- Adequate Infrastructure and cadre-wise qualified faculty as per COA Norms must be appointed/ maintained by the institution at all times.
- The institution needs to appoint regular full-time core faculty as the guest faculty shown are engaged in professional practice.
The institution shall initiate necessary remedial actions, if any, based on the observations of the Council and/or Inspection Committee and send its compliance/observations on the same for further consideration. The Council shall be at liberty to inspect the Institution at any point of time to verify the compliance made by the institution and to ascertain that the institution is imparting architectural course as per the Norms prescribed by the Council, from time to time.

- Lateral Entry to Second Year Degree Course(s) in Engineering and Technology Programme shall be permissible up to maximum of $10 \%$ of the "Approved Intake" of previous year, which shall be over and above, supernumerary to the "Approved intake", plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
20 The Covernor of Punjab is also pleased to further lssue the following criteria for maling admissions


## A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR DIPLOMA HOLDERS

(1) All those candidates who have passed minimum three years/two years (Lateral Entry) Diploma examination from an AICTE approved institution/recognized university as defined by UCC with at least $45 \%$ marks ( $40 \%$ in case of Candidates belonging to reserved category) in any branch of Engineering and Technology shall be eligible to apply.

OR
(11) All those candidates who have passed B. Se. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UCC, with at least $45 \%$ marks ( $40 \%$ in case of Candidates belonging to reserved category) and passed XII standard with mathematics as a subject shall be eligible to apply.

OR
(iii) Passed D.Voc stream in the same or thlied sector:
((The Universities will offer suitable bridge courses such as Mathematios, Physics, Engineering drawing, etc, for the students coming from diverse back crounds to achieve desired learning outcomes of the programme)
B. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO DEGREE LEVEL, ENGINEERING. TECHNOLOGY COURSE:
(1) The admission of candidates to the Engineering courses under this scheme shall only be given to those, who fulfill all other conditions for admission. In case of seats reserved for SC/ST, the relative merit of candidates shall be determined within the raserved category.
(i) Candidates who have appeared / are appearing in the qualifying diploma examination to be held

- during the current session shall also be eligible for submission of admission form but they will have to pass the diploma before the date of counselling, otherwise, thy will not be consldered for admission. Such condidates will not have any claim, whatsoever, with regard to the admisston to the courses.
(1i) The guidelines issued for the grant of resident certificates / bonafide resident of Punjab by Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-2 Branch) vide No. 1/3/95-3PP2/9619 dated the $6^{6 \mathrm{t}}$ June, 1996, and I.D. No. 1/2/96-3PP-2/8976 dated $7^{\text {th }}$ July, 1998 and No. 1/3/95-3PP-2/80 dated 1" January 1999, and further instructions, issued by that Department, if any, will be adhered to in letter and spirit while making admission to the Degree Courses in the Engineering Colleges. However, children of defence personnel posted in Punjab are exempted from this condition to the extent that they should have passed only qualifying examination from a recognized institution situated in Punjab.
(iv) Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as contained in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education \& Industrial Training Memo Na. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21* March. 2003, which is annexed to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the sald commurication.


## Exemption under above para

Children / Wards / Dependent (whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government Employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab Cadre, Serving fudges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards / Corporations / Statutory Bodies established by an Act of the State of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before $1^{x}$ January of the year of admissions that is on or before 1* January, 2020 and their children / wards / dependents have completed qualifying examination outside Punjab.

## C. Reseryation:

(i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Puojab Government, Department of Technical Bducation and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated $2^{24}$ July, 2013 and Memo no.8/41/2019-4TE2/53 dated 13.09.2019, which are attached as Annexures. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification for all purposes and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
(ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for counselling. If no reservation is claimed the candidate shall be treated and considered as a "General Category Candidate".
(iii) The I. K. Guiral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the online application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any, under which reservation is being sought, so that inter-se gradation can be facilitated. These sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo no.8/41/2019-4TE2/53 dated 13.09.2019, which are attached as Annexures. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect inter-se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesald memo dated 2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ July, 2013 and dated $13^{\text {tit }}$ September, 2019.
(iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation in any reserved category. However, the procedure for counselling shall be as per Punfab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo No.7/21/2004-RS1/1674-1677 dated 20 ${ }^{\text {d }}$ Dec. 2004.

