

General Conditions:-

1. **Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme** shall be applicable as per AICTE / Punjab Government / IKGPTU norms.
2. **Reservation:** Reservation of seats shall be as per guidelines issued by the Government of Punjab Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, from time to time.
3. As per IKGPTU Notification Ref. No. PTU/Reg/Notification/454 to 457 dated 28/10/2014, all the courses offered are subject to minimum admission of 05 (Five) students against intake of 18/25 seats and 10 (Ten) students against intake of 60/40/30 seats. Admission in these courses will be purely provisional, if the minimum admission criteria to any course is not fulfilled till the last

date of admission, then the concerned HoD will initiate the process for further directions from competent authority to run that particular course having enrolment less than the specified minimum admissions.

4. **Refund Policy** shall be same as per guidelines issued by the respective Regulatory Body (i.e. UGC / COA / AICTE / Govt. of Punjab / IKGPTU) from time to time.




1.0 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala as the authority competent to conduct the Online Centralized Counselling for admission to **various degree levels Engineering Courses** being run in the Institutions and Universities located in the State of Punjab on the basis of inter-se-merit of qualifying examination for the Academic Session 2023-24. The admission shall be made in the colleges affiliated to Universities/Campuses of the Universities mentioned below:-

1. I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala
2. Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University, Bathinda
3. Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana

Note: The name of colleges, branches in each college and the number of seats will be as given in the letter of approval issued by AICTE/Concerned University (in case of University Campuses / Constituent Campuses only) for the year 2023-24.

As per All Indian Council for Technical Education, New Delhi letter No. AICTE/Adv-1/AB/2016/86 dated 08.12.2016 and letter dated 07-07-2020:-

- In no eventually, a Technical Institution without prior approval of the AICTE, and affiliating University shall be allowed to participate in the counselling and admission process and to admit students. Affiliating University shall not enroll students admitted in such Technical Institutions, which do not have requisite approval of the AICTE.
- University shall not grant affiliation to a Technical Institution approved by AICTE after the last date as issued by AICTE in the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence.
- Affiliating University shall not permit any Technical Institution to admit students without requisite prior approval of the AICTE.
- University/Institution shall not permit admissions of students to Technical Program which are not approved by the AICTE.

2.0 The Governor of Punjab is also pleased to further issue the following criteria for making admissions:-

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS & RESIDENT STATUS) FOR ADMISSION TO DEGREE LEVEL ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY COURSES:

- (i) For admission to the Engineering Courses, 85% seats shall be open for the candidates from within the State and 15% will be open for the candidates from outside the State.
- (ii) Admission shall be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of qualifying examination for both 85% quota for residents of Punjab and 15% quota for outside Punjab.
- (iii) All those candidates who have passed 10+2 examination with Physics / Mathematics / Chemistry / Computer Science / Electronics / Information Technology / Biology / Informatics Practices / Biotechnology / Technical Vocational subject / Agriculture / Engineering Graphics / Business Studies / Entrepreneurship as per table 1.3(a) of AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2023-24.

Agriculture stream (for Agriculture Engineering)

Obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.

OR

Those candidates who have passed minimum 3 years Diploma examination from Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Chandigarh or Sant Longowal Institute of

Engineering and Technology, Longowal (SLIET), or any such examination from any other recognized State Board of Technical Education with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) subject to vacancies in the First Year, in case the vacancies at lateral entry are exhausted.

(The Universities will offer suitable bridge courses such as Mathematics, Physics, Engineering drawing, etc., for the students coming from diverse backgrounds to prepare Level playing field and desired learning outcomes of the programme)

OR

The candidates who have passed two years certificate course from Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology, Longowal (SLIET) shall be eligible.

- (iv) The candidates whose results are not declared/pending (due to whatsoever reason) in the qualifying examination, shall also be eligible to appear for counselling. The admission of such candidates shall be purely provisional and shall stand cancelled, if they fail to produce their eligibility at the time of admission and such candidates shall have no claim, whatsoever, for admission to these courses through Counselling.

Eligibility for PAU, Ludhiana

- (i) In addition to conditions enumerated above for admission to Engineering courses run by Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana, the eligibility criteria of the concerned university, shall be applicable.
- (ii) In case of any dispute, decision of the competent authority conducting the counselling shall be final and binding on all.

B. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO DEGREE LEVEL ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY COURSES:

Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as contained in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab Memo No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003, which is attached as Annexure. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

Exemption under above Para

Children/wards/dependent (whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab cadre, Serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards / Corporations / Statutory Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of entrance test that is on or before 1st January, 2023 and their children / wards / dependents may have done 10+1 and/or 10+2 outside Punjab.

C. RESERVATION:

- (i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05 - 1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 - 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019, which are attached as Annexure. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
- (ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for Online Centralized

- Counselling. If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Candidate".
- (iii) The I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any, under which reservation is being sought, so that *inter se* gradation can be facilitated. These sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05 - 1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 - 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019 which are attached as Annexure. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect *inter se* gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013 and memo dated 13.09.2019
- (iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation in any of the reserved category only. However, the procedure for a counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo No. 7/21/2004-RS1/1674-1677 dated 20th Dec, 2004.

D. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (i) There shall be a Centralized Online Counselling by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University. The procedure for Centralized Counselling shall be decided by the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University. However, the following category of seats shall be filled through direct Counselling other than Centralized Counseling:
- Sub categories, Priority for making admission under Defence Category, Para-Military and TA/RA Category & ICAR Nomination seats, Disabled Person Category of PAU, Ludhiana.
- For the above categories, counselling shall be done by I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala, whereas for other categories, counselling shall be done by the concerned Universities/Institutions, but the nominee of I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala, shall be associated for these counselling. However, Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana will itself admit candidates under Rural Quota (Except for SC Candidates) of B.Tech. First Year through counselling on the basis of merit criterion as per seat matrix before the start of online counseling by the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala.
- (ii) The students shall be liable to pay Fee / Development Fee and other charges as per the rates of Fee / Development Fee and other charges to the concerned College as fixed by the Government of Punjab/ AICTE / Concerned University, from time to time.
- (iii) The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt., Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25th April 2008 and Partial notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20th June 2008 and partial notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/171 dated 18th January, 2011 which are attached as Annexure.
- (iv) Counselling for 85% seats for Punjab residents and 15% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously. However, the reserved category candidates shall be considered in general category first before being considered in respective reserved category.
- (v) The College / University will issue a public notice on official website to this effect indicating clearly the number of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category in all the rounds of counselling.
- (vi) After following the above said procedure, if still the seats remain vacant in reserve category, the college / university can fill these from candidates belonging to general category in a subsequent step at the end of Centralized Counseling. Admission to such unfilled/vacant seats as well as management-quota shall be furnished to the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University and details thereof shall be finalized within 15 days of the last date of counselling.
- (vii) 85% seats would be reserved for the candidates from within the state of Punjab and 15% will be open to all candidates from outside the State. The eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidates should be a resident of Punjab State in terms of Punjab Govt., Department

of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II/9619 dated 6th June 1996 and letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II / 81 dated 1st Jan 1999, or have passed 10+1 and 10+2 examination as a regular candidate from recognized institutions situated in Punjab. However Children of Defence Personnel posted in Punjab are exempted from this condition to the extent that they should have passed only qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 from a recognized institution situated in Punjab. Each candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal / Head of Institution last attended in the prescribed Performa.

- (viii) **There shall be a joint Centralized Counselling by I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University with representatives from all the other Universities.**
- (ix) There shall be two rounds of Centralized Counselling by I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. The procedure of Centralized online Counselling will be decided by the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. Thereafter the direct admissions at the college level shall be allowed for vacant seats. The I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala will issue necessary instructions to the Institutions / University in this regard.
- (x) Any seat falling vacant after counselling or any drop out vacancy will be filled by the concerned private institute/college on the criteria of admission under management quota. A seat once accepted shall not be changed.
- (xi) The information about the eligibility for admission to degree courses in Engineering, Colleges and Departments of Universities and also about the institution / discipline / category-wise availability of seats and reservation of seats for various categories shall be made available by I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala on website www.ptu.ac.in.
- (xii) The last date, upto which students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason will be same as notified by the AICTE in its Academic Calendar or notified by the respective regulatory body from time to time. No student should be admitted in any institution after the last date under any quota. Hence admission to these courses shall be allowed only once in an academic session.
- (xiii) If any new Institution is approved or seats are increased/alterd in the existing institutions by the AICTE and such approval is received before the commencement of that particular round of counselling, I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University will publish on the official website and invite additional Choice preference from the registered candidates, at the till end of their original choices, without, however, altering the previous choice. These new institutes as well as existing Institutes having addition / alternation in seats shall be taken into consideration before the start of choice filling of that particular round.
- (xiv) The guidelines for admission for Foreign Nationals/Overseas Citizens of India/Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries shall be as per AICTE guidelines issued from time to time. However any Foreign National who had obtained School Leaving Certificate/ Diploma/ Degree in a Foreign Institution shall produce an Equivalency Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities for admission to an Institution/ University in India.
- (xv) The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/Overseas Citizens of India/Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries shall be as per AICTE guidelines issued from time to time.
- (xvi) The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per Notification of Punjab Government in this regard.
- (xvii) The guidelines for admission of Sikh minority community students to Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana and Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Engineering College, Fatehgarh Sahib shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 18/33/2001-GC(6)/4513 dated Chandigarh, the 3rd April, 2001.
- (xviii) Non refundable counselling fee of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) will be collected by the University as counselling fee from each student one time only.
- (xix) In case a student changes his / her / college / University allotted during Centralized Online Counselling conducted by I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala his / her fee

