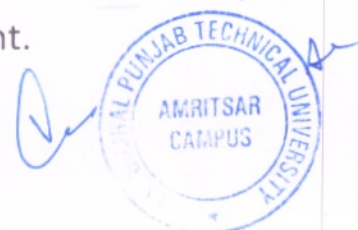




INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (21 JUNE 2024)

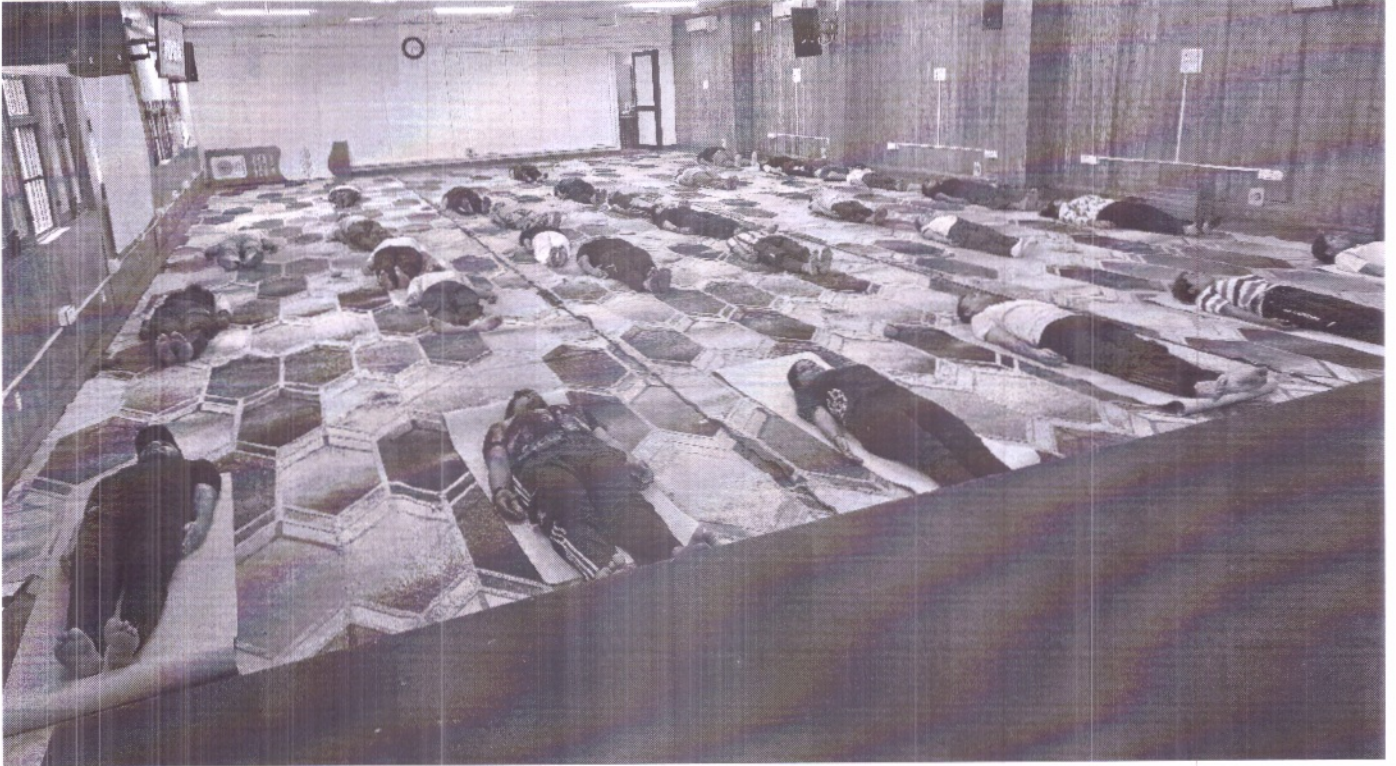

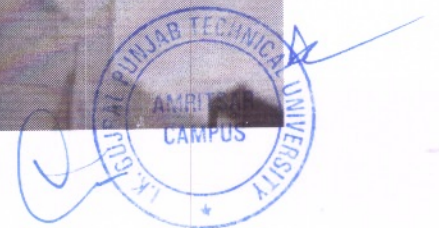
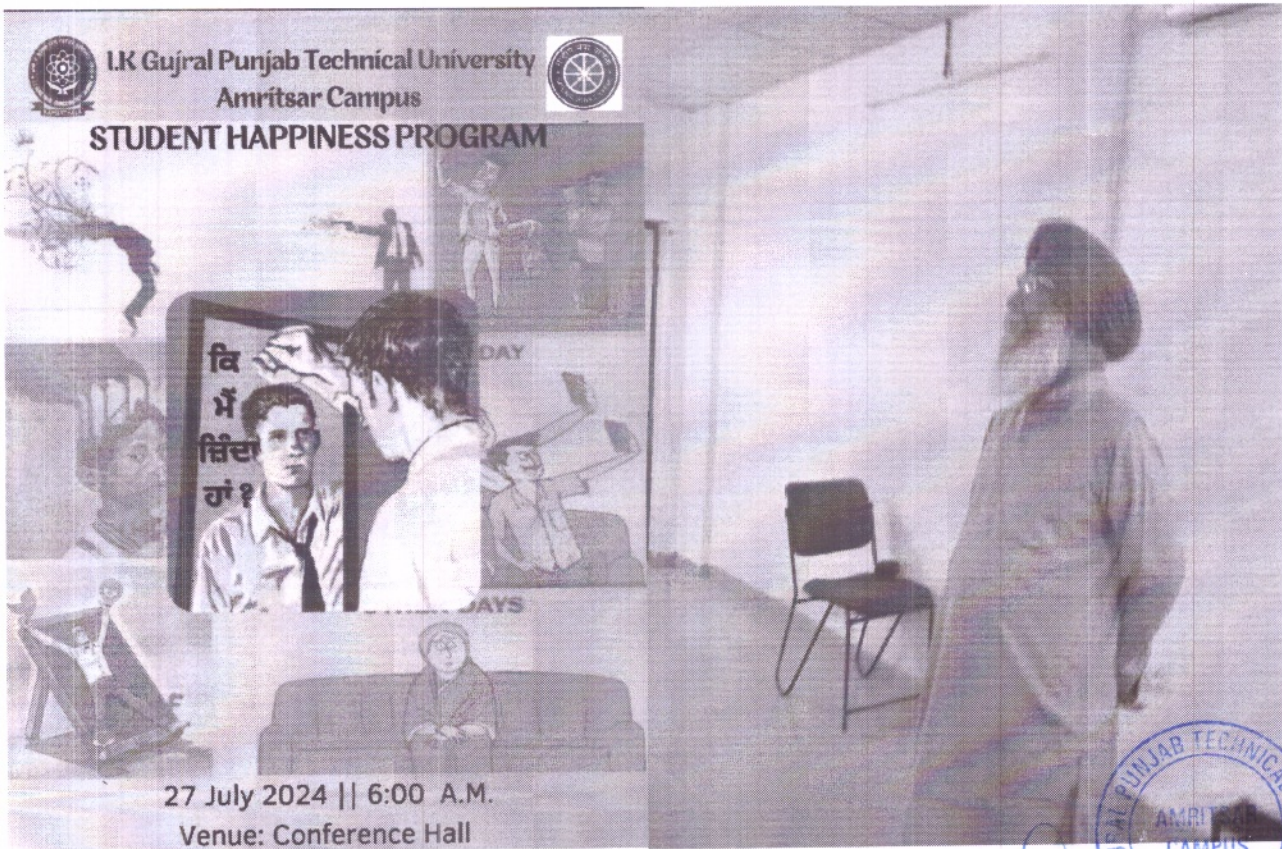
KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS (26 JULY 2024)

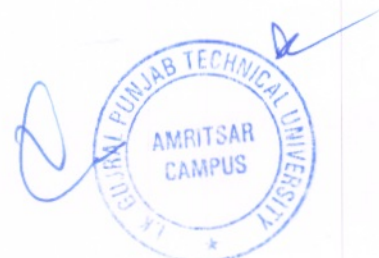
INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION (AZADI KA AMRIT MOHATSAAV)

It was a day of reflection, joy, and patriotism, as students and staff came together to honor India's journey to independence.