## D. GENERALCONDITIONS:

(1) There shall be centralized Centralized Counselling by I. K. Gurrapumjab Techancal University:
(ii) There shall be two rounds of Centralized counseling by L. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. The procedure of Centralized Online Counselling will be decided by the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. Thereafter the direct admissions at the college level shall be allowed for vacant seats. The L. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala will be issue necessary instructions to the affiliated Institutions of University in this regard.
(iii) As per All India Council for Technical Education Revised Acadernic Calendar for A/Y 2021-22 issued on dated 12.07 .2021 , which is attached as annexure, the last date upto which students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason(no student should be admitted in any institution after the last date under any quota) is 20,10.2021. Hence admissions to various degree courses shall be allowed only once in an academic sessipn.


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(iv) The students shall be liable to pay Fee / Development Fee and other charges as per the rates of Fee / Development Fee and other charges as fixed by the Govermment of Punjab/AICTE/ Concerned University, from time to time.
(v) The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt, Deptt. of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated $25^{\text {mh }}$ April 2008 and Partial notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 Dated $20^{\text {m }}$ June 2008 and partial notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/171 dated $18^{\text {i }}$ lanuary 2011, which is as Annexed.
(vi) The allocation of seats through counselling shall be done as follows:
(a) Counselling for $85 \%$ seats for Punjab residents and $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$ outste Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously. However, the reserved cutegory candidates shall be consldered in general category first before being considereit th respentve reserved catagory.
(b) The seats still remaining unfilled even after the end of Centralized Counselling shall be filled on merit at the level of Institution. Admission to such unfilled/vacant seats as well as management quota shall be furnished to I. K. Gufral Pumjab Technical Universityand details thereof shall be finalized within 15 days of the last tate of counselling.
(vii) Any seat falling vacant after counselling or any drop out vacancy will be filled by the Institute on the basis of the criteria of admission under management quota. A seat once accepted shall not be changed.
(viii) The information about the eligibility for admission to Lateral Entry courses in Engineering Colleges and Departments of Universities and also about the institution/ discipline/ categorywise availability of seats and reservation of seats for various categories shall be made available byI. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala on website www.ptuacin.
(ix) The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/Person of India Origin shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-1TE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.
(x) The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per notification of Punjab Government in this regard.
( x ) Non refundable counselling fee of Rs. 2,000 - (Rupees Two Thousand only) will be collected by the University as counselling fee from each student one time only.
(xil) In case a student changes his/her College/University during centralized counselling conducted by I. K. Culiral Punjab Technical Universityhis/her fee shall be refunded by the pervipus Institution after deduction of Rs 1,000 / only the original documents will be refunded immediately. However, In case of up-gradation of seats during subsequent counselling's no deduction shall be made.
(xilii) In case a student surrenders his/her seat, within 7 days of the ond of the Centralized online Counselling, he/she must submit application to college and rister on I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical Universitywebsite www.ptuacin. I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical Universityshall only forward such cases to the concerned Colleges/ Universities and Colleges must refund his/her full fee after detection of Rs. 1,000 /- only.
(viv) In keeping with the direction of Ministry of Human Resource Development Department, Govt, of India, all Institutions and Universities shall in public interest, maintain a waiting list of students/candidates. In the event of a student/ candidate withdrawing before the start of the course, the waiting list candidates should be given admissions against the vacant seat. The entire fees collected from the student, after a deduction of processing fee of not more than Rs. 1,000 - (Rupees One Thousand Only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution/University to the student/candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School/Institution leaving certificates in original. If a student leaves after joining the course and if the seat subsequently falling vacant gets filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the institution must return the fees collected with proportionate deduction of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable.
(xv) All Institutions affliated to I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University and Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University shall follow 'Fee Waiver Scheme' as prescribed by AICTE and Deon (Acodemics)
notified by Government of Punjab vide its notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/1797, dated 23 rd May, 2011, Motilitention No. 13/60/08-1TE2/2007 dated 31.5.2012, Letter No. 751-752/S1/ECC/2015 dated 13.05.2015 and Letter No. 428-430 dated 04.04.2019. Other Institutions/ - Universities may notify their respective fee waiver scheme separately.
(xvi) As per section 7 of the Athhaar Act, 2016, use of Aadhaar Authentication Services while identifying beneficiaries and processing the benefit under any scholarship scheme of government is mandatory. The Universities shall adhere to the guidelines and regulations defined by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAD.

The Courses offered in the timings of Regular Shift, Second Shift and Part Time shall be considered as Regular Courses. The Institutions shall have to fulfill all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements to offer the Regular Courses as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 21-22 for the Total Approved Intake and the Institutions may conduct the Courses in the timings of Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift and Part Time not exceeding the "Approved Intake" of each Course, as per the convenience of all stakeholders. All such Institutions shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS (with effect from A/Y 2020-21) to fulfil the norms and an affidavit for the same shall have to be submitted to AICTE. Student enrolment details shall be uploaded in the Web-Portal.

