Lohri Festival (January 13th)

Lohri is a popular winter folk festival of Punjab and celebrated with a bonfire. It marks the end of winter, and is a traditional welcome of longer days. Lohri rituals are performed in Campus with all the staff & students.

Republic Day (January 26th) & Independence Day (August 15th)

Every year the University Main Campus celebrates National Festivals i.e. Independence Day on 15th August and Republic Day on 26th January with pomp and gaiety by hoisting the national tricolour in the main Campus. After unfurling the flag, students sing the National Anthem and other patriotic songs. On those occasions, the Vice-Chancellor also delivers Independence/Republic day messages.

Holi (In March)

Holi is the Festival of Colours. Every year the Campus Annual Function (comprising of Sports event, cultural & literary events, and some fun events) is organized near to this festival. Noted personalities and educationists are invited for inaugural and valedictory functions.

Ambedkar Jayanti & Vaisakhi festival (April 14th)

Ambedkar Jayanti is an annual festival observed on 14 April to commemorate the memory of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Indian polymath and civil rights activist. On this day students are encouraged to understand the constitution of the Nation by organizing some special talks followed by the Vaisakhi celebrations.

World Art Day, (April 15th)

World Art Day celebrations help reinforce the links between artistic creations of the students, encourage greater awareness of the diversity of artistic expressions and highlight the contribution of Architects/artists to sustainable development. World Art Day, a celebration to promote the development, diffusion and enjoyment of art and architecture. Teacher's day (September 5th)




Guru Nanak Birthday