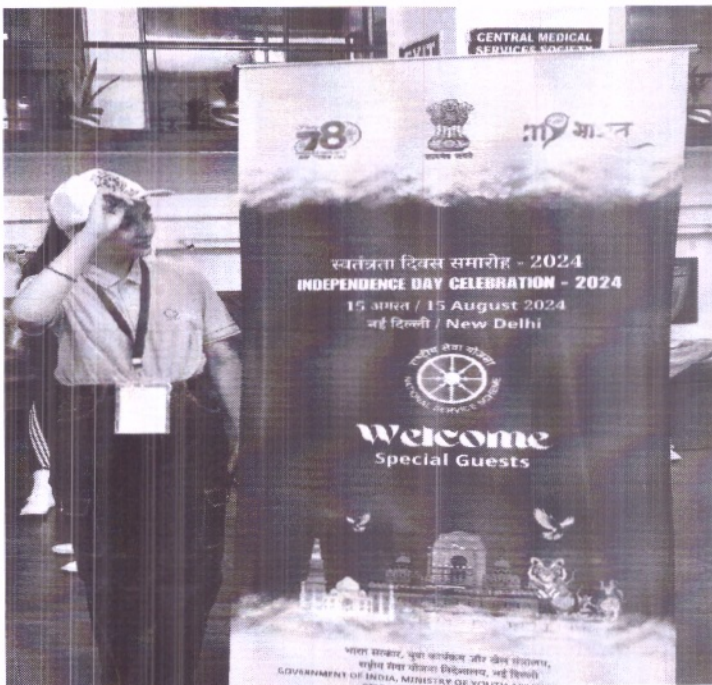

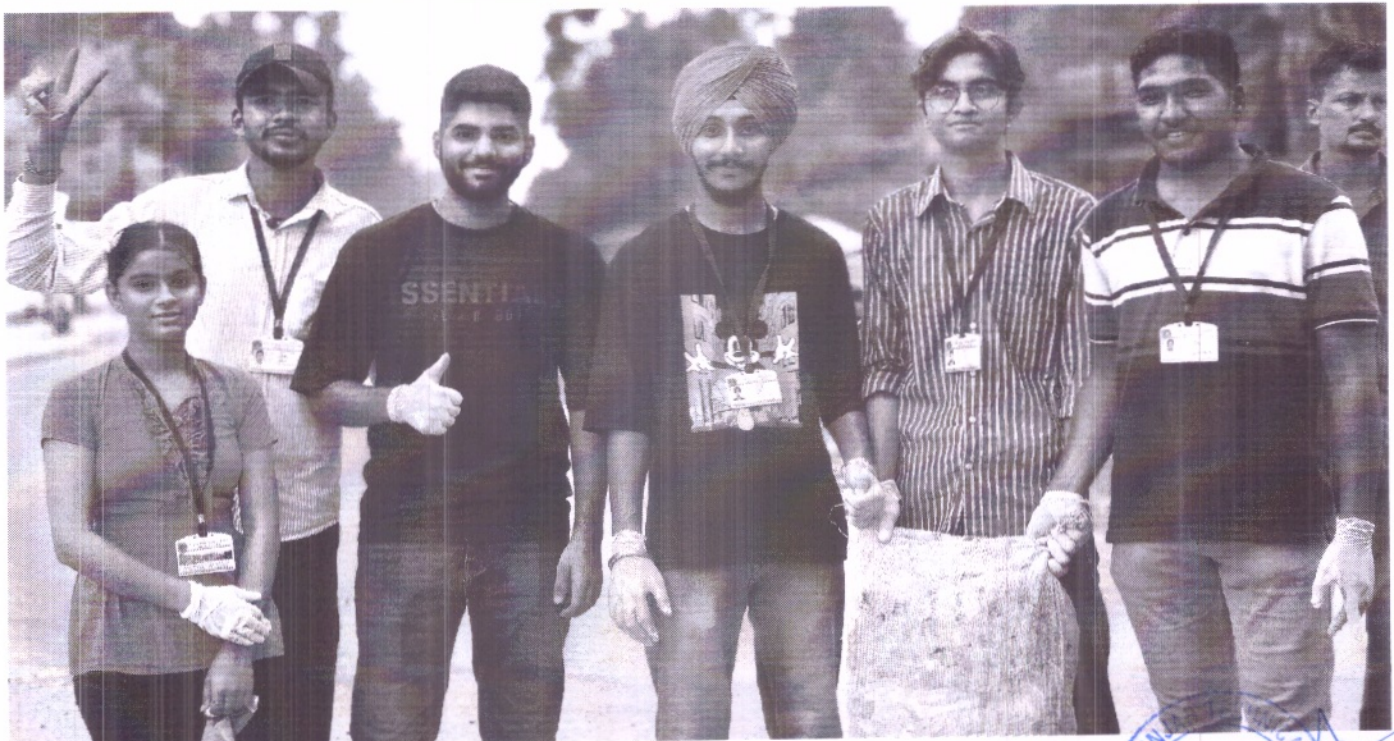
GURPREET KAUR GOT SELECTED FOR IDC CAMP 2024

