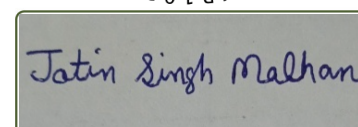

GATE SCORE COMPUTATION

The GATE 2025 score is calculated using the formula:

$$\text{GATE Score} = S_q + (S_t - S_q) \frac{(M - M_q)}{(\bar{M}_t - M_q)}$$

where,

M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the test paper mentioned on the GATE 2025 Score Card

M_q is the qualifying marks for general category candidates in the test paper

$\bar{M}_t$ is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of all the candidates who appeared in the test paper

S_q = 350, is the score assigned to M_q, and

S_t = 900, is the score assigned to $\bar{M}_t$

In the GATE 2025 score formula, the qualifying marks (M_q) for the general category candidate in each subject will be :
Cut-off marks for GENERAL category = max(25, min(40, $\mu + \sigma$)). Here μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of positive marks of all the candidates who appeared in the test paper.

Qualifying in GATE 2025 does not guarantee admission to a postgraduate program or scholarship/financial assistance. Admitting institutes may conduct additional tests or interviews for final selection of candidates.

It gives me pleasure to inform you that you have been selected for admission to the DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (PHD) in MATERIALS SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING on Full-Time (Teaching A/ship) basis subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. You need to deposit the first installment of Institute dues amounting to Rs. 22400.0/- (For SC) through the payment link provided on the application portal, latest by 17-Jul-2025, failing which the offer of admission will automatically stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the panel
2. Your Admission is provisional subject to :-
 - a. Production of the qualifying Degree Certificate and Mark Sheets showing the required percentage of marks /CGPA by 19.07.2025/31.10.2025*
 - b. Production of proof of having appeared/passed in the qualifying degree examination
 - c. Production of GATE/NET/DST/INSPIRE/National Exam Certificate
 - d. Production of OBC/EWS/SC/ST/PwD Certificate (for respective category candidates)
 - e. Production of Relieving Certificate from Employer (for working professionals)

*If you are in the final year of your qualifying examination, you must inform Academic (P.G.) Section, IIT Delhi in writing about the requirements of your qualifying degree including Viva-Voce are not met on the date of registration. Failure to inform the Academic (P.G.) Section about non-completion shall result in the forfeiture of the entire fees deposited by you, in addition to cancellation of admission. If you are already enrolled in a program at IIT Delhi or any other institution, and you have received an offer to join a new program at IIT Delhi, you must resign from your current Programme before joining the IIT Delhi and submit the details in written to the Academic Section, IIT Delhi at the time of registration.

3. You will have to produce a Medical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format (available on application portal). The admission is subject to being found medically fit.
4. You will be required to give an undertaking to the effect, inter alia, that you would not leave the programme midway or appear in any competitive examination etc., without the prior permission of the Institute.
5. You will be governed by the Rules and Regulation of the Institute in force from time to time.
6. You must submit your documents and attend Orientation on a dates as per Schedule to be notified through the Institute Webpage (<https://home.iitd.ac.in/pg-admissions.php>). If due to unavoidable circumstances, you cannot do so by the given dates, you may, with the prior permission of Dean Academics, approved in writing, register until the last date of Late Registration for Semester 1, 2025-2026, given on the Institute calendar (<https://home.iitd.ac.in/academic-calendar.php>). Failing this permitted "late registration", the offer of admission would automatically stand cancelled, even if you have already paid the Institute and/or Hostel dues.

7. You will be required to renew your registration every semester which is done centrally, normally in July and December every year. On your failure to do so, your registration as Institute Student will stand terminated.
8. You are required to open an Account with the State Bank of India/Canara Bank (in case you don't have one) and intimate your Account number to the J.R. (Accounts).
9. In case, you have already been selected for admission in any other Deptt./ Centre / School/ Programme of this Institute, you will have to resign from the Deptt./ Centre/ School/ Programme before joining this Deptt./ Centre/ School/Programme.

10. This offer of admission does not guarantee on-campus accommodation.

The Institute will strive to provide a hostel seat (on sharing basis only) to selected female candidates, candidates with special needs (SwD - Students with Disabilities, formally admitted as PwD) and foreign nationals, to the extent possible, only on request and subject to availability. Male students are not eligible for hostel accommodation generally before completion of 1 full academic year. Full time PhD students may be eligible for House Rent Allowance as per rule, if they do not avail on-campus accommodation (including non-allotment after application). For this they may contact drpgsr@admin.iitd.ac.in

11. All candidates admitted with Assistantship / Scholarship will be required to render 8 hours of work per week outside the normal academic work as per advice of the respective Department/Centre. Their assistantship/scholarship will be notified by the Academic (P.G.) Section on submission and verification of the documents mentioned in para 2 above.

For Sponsored Full Time/Part Time and all other Part Time Students only

12. The conditions prescribed for your admission to the said programme on Sponsored (Full-time)/Part-time status shall continue to be fulfilled by him/her during the entire period of his/her study at this Institute. In case, you change your employer during the period of study at this Institute, you will immediately inform the HOD of the same and furnish "No Objection Certificate"/Sponsorship Certificate" afresh from your new employer.
13. You will not be provided hostel accommodation by the Institute.

For all Ph.D. Research Scholars

14. You will be governed by the Ph.D. Ordinances and Regulations in force from time to time.
15. The duration of the Ph.D. Programme is five years under normal circumstances. This period may be further extended up to a maximum of seven years on the merit of each case. On failure to submit the thesis within this maximum period, your registration as Institute student will automatically stand terminated. The minimum period of registration for those who have an M.Tech. Degree or its equivalent shall be two years and for those with B.Tech. or its equivalent would be three years.
16. You will apply for registration of topic of research and for the appointment of research supervisor(s) on the prescribed form within 3 months of registration /joining the Department/Centre/ School/ IDP.