shall be refunded by the previous Institution after deduction of Rs. 1000/- only and the original documents will be returned immediately. However, in case of upgradation of seats during subsequent counselling no deduction shall be made.

- (xx) In case a student surrenders his / her seat within 7 days of the end of the Centralized Counseling, he / she must submit application to the College and register online on I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala website www.ptu.ac.in. I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall only forward such cases to the concerned colleges / Universities and colleges must refund his / her full fee after deduction of Rs. 1000/- only.
- (xxi) In keeping with the direction of Ministry of Human Resource Development Department, Govt. of India all Institutions and Universities shall in public interest, maintain a waiting list of students / candidates. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admissions against the vacant seat. The entire fees collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for institutions and universities to retain the certificates in original. If a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant gets filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the institution must return the fees collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable.
- (xxii) All Institutions affiliated to I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University and Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University shall follow 'Fee Waiver Scheme' as prescribed by AICTE and notified by Government of Punjab vide its notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/1797, dated 23rd May, 2011, Notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/2007 dated 31.5.2012, Letter No.751-752/S-I/ECC/2015 dated 13.05.2015 and Letter No. 428-430 dated 04.04.2019. Other Institutions / Universities may notify their respective fee waiver scheme separately.
- (xxiii) As per section 7 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016, use of Aadhaar Authentication Services while identifying beneficiaries and processing the benefit under any scholarship scheme* of government is mandatory. The Universities shall adhere to the guidelines and regulations defined by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI).

E. OVER-RIDING PROVISION

Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down in the judgment of the honorable Supreme Court of India in the case of TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) 8SCC 481: AIR 2003 SC 355). Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Department of Technical Education, Government of Punjab, for immediate rectification.


Subject : Standing Operation Procedure (SOP) for Admissions at IKGPTU Main Campus & Constituent Campuses for the Session 2023-24

The following procedure shall be followed for making Admissions in all the courses offered at IKGPTU Main Campus and its Constiuent Campuses for the Session 2023-24:-

1. **For AICTE / COA Courses** (i.e. B.Tech. 1st Year, B.Tech. Lateral Entry, B.Architecture, M.Tech. & MBA), the admissions shall be made through 2 Rounds of Centralized Online Counselling. Vacant Seats of Centralized Online Counselling shall be filled through Direct Counselling on First Come First Serve basis till the last date of Admission. If the number of applicants are more than the available number of Seats then the seat will be allocated on merit basis.
2. The students, who have deposited counselling fee and want to take direct admission in same course (for which counselling fee has deposited), then the deposited counselling fee shall be considered against Admission Processing fee.
3. **For UGC Courses** the admission shall be made through Direct Counselling. There shall be 2 Rounds of Direct Counselling, through which seats will be allocated after considering the reservation policy and merit of student. After end of 2 Rounds of Direct counselling the vacant seats will be converted in common pool and the same will be allocated on First Come First Serve basis till the last date of Admission. If the number of applicants are more than the available number of Seats then the seat will be allocated on merit basis.
4. Admission to all the students (except Admitted through Centralized Online Counselling) shall be made after doing Pre-Registration / Registration at University website www.ptu.ac.in. If any student has done Pre-registartion and paid Registartion Fee for AICTE / COA Course and also got seat through Centralized Online Counselling, then the amount of fee paid during Pre-Registration shall be refunded to concerned student. The Director/Incharge/HoD of concerned Campus shall be responsible to prepare a compiled report of such students and submit those case(s) to Finance & Account Departmetn through Dean (Academics) for refund.
5. The Director/Incharge/HoD of concerned Campus shall make sure that admission of only those students should be considered, who have done Pre-registration and paid the Registration Fee.
6. Admission Cell will share the Campus Registration data with Chairman (Student Call Centre / Help Desk Committee) on daily basis for their information and further necessary action.
7. Direct Counselling Schedule shall be prepared in coordination with Campus Director / Incharge in such a way that 2 Rounds of Direct Counselling be completed within 15 days.
8. First round of Direct Counselling for the UGC courses shall be completed within 7 days from the issuance of Notification of IKGPTU or declaration of result of qualifying exam Board / University, which ever occurs later. Students will directly report to the respective University Campus for admission latest by 12:00 PM (i.e. Amritsar, Mohali, Hoshiarpur and Kapurthala).
9. Admission Cell will prepare the Seat Matrix of all the Courses of Campuses and share the same with the Director / Incharge / HoD of the Main Campus and Constituent Campuses, which will be verified by the concerned Campus Director / Incharge / HoD before allotment of seat.
10. Merit shall strictly be prepared on the basis of Qualifying exam score.
11. The Students will require to submit all the necessary documents related to admissions and to pay the applicable semester fees on the same day of seat allotment. If the student is unable to fulfil these conditions then the allotted seat will be cancelled and awarded to the next candidate.

