## RUSTICATION AND EXPULSION

- The Principal of a College shall have the power to expel or rusticate a student for sufficient reasons including acts indiscipline and misconduct of inside or outside the College.
- 2. Before rusticating or expelling a student an enquiry shall be held and adequate and reasonable opportunity shall be given to the student concerned to explain his position and a complete record of the case shall be maintained.
- 3. Each case of order of rustication or expulsion shall be reported to the Registrar of the University by the Principal of the College concerned without delay after the order has been passed by him and it shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by the Principal to the effect that the student had been given adequate and reasonable opportunity to explain his position before the order was passed.
- 4. The Principal may, for reasons to be recorded, review and amend his order within ten days of the original order. The amended order so passed alongwith reasons shall be reported without delay to the Registrar of the University. The Registrar shall place the amended order before the BOG for its approval.
  - Provided that no order of rustication or expulsion shall be revised by the Principal after it has been notified under Ordinance 5 infra
- 5. The Registrar will enter the order of rustication/ expulsion in the Register of students and notify it to all the affiliated Colleges and other Universities in India on expiry of fifteen days from the date of order.
- 6. As soon as rustication or expulsion of a student has been notified by the University to the Colleges, his name shall be removed from the rolls of the College and he shall not pay any fees to the College during the period of rustication or expulsion.
- 7. Rustication shall mean the loss of one academic year i.e. the student concerned shall not be allowed to appear in any University examination during the academic year in which he is rusticated, and his name will be removed from the rolls of the College/University from the date the Principal passes the orders of rustication. A rusticated student may rejoin the same class in the same college with the permission of the Principal concerned during the days of admission in the following academic year or subsequently within the period permitted under the Ordinances.
- 8. A student who is expelled from a College shall not be readmitted to the same or any other College without the sanction of the BOG. Except as provided in Ordinance 9 infra, an expelled student shall not be allowed to appear in any University examination during the academic year in which he is expelled and the next following year and his name shall be removed from the rolls of the College/ University from the date the Principal passes the order of expulsion.
- 9. If the Vice Chancellor is of the view before or after notification that the order of a Principal rusticating or expelling a student requires revision in the light of new facts which come to his knowledge, the Vice Chancellor may bring the matter to the notice of the BOG whose decision shall be final.
- 10. In case of indiscipline created by a student of another College, the Principal shall have the right to bring the facts to the notice of the Principal of the College to which the student belongs and also to the notice of the Vice Chancellor. The Vice Chancellor may take cognizance of the fact for appropriate action in the matter including expulsion/ rustication on the basis of the report of the Enquiry Committee constituted by him.
