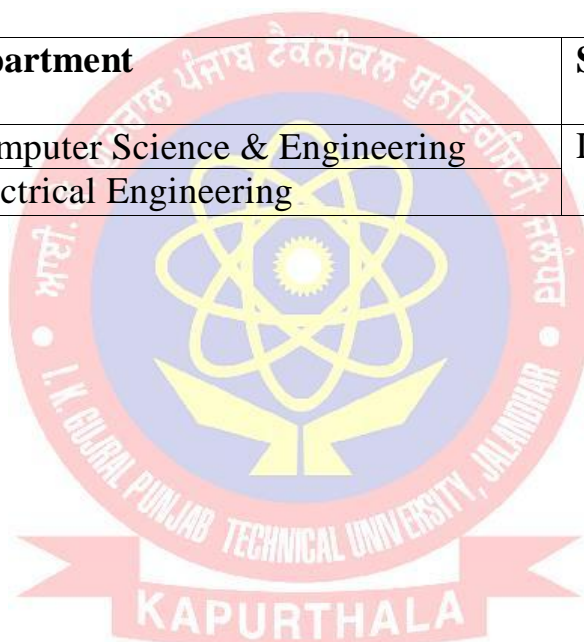

The criteria for judging the final round are 1. Accuracy of Programs in all Test cases and 2. The time complexity for tie-breaker. CSE 5th, Rajan Baliwal, B.Tech SE 5th conquered the contest and Anshu Verma B. Tech. CSE 5th, Daksh B.Tech. CSE 5th, Utkarsh Saxena B.Tech. CSE 5th hold the position of succeeders.

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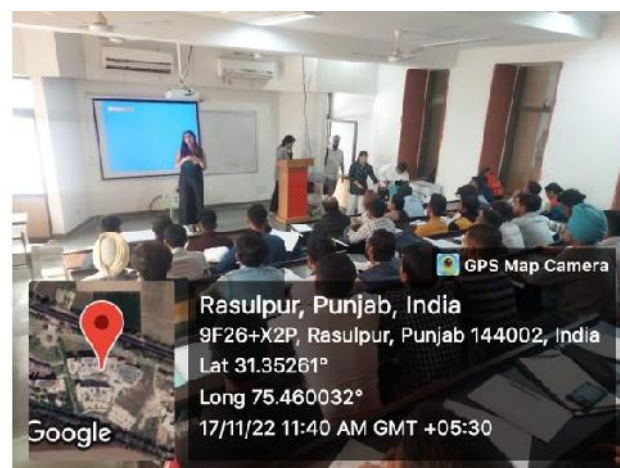

A One-day workshop “Industrial automation its scope and future”, commenced on 17th November 2022 at IK Gujral Punjab Technical University, Main campus, Kapurthala. The invited experts were from Wonder Automation-Training Division, Industrial area, Mohali Punjab. More than 60 students of the department participated with great enthusiasm. Especially, focus was given to enhance the practical skills of undergraduate and post graduate students of the department. The invited experts deliberated upon the introduction of various industrial automation systems and highlighted its need in current aspects of artificial intelligence.