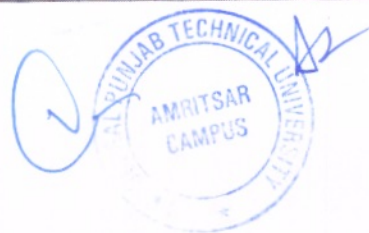
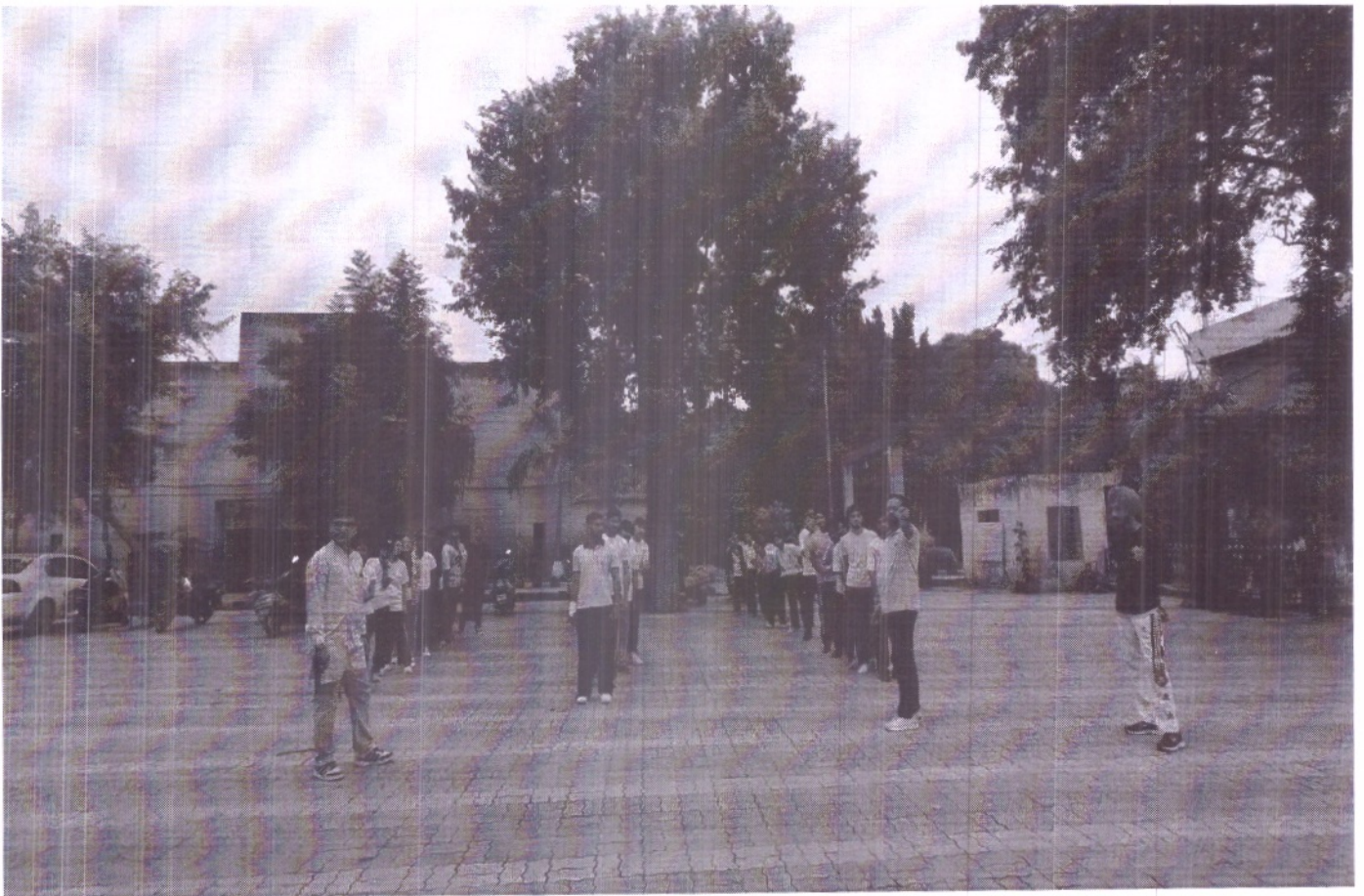
CONDOLENCES TO SHRI RATAN TATA SIR BY NSS UNIT