The Institutions may run Skill Development Courses, student developmental activities such as Research Park, Start-up Centre, Innovation Club, Entrepreneurship, etc. in the excess Built-up area without affecting the regular academic activities.
7.11 The AICTE approved Institutions shall be permitted to collaborate with each other for Student Exchange Programme so that the students admitted in an Institution may spend one Semester in another Institution.

Further, the institutions running only one course (unique in nature) with more than 50 years of existence and unable to modify/improve/change infrastructure (heritage building), can share the facilities / collaborate with nearby institutions for all academic related activities.
7.12 An institution shall only allow up to $20 \%$ or as per the new regulation of UGC /AICTE of the total courses being offered in a particular Programme in a Semester through the Online Learning courses provided through SWAYAM platform as per the AICTE (Credit Framework for online learning course through SWAYAM) Regulations, 2016 as amended from time to time.
7.13 Institutes having less Enrolment / Poor Academic Performance
a) Institutions having less enrolment

Institutions having Course(s) in which admissions are less than 30\% of the "Approved Intake" for the consecutive past 5 years consistently, and if in the following year, the admitted student strength does not exceed $50 \%$ of the "Approved Intake" in the course(s) by filling vacant seats through lateral entry, then the Council shall reduce the intake by $50 \%$, in such Course(s) in the current Academic Year.
In the Courses approved by the Council, if the Institution fails to admit the students/ not started the Course(s) due to Non-affiliation by the University/ Board or Non-Fulfilment of State Government/ UT requirements in the year of establishment, the same shall be informed to the Council, else ALL the Courses shall be considered for implementing the above Clause.
The Institution falling under this category need not apply for restoration in the next Academic Year and the Intake shall be automatically reinstated by the Council, if the enrolment becomes more than $30 \%$ based on the student enrolment data provided by the Institution. However, such Institutions shall not be eligible to apply for other categories listed under Chapter II/III/V/ VI of the Approval Process Handbook except Extension of Approval.
Further, if such Institutions apply for restoration of Intake against the punitive action if any, in the previous Academic Year(s) and if the earlier "Approved Intake" being restored through EVC followed by SHC/ SAC, then this Clause shall be applied after five years.
b) Institutions having poor academic performance:

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7.14 Admission to Lateral Entry to Second Year Course(s)
a) Lateral Entry to Second Year Diploma Course(s) shall be permissible up to a maximum of $10 \%$ of the "Approved Intake" which shall be over and above, supernumerary to the "Approved Intake", plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
b)

Lateral Entry to Second Year Under Graduate Degree Course as applicable in Appendix 1 shall be permissible up to a maximum of $10 \%$ of the "Approved Intake" which shall be over and above, supernumerary to the "Approved Intake", plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
c) The Institution applied for Closure (if the same is under process/ approved for Progressive Closure) are eligible for admission to the Lateral Entry in the current Academic Year, as Extension of Approval was issued in the previous Academic Year and students were admitted during that year.
d) The Institutions where "No Admission" have been issued for the current Academic Year are eligible for admission to the Lateral Entry in the current Academic Year, as Extension of Approval was issued in the previous Academic Year and students were admitted during that year. However, in the Institutions where "No Admission" have been issued for the previous Academic Year are not eligible for admission to the Lateral Entry in the current Academic Year.
e) Institutions applied for the Conversion of Degree Level into Diploma Level and vice-versa/ Conversion of Women's Institution to Co-ed Institution and vice-versa and approved for the conversion are eligible for admission to the Lateral Entry as per the approval that of the previous Academic Year.
f) Any Foreign National obtained Diploma in a Foreign Institution (having an equivalency Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities) or Diploma in an Indian Institution shall also be eligible for Lateral Entry into the Second Year under Graduate Degree Course. The Institutions having approval for the supernumerary seats in such Course(s) as per Clause $\mathbf{2 . 1 2}$ of the Approval Process Handbook are ONLY eligible to admit the Foreign Nationals as per the norms, else the Institution shall apply for the same on AICTE Web-Portal. However, the total Foreign Nationals admitted under supernumerary seats and the Lateral Entry shall not exceed the $15 \%$ of the "Approved Intake" in an Academic year.
g) NRI candidates shall also be permitted for admission in Lateral Entry to Second Year, subject to the approval from AICTE for the NRI seats and fulfilment of requisite norms as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
h) Vacant seats arising out of the students withdrawing the admission in the First Year shall also be considered for Lateral Entry.
7.15 The Technical Institutions shall follow Norms for Faculty requirements and Cadre ratio at Diploma/ Under Graduate/ Post Graduate Level as provided in the Appendix 7 of the Approval Process Handbook.