12. If number of applicants are more than the available seats, then the seat falling vacant shall be awarded to the next eligible student in the waiting list.
13. Student will be responsible for producing all certificates related to the category in which he/ she has applied. Student will not be granted the benefit of the said category if he/ she fails to produce the relevant certificates on the day of counselling.
14. Concerned Campus Director/In-Charge/HoD will be responsible for overall admission process.
15. Advertisement for the Direct Counselling Schedule of UGC/AICTE programs be published in the leading newspapers as and when required on priority basis.
16. HoD/In-Charge will be responsible for document verification and marking the attendance by candidates on the day of counselling. Further, they must ensure that candidate must submit documents that are minimum requirement for admission under different categories and time can be granted to the candidate to submit other documents.
17. HoD/In-Charge will be responsible for submission of merit list to the Rank Verification committee as per the format prepared by them. Rank verification committee will approve the merit list.
18. HoD/In-Charge will be responsible for allotment of seat after approval of merit list by Rank Verification committee.
19. The applicable semester fee shall be collected on the portal designed by Finance and Accounts Department as per Fee Structure and Admission Schedule notified by the University.
20. After allotment of seat, the concerned HoD/Incharge will verify the documents of the student and permit the student to pay the semester fee (as applicable) on the link provided by Finance and Accounts Department. The concerned HoD/Incharge will be responsible for collection of Fee and processing of refund cases (if submitted).
21. After confirmation of Semester Fee, the Concerned Campus Director / Incharge / HoD will issue Seat Confirmation letter to respective student.
22. As per Academic Calendar of AICTE for Session 2023-24, the classes will start from 15th September 2023. For Admission Session 2023-24, Induction Programme will start from 1st September 2023 (for 2 Weeks) and after 15th September 2023 (3rd week) Induction Programme will be run simultanously with regular classes.

Subject: Regarding Provisional admission under Post-Graduate Courses offered at Main Campus & Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU in Session 2023-24.

The following procedure shall be followed for provisional admission under Post-Graduate Courses (i.e. MBA, M.Tech., M.Arch., M.Planning & M.Sc. Courses) offered at Main Campus and Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU:-