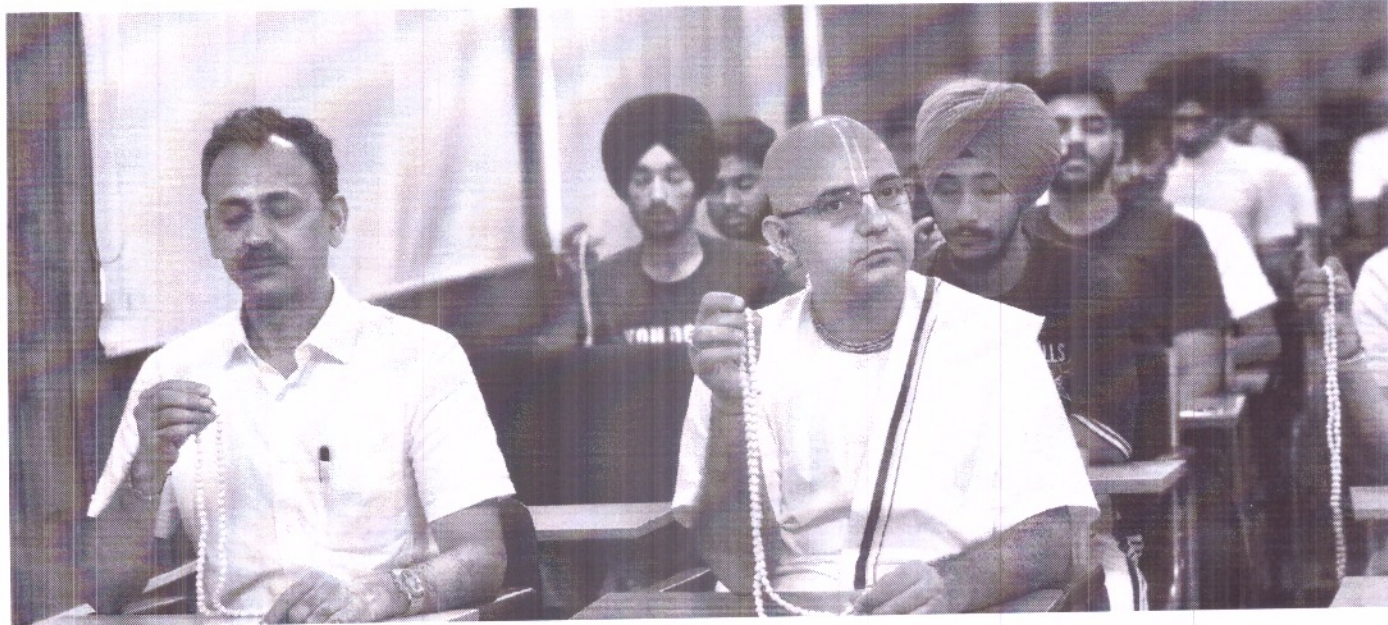

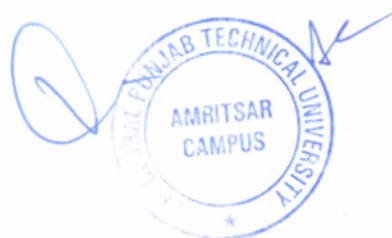






KASHISH (BTECH CSE 5TH SEM) GOT SELECTED FOR NATIONAL CAMP

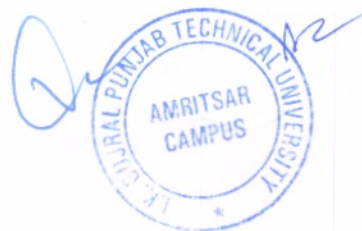