The Institutions shall ensure the timely and complete payment of the salary of Faculty by Electronic Clearing Service through Nationalized Banks. Expert Visit Committee shall ensure the Faculty availability by the annual salary paid statements of the faculty in addition to their physical presence.
The Institution should not demand for the Original Degree Certificates from the Faculty members at the time of joining the Institution. The Faculty members shall avoid the practice of leaving an Institution in the middle of the semester without completing the Courses assigned to them in the Semester.

The institutions shall ensure that necessary addition/deletion of faculty ID (Details in case of new faculty have not worked in any other AICTE approved institutions so far) on AICTE web portal within the same month from the date of Joining/Leaving.
a) In the following Programmes, the Adjunct Faculty/ Resource Person as per guidelines given in Annexure 9 of the Approval Process Handbook are permissible (up to a maximum as mentioned below), as the Programmes require more pradtical exposure.

- Design-20\%
- Planning - $30 \%$
7.45 (a) Supernumerary seats ( 25 Nos.) are granted by the Council, for the Institutions falling under the Centrally Supported Scheme of "Upgrading existing Polytechnics to integrate Persons with Disability (PwD)" in the mainstream of Technical and Vocational Education.
(b) Concession for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit / Kashmiri Hindu Families (NonMigrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission in Higher Educational Institutions (As per MoE directives: F.No. 3-4/2017-NER, Dated: $15^{\text {th }}$ October, 2019). This is in addition to PMSSS supernumerary seats. They are not eligible for scholarship
7.46 Affidavit 2 specified in the Approval Process Handbook shall be uploaded in the AICTE Web-Portal in e-stamp paper with digital signature of the authorized signatories.
7.47 In case of any litigation pertaining to the penal action initiated by the Council for an Institution, for the contravention of any of the relevant Regulations, such Institution shall have to apply as per Clause 8.1 (b) / 8.18 (as applicable) in AICTE Web-Portal, in the absence of any specific court order to the contrary.
7.48 Clause 1.5.4 of the Approval Process Handbook does not permit Self-financing Institutions to use 'Indian,', National', etc. in the Name of the Institution. The Institutions which were already given approval with those words shall be instructed to change/ drop the word from the Name of the Institution, as the Stake holders may misinterpret them to be Government/ Government Aided Institutions.
If any Institution (other than Government/ Government Aided) continue to use 'Indian',' National', etc. in the Name of the Institution, the Council shall remove such words while issuing EoA.


### 7.49 Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme

- The Waiver is limited to the Tuition Fee as approved by the State Level Fee Committee for Self-Financing Institutions and by the Government for the Government/ Government aided Institutions. All other Fees except Tuition Fee shall have to be paid by the beneficiary.
d) Admission Procedure
- Under this Scheme, up to a maximum of $5 \%$ of "Approved Intake" per Course shall be available for this admission. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature. These supernumerary seats shall be available only to such Course(s) in an Institution, where a minimum of $50 \%$ of "Approved Intake" are filled up in last Academic year
- The Competent Authority to effect this admission is the State Government/ UT or its designated authority.
- In the event of non-availability of students in this category, the same shall not be given to any other category of candidates.
- The State Admission Authority shall invite applications under this category; make a separate merit list for this category and effect admission on the basis of the merit list so generated.
- The Institutions shall publish in their Brochure and Web site the details of this scheme.
- Competent Authority for admission shall submit a separate list of the students admitted under this category to the Institution to which they are admitted for compliance.
- A letter in this respect shall be issued by the Competent Authont 5 for admission to each beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and he she shall not be allowed to change the Institution/ Course under any circumstances.

### 2.0 The guidelines/regulations for admissions are as under:-

## A. Eligibility Criteria (Educational Qualifications \& Resident Status)

The eligibility criteria for admission shall be same as notified by the University. (Anmexure - A).
(i) For admission to the UGC (Non-AICTE) Courses, 85\% seats shall be open for the candidates from within the State and $15 \%$ will be open for the candidates from outside the State.
(II) Admission will be made on the basis of Rank prepared based on inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination for both $85 \%$ quota for resident of Punjab and $15 \%$ quota for outside Punjab.
(III) Welghtage of $5 \%$ in the marks obtained in qualifying examination shall be awarded to those candidates who have studied for atleast three years or have passed their +1 and +2 examination from the schools located in Rural Area. (Format of Rural Area is attached at Annexure-B).