1. The candidates seeking admission under Post-Graduate Courses, shall have to do Pre-registration at URL <https://admissions.ptu.ac.in/> and require to deposit Non-refundable Registration Fee of Rs. 2,000/- (if not paid earlier), which shall be adjusted against semester fee at the time of final admission.
2. Provisional Admissions in Post Graduate programs will be offered on the basis of merit of all previous semesters, except the final semester of the qualifying examination. However, it is compulsory to pass the last semester of Under Graduate course (qualifying examination) before the last date of admission, as notified by the respective Regulatory Body / University from time to time, otherwise his/her admission will be cancelled.
3. The candidate will have to give an undertaking at the time of Provisional Admission that if he/she does not fulfil the eligibility criteria, on the basis of which the candidate has got the admission, the seat allotted to such candidate shall stand cancelled.
Note : After the counselling or interview the tentative merit list / final merit list / seat allotted and waiting list will be displayed on website <https://admissions.ptu.ac.in/> as per the schedule notified. The candidate can check his/her status with regard to admission on website.
4. The candidate, who has been allotted a seat can deposit the tuition fee and other charges as notified vide Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/NF/AC/87 date 08/06/2023.
5. Full semester fee (as applicable) shall be charged from the candidate at the time of provisional admission. If a candidate withdraw his provisional seat on or before 31/08/2023, then the provisional admission fee shall be refunded (except Admission Processing Fee), otherwise no refund case will be considered after 31/08/2023.
6. Candidate may be allowed to deposit partial 50% of Semester fee at the time of admission, on case to case basis, on the recommendation of HoD(s) and approval of Dean (Academics). The remaining 50% of semester fee should be deposited on or before 31st August, 2023. The concerned HoD(s) will submit the details to Finance Department through Dean (Academics) on or before 15 Sept, 2023 for the reconciliation of fee as per the requirement of Finance Department.
7. After confirmation of provisional allotted seat the candidate will report to the concerned campus with all the original testimonials for verification.
8. The candidate seeking provisional admission shall have to fulfill the eligibility criteria of the respective Regulatory Body / University, else the provisional admission shall be cancelled, and

the candidate will have no right to claim the seat and refund of provisional admission Fee. An undertaking will be taken from the candidate in this regard.

9. The concerned Campus Director / HoD will keep the record of such candidates and submit the compiled report to Finance & Accounts Department through Dean (Academics) for reconciliation of fee.
10. The Finance and Accounts Department, IKGPTU shall make necessary provisions in this regard.



The scholarship scheme is implemented for the students of Main Campus and Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU for session 2023-24. The guidelines of the scheme are as under:

Category-1

B.Tech.: Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronic & Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering.

1. Scholarship equivalent to full tuition fee will be provided to the respective University/Board toppers in the qualifying examinations.
2. For University Main Campus, IKGPTU Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 90% marks in qualifying examination.
3. For University Main Campus, IKGPTU Scholarship equivalent to 25% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination.
4. For Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU- Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination.
5. For Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU- Scholarship equivalent to 25% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 70% marks in qualifying examination.

Category-II

M. Tech. Civil Engineering (Geotechnical Engineering), Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering (Power System & Renewable Energy), Electronics & Communication Engineering, (Wireless Communication Engineering) Mechanical Engineering (Manufacturing Engineering & Automation).

Scholarship equivalent to full tuition fee will be provided to the respective University toppers in the qualifying examinations.

Category-III

B. Arch, B. Planning

1. Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination (Average of 10+2 % age and NATA % age).
2. Scholarship equivalent to 25% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 70% marks in qualifying examination (Average of 10+2 % age and NATA % age).

Category-IV

M.Sc. (Chemistry/Clinical Research, Environment Science, Food Technology, Mathematics, Physics), MBA, M. Architecture, M. Planning and any other PG Courses except category -II above

1. Scholarship equivalent to full tuition fee will be provided to the respective University toppers in the qualifying examinations.
2. For University Main Campus, IKGPTU, Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 90% marks in qualifying examination.
3. For Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination.

Category-V


B.Sc. Non-Medical B.SC.(Honours)- Chemistry, Food Technology, Mathematics, Physics, BBA, BCA, BHMCT, BA(JMC), Integrated and Dual Degree Courses offered and any other UG Courses,

1. For University Main Campus, I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University Kapurthala - Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 90% marks in qualifying examination.
2. For University main campus, IKGPTU Scholarship equivalent to 25% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination.
3. For Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU- Scholarship equivalent to 50% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 80% marks in qualifying examination.
4. For Constituent Campuses of IKGPTU- Scholarship equivalent to 25% tuition fee will be provided to the candidates who have secured more than 70% marks in qualifying examination.
5. Scholarship equivalent to full tuition fee will be provided to the respective university toppers in the qualifying examinations.

General conditions for the continuation of the scholarship in higher semester

1. For the continuation of the scholarship, the student must secure a minimum of 8 SGPA in every semester without any reappear at any stage. If SGPA falls below 8 in any semester, he/she shall lose claim further during his course tenure.
2. A Student can avail only one scholarship scheme at a time.
3. He/She must have shown good conduct throughout the session.
4. In case of student is upgraded to higher semester and failed to qualify the eligibility at Point No. 1, the scholarship will be ceased to exist, and he/she will have to pay the full fee subsequently. The concerned HoD will ensure to update the fee record in consultation with Finance & Accounts Department IKGPTU.