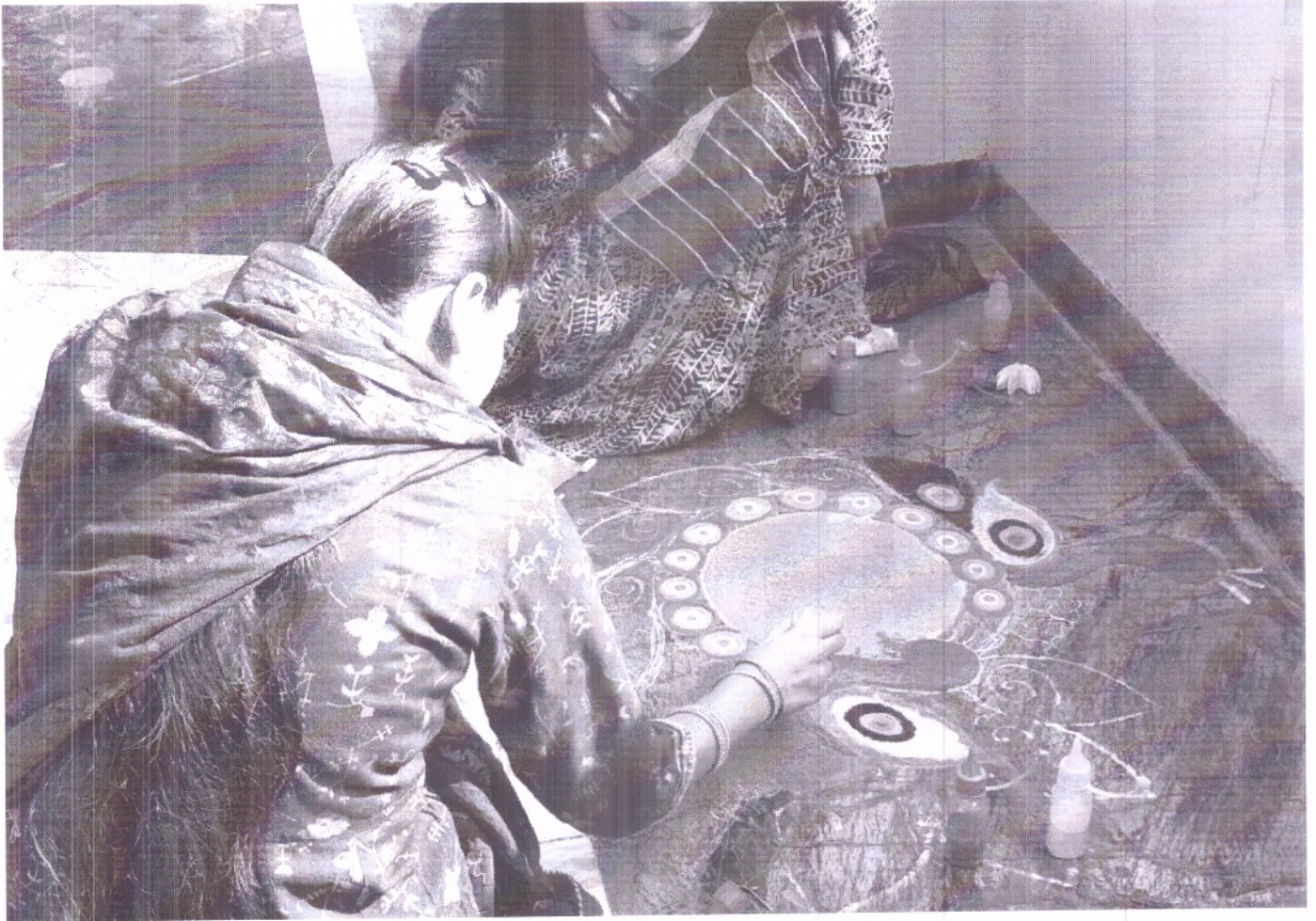

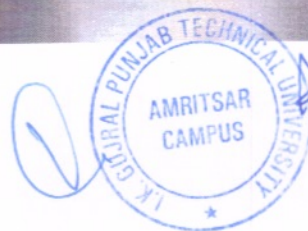
SHP STUDENT HAPPINESS PROGRAM (CHANGI SOCH VADDE FAIDE)

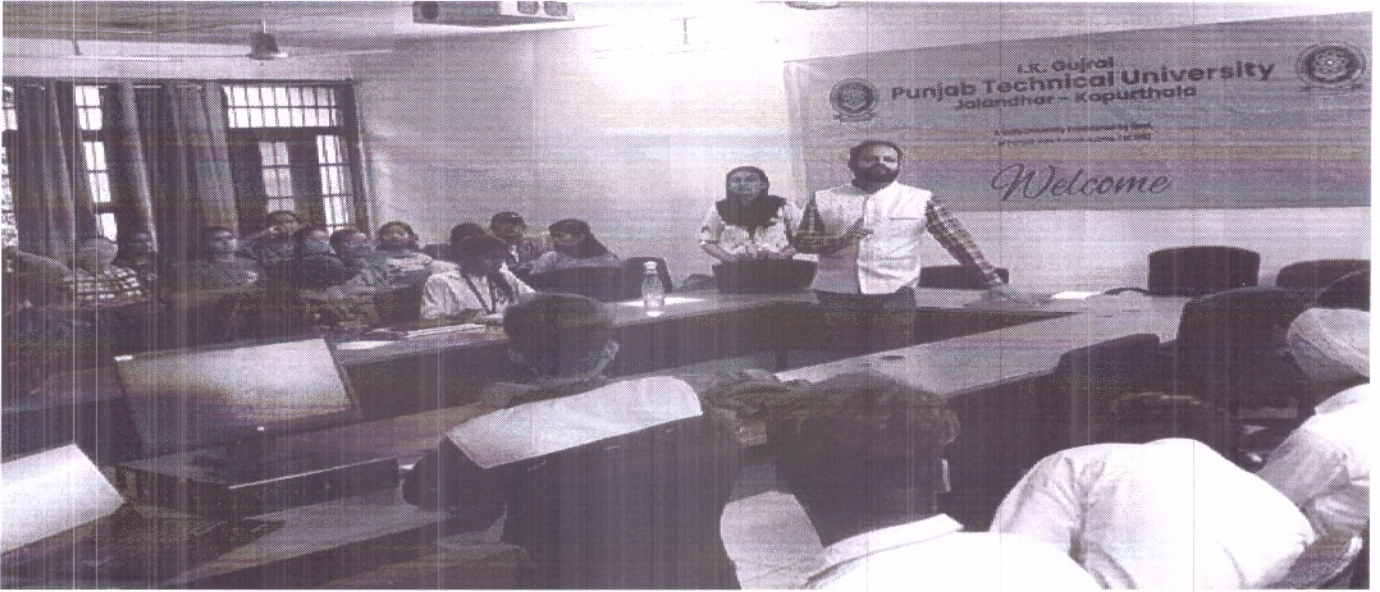
The camp concluded with a Prize Distribution Ceremony, celebrating the active participation and achievements of the students. The event was a great success and contributed significantly to their overall learning and development.