## B. General Eligibility Criteria for Admissions:

Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria for admission shall be same as mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education \& Industrial Training, Punjab, Memo No.35/44/95/T (2) 978 dated 21* March 2003, which is attached at Annexure - $\mathbf{C}$ to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

## Exemption Under above para

Children/wards/dependent (Whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab-cadre, serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations /Statutory Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding past outside Punjab on or before $1=$ january, 2021. Le

## C. Reservation:

(i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2 nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019-4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019, which are attached at Annexure - D to this notification or as notified by Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training from time to time. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
(ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for online counselling, If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Candidate".
(iii) The I. K. Guiral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the online application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any under which reservation is being sought, so that inter se gradation can be facilitated. There sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo No.13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated Ind July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019-4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019, which are attached as Annexure. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated Ind July, 2013 and memo dated 13th September, 2019.
(iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make a claim for reservation in any of the reserved category. However, the procedure for a counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo No. 7/21/2004-RS1/1674-1677 dts. 20 m Dec. 2004.
D. Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme for Non-AICTE Courses:

As per IKGPTU Notification Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/N/3767 dated 27/11/2018, which is attached at Annexure - E, the Tuition Fee Waiver scheme shall also be applicable on Non-AICTE courses on the pattern of AICTE courses as notified by the Punjab Government from time to time. (Punjab Government notifications related to TFW Scheme are attached at Annexure - F).
Note : Please go through the latest guidelines ie. "Requirements and Eligibility" and "Admission Procedure" related to Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme, issued by the AICTE in its Approval Process Handbook 2021-22 (Revised) at para 7.49 \& Page No. 107 for your kind information and reference.

## E. Fee \& Other charges:

The students shall be liable to pay fee/ development fee and other charges as per the rates of fees/ development fee and other charges as notified by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, at the time of admission. Fee Notification issued by the University for the Session 2021-22 vide Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/NF/157 de 22/06/2021 (For IKGPTU Campuses), Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/NF/152 dit 22/06/2021 and Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/NF/2159 dated 19/07/2021 (For Autonomous and Affiliated Colleges of IKGPTU) is attached at Annexure - G.

G. Procedure for Admission:
(i) The Colleges / Institutes shall display, on the website of the college, the dates to apply for these courses and dates of the counseling, wherever, possible the counseling will be made online.
(ii) The counseling will be made purely on the basis of merit and should be displayed to the students.
(iii) Preparation of Merit list
(1) There will be a common merit lists for General and Reserved categories / subcategories (If applicable) candidates.
(2) The rank of the candidates in the merit list securing equal marks will be in accordance with the following criteria:
(a) The candidate securing higher aggregate percentage marks in the qualifying examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
(b) In the case of tie in (a) above, the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in order of merit.
(iv) Counseling for 85\% seats of Punjab residents and 15\% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneousty. However, the reserved category candidates shall be considered in general category, first before being considered in the respective category.
(v) The college will issue a public notice on official website to this effect indicating clearly the number of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category in all the rounds of counseling.
(vi) Institute must complete atleast two rounds of counseling based on rank in inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination considering the respective reserve category, as applicable by Punjab Govt.
(vii) After following above said procedure, if still the seats remaining vacant in reserve category, the college can fill these from candidates belonging to general category in subsequent step at the end of counseling.
(viii) The whole process will cease on the last date of admission as finalized by Regulatory Body Le. UGC/IKGPTU/State Govt etc.
(ix) The candidate must have passed qualifying examination at the time of admission.
(x) The candidates having compartment/re-appear in qualifying examination can be admitted provisionally, however, such candidates are required to pass the qualifying examination before the commencement of $1 *$ semester examination of University.
(xi) The College/Institute must upload the list of admitted students on the webportal of the University latest by $7^{\text {th }}$ October, 2021 however, in case of any discrepancy, the

Institutes/Colleges are allowed to submit it as a hard copy to the University, by all means, upto 14im October, 2021.
(xii) The application along with all qualification certificates should be produced in original for the eligbility check Specimen Application form to be filled by the candidate desirous of taking admission to these courses is attached at Annexure - H.
(xiii) Colleges will upload the data of the candidate admitted by them in each round of counseling on University webportal and shall deposit non refundable admission processing fee amounting to Rs $2,000 /$ - (Rupee two thousand only) for each student simultaneously.
(xiv) College will verify the original documents of the candidates and ensure that the eligibility is fulfilled before making admission. An undertaking will be submitted by the institute alongwith the updated list of the students that all the admitted students fulfill the eligibility criteria.
(xv) The documents in original are required to be produced to the university for eligibility check.
(xvi) The Fee structure for Foreign National/PIO shall be the same as was in vogue for NRI candidates.
(xvil) The guidelines for admission of Foreign National/PIO shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-1TE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.

## H. Refund of Fee Guidelines:
