In Model Making, Robin (B.Sc.-FT) got first position, Vivek Kumar Sonkar-Yashwant Kumar got second position.

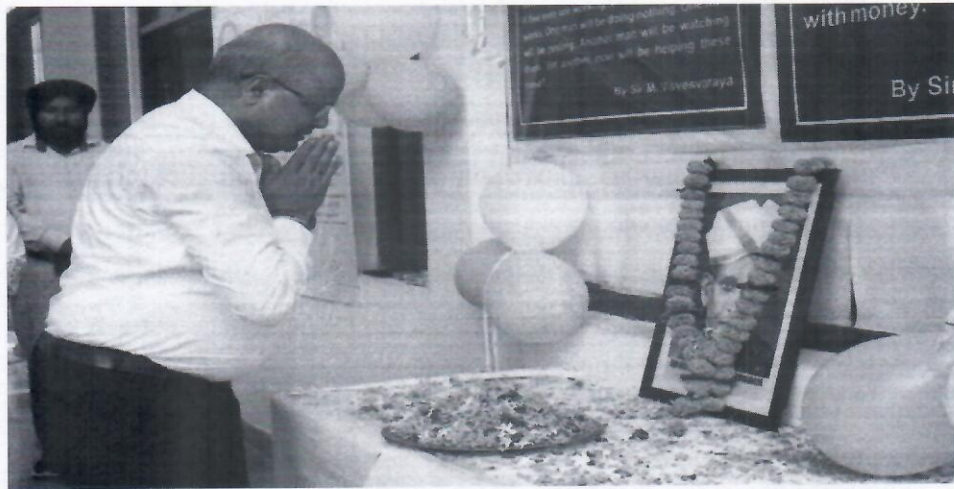
