Stage 2: DVV

At the time of DVV verification process no clarifications were sought from IKGPTU. Hence, the input provided by IKGPTU at the time of DVV and SSR should be same. However, in the revised SSR the response of HEI has changed to 0.64, whereas, the HEI input and supporting documents remain same.

Stage 3: Appeal

Reasons for Appeal:

The following documents (as per the SOP of NAAC) can be seen to substantiate the claim of IKGPTU:

1. Since the HEI input in the DVV and Revised SSR remains unchanged and same supporting documents are uploaded, the response of HEI has been revised from 0.49 to 0.64.
