3rd June 2022-Guru Arjan Dev Shaheedi Diwas

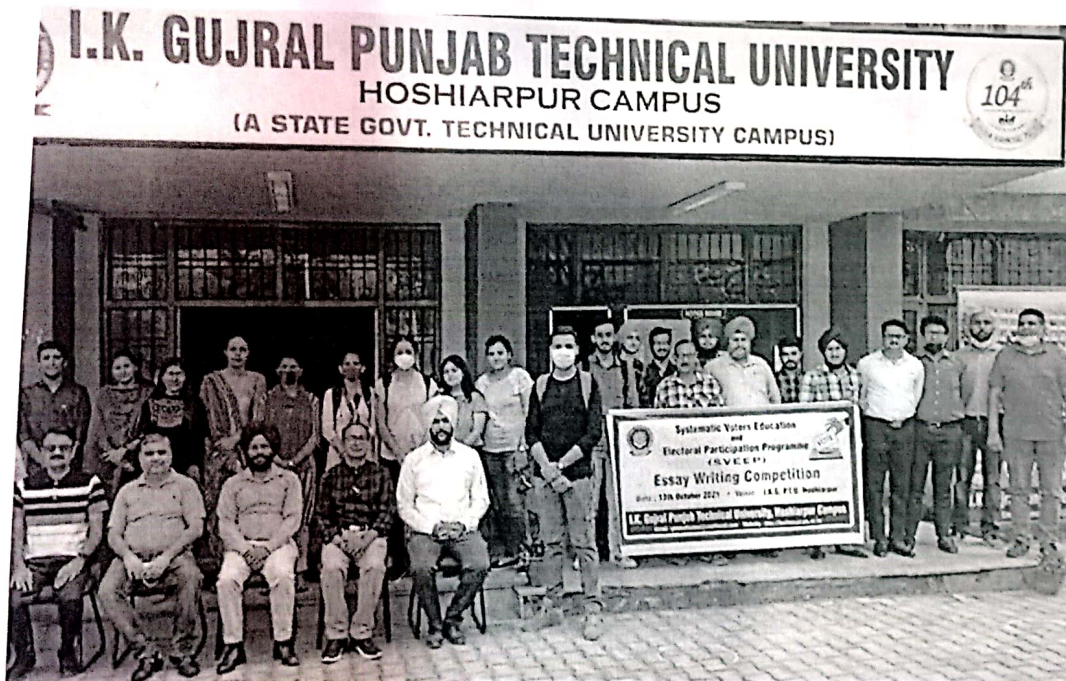



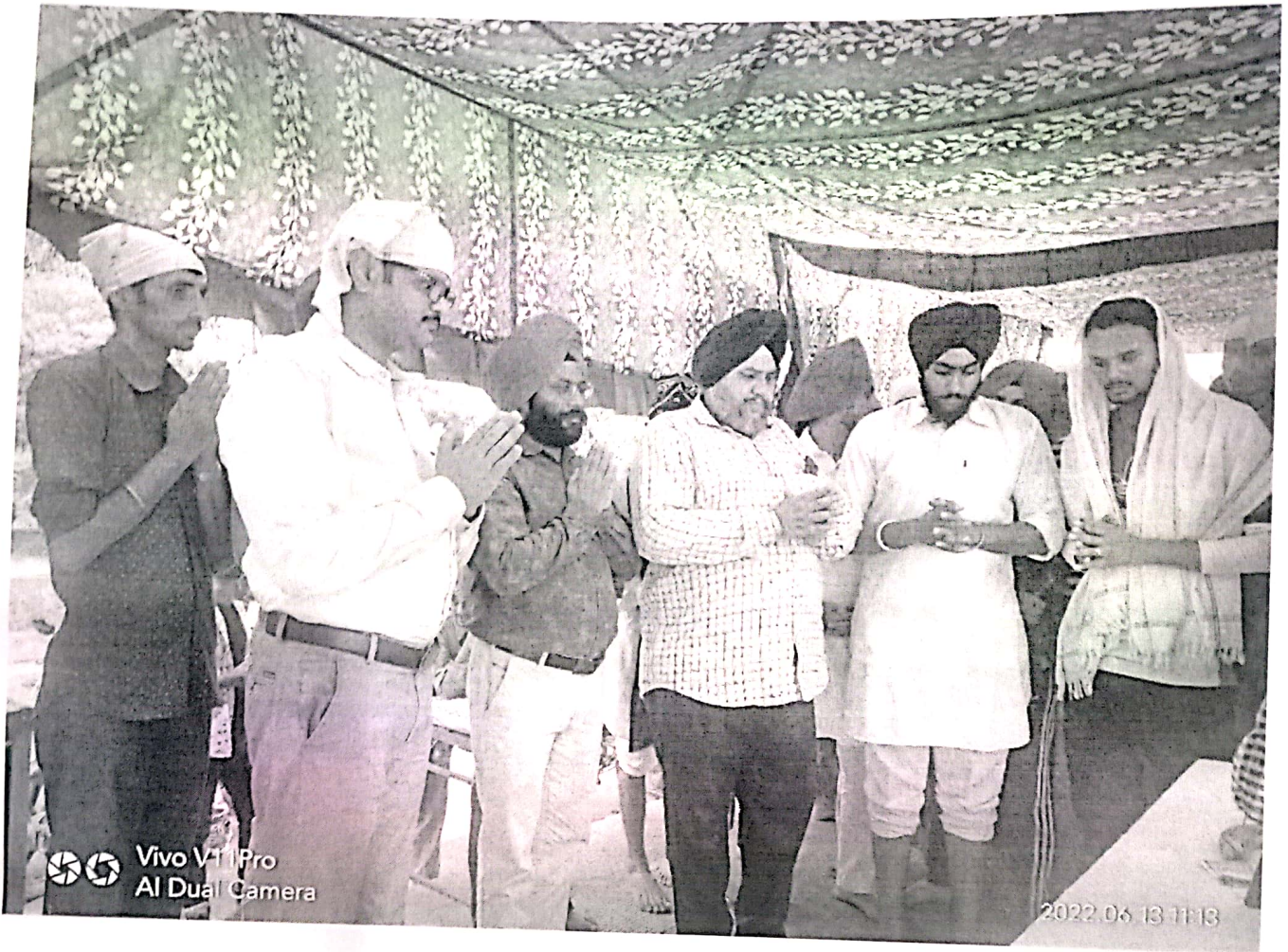
