2.0 The guidelines/regulations for admission are as under:-

A. Eligibility Criteria (Educational Qualifications & Resident Status)

The eligibility criteria for admission shall be same as notified by the University. (Annexure - A).

- (i) For admission to the UGC (Non-AICTE) Courses, 85% seats shall be open for the candidates from within the State and 15% will be open for the candidates from outside the State.
- (ii) Admission will be made on the basis of rank prepared based on inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination (Weightage of 5% in the marks obtained in qualifying examination shall be awarded to those candidates who have studied for atleast three years or have passed their +1 and +2 examination from the schools located in Rural Area) for both 85% quota for resident of Punjab and 15% quota for outside Punjab. (Format of Rural Area is attached at **Annexure B).**

B. General Eligibility Criteria for Admissions :

Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as contained in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, Memo No.35/44/95/T (2) 978 dated 21st March 2003, which is attached at Annexure - C to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

Exemption Under above para

Children/wards/dependent (Whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab-cadre, serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations /Statutory Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1st January, 2019.

C. Reservation:

- (i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13 / 2/05 -1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013, which is attached at **Annexure D** to this notification or as notified by Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training from time to time. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
- (ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for online counselling. If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Candidate".
- (iii) The I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the online application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any under which reservation is being sought, so that inter se gradation can be facilitated. There sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo No.13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 which is attached as Annexure. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013.
- (iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make a claim for reservation in any of the reserved category. However, the procedure for a counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo No. 7/21/2004-RS1/1674-1677 dt. 20th Dec. 2004.

D. Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for Non-AICTE Courses:

As per IKGPTU Notification Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/N/3767 dated 27/11/2018, which is attached at **Annexure – E**, the Tuition Fee Waiver scheme shall also be applicable on Non-AICTE courses on the pattern of AICTE courses as notified by the Punjab Government (attached at **Annexure – F)** from time to time.

E. Fee & Other charges:

The students shall be liable to pay fee/ development fee and other charges as per the rates of fees/ development fee and other charges as notified by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, at the time of admission. Notification Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/NF/2061 dated 23/05/2019 is attached at **Annexure – G.**

G. Procedure for Admission:

- (i) The colleges / Institutes shall display, on the website of the college, the dates to apply for these courses and dates of the counseling, wherever, possible the counseling will be made online.
- (ii) The counseling will be made purely on the basis of merit and should be displayed to the students.

(iii) Preparation of Merit list

- (1) There will be a common merit lists for General and Reserved categories / subcategories (if applicable) candidates.
- (2) The rank of the candidates in the merit list securing equal marks will be in accordance with the following criteria:
 - (a) The candidate securing higher aggregate percentage marks in the qualifying examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
 - (b) In the case of tie in (a) above, the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in order of merit.
- (iv) Counseling for 85% seats of Punjab residents and 15% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously. However, the reserved category candidates shall be considered in general category, first before being considered in the respective category.
- (v) The college will issue a public notice on official website to this effect indicating clearly the number of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category in all the rounds of counseling.
- (vi) Institute must complete atleast two rounds of counseling based on rank in inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination considering the respective reserve category, as applicable by Punjab Govt.
- (vii) After following above said procedure, if still the seats remaining vacant in reserve category, the college can fill these from candidates belonging to general category in subsequent step at the end of counseling.
- (viii) The whole process will cease on the last date of admission as applicable i.e. 15th September of each year.
- (ix) The candidate must have passed qualifying examination at the time of admission.
- (x) The candidates having compartment/re-appear in qualifying examination can be admitted provisionally, however, such candidates are required to pass the qualifying examination before the commencement of 1st semester examination of University.
- (xi) The college/Institute must upload the list of admitted students on the webportal of the University latest by 22nd September, 2019, however, in case of any discrepancy, the institutes/Colleges are allowed to submit it as a hard copy to the University, by all means, upto 29th September, 2019.
- (xii) The application along with all qualification certificates should be produced in original for the eligibility check. Specimen Application form to be filled by the candidate desirous of taking admission to these courses is attached at **Annexure H**.
- (xiii) Colleges will upload the data of the candidate admitted by them in each round of counseling on University webportal and shall deposit non refundable admission processing fee amounting to Rs. 2,000/- (Rupee two thousand only) for each student simultaneously.
- (xiv) College will verify the original documents of the candidates and ensure that the eligibility is fulfilled before making admission. An undertaking will be submitted by the institute alongwith the updated list of the students that all the admitted students fulfill the eligibility criteria.
- (xv) The documents in original are required to be produced to the university for eligibility check.
- (xvi) The Fee structure for Foreign National/PIO shall be the same as was in vogue for NRI candidates.

(xvii) The guidelines for admission of Foreign National/PIO shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.

H. Refund of Fee Guidelines:

The competent authority has approved the following guidelines for refund / adjustment of fees for Constituent Campuses and Affiliated Colleges of IKGPUT for Academic session 2019-20:

General Terms

- (i) Application for the seat surrender should be submitted to the head of the concerned Department / Institution.
- (ii) Counselling fee is non-refundable.
- (iii) The refund cases will be processed within 15 days after the surrender of the seat.
- (iv) Start of Academic session will be as per Academic calendar issued by IKGPTU.
- (v) There will be no charges for change of course or branch within an institution.
- (vi) Security fee is refundable in all cases.

Refund Rules for AICTE & UG courses (for both Centralized and Direct Counselling)

- (i) In case a student surrenders his/her seat before the start of the course, his/ her total fee will be refunded after deduction of Rs. 1000/- only.
- (ii) In case a student surrenders his/ her seat after the start of the course and before /on last date of admission to that course, he/she will be refunded fee with proportionate deduction of total monthly fee (full fee including development and other charges) and proportionate total hostel rent (all charges). For instance, if a course starts in the month of July and the student surrenders seat on any day of August, fee will be deducted for FULL months of July & August.
- (iii) In case a student surrenders his / her seat after the last date of admission to that course, he/ she will not be refunded any fee.

I. Over Riding Provision:

Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the Act or Regulations of the university, any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the university clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification. The decision of the competent authority of the university in all such matters shall be final and binding on all concerned.
