. from competent authority, these will be sent to selected Printers for hard copy printing as well as development of Tablet based interactive LMS.
- 9. As the job of CDC is of extremely academic nature, their quality of work will determine the quality of our SLMs. Hence it is proposed that concerned external members/faculty/authors etc must be paid attractive honorarium. IGNOU/PU/other reputed ODL university rates can be referred for setting minimum honorarium, however our rates need to be higher and attractive enough. This is especially important in context of following:
 - We have very short time to complete our first phase i.e. approximately 2 months only (As target date is 28-02-2014).
 - This cost is in fact a one time capital investment for enhancing PTU's DEP quality & brand image. So this expenditure is worth making and has a critically high impact value.
 - This will help to attract quality authors from the academia.
- 10. It is obvious that authors will quite often visit PTU for meetings with CDC and even for ODL training. While writing scripts, they may need to consult some reference books as well. So we must ensure that our Library should stock all reference books as mentioned in syllabi of concerned regular courses. A committee may kindly be constituted under flagship of Academics Department (Regular) which will provide course wise list of books to be immediately purchased in Library. Thereafter the Librarian must ensure their fastest purchase on urgent basis. Also Indian Journal of Open Learning & other ODL research journals published within/outside the country must be subscribed in our Library. 11.
 - Entire SLM development project revolves around one axis and that axis is i. PTU Faculty. Therefore it is strongly felt and recommended that all DEP Faculty should be transferred to DDE. Their physical sitting in DDE is imperative for tuning them up to this altogether new paradigm of ODL. They need to be trained, groomed for SLM Content Development. They will need high intensity & continuous rapport with DDE and the SLM Steering

Accordingly in order to ensure their comfortable sitting arrangements it is ii. proposed to renovate and develop corridor hall area which connects DDE with Director Recruitment Office. It is having ample sitting space. Just some face

lifting and partitioning work will make it ideal workplace for unleashing the academic energy of our high potential faculty. By the time this area gets ready, the workstations of DDE staff can be got vacated for adhoc sitting arrangements of Faculty as time is acutely short and work needs to kick start immediately without any delay.


