DVV Recommendation / Remarks: No recommendation / remark were given by DVV.

Stage 3: Appeal

Reasons for Appeal:

1. In the data template of 3.4.4 no column of teachers recognized as supervisors is available. This data is taken from data template of metric 2.4.2. During the data transfer by mistake the number of teachers as recognized guides was taken as 77 instead of **75**.
2. According to HEI's PhD ordinances, the total number of teachers recognized as PhD guide during the assessment year will be 75 instead of 77. That is the revised value of sub-metric 3.4.4.2 is

2.4.4.2 Number of teachers recognized as guides during the last five years: 75

3. Considering this revised value of metric 3.4.4.2, the number of PhD awarded per teacher during the last five years will be $109/75=1.45$ (instead of 1.42).
4. Maximum number of faculty members joined the university in the year 2016 and hence the students were enrolled for PhD thereafter. Keeping in view the allowed duration to complete PhD, enrolled students are currently carrying out their research work. While grading this metric the above point may be considered.

Appeal:

In view of the above points, HEI appeals that revised data of sub-metric 3.4.4.2 be considered as 75 and HEI feels that it deserves to be graded up for this metric to 4.
