Minutes of meeting of UID Implementation Committee held under the chairmanship of Worthy Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab on 24/07/2014 at 3:00 PM in Committee Room, 6th Floor, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh.

A meeting of UID Implementation Committee was held under the Chairmanship of Worthy Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab on 24/07/2014 at 3:00 PM in Committee Room, 6th Floor, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh. Following officers attended the meeting:

The following issues were discussed during the meeting and decision taken thereof:

1. **Aadhaar: Infrastructure built and its utility in Punjab**

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID Punjab briefed the committee on the uniqueness of Aadhaar and related infrastructure created in Punjab and its potential usage. He informed that UID Punjab has created a database of almost entire state population, State Resident Data Hub(SRDH), which should be used for verification and standardization of databases of all State/Central Social Security and Welfare Schemes. He explained that this verification/standardization can be done through live Web-portal. He further briefed that UID Punjab has already tested and operationalized the Demographic/Biometric Authentication Services which could be used by various departments for their respective applications. Advisor, Planning Commission termed the SRDH as a 'Goldmine' and emphasised that the state should utilise it to its fullest potential to improve effectiveness of various schemes. The demonstration for Aadhaar Authentication and eKYC was also given by the UID Punjab and UIDAI Regional Office staff. The Committee appreciated the efforts of UID Punjab for development of core infrastructure. The Chairman directed that:

- Services like SRDH, eKYC and Authentication should be used for all beneficiary oriented and service delivery schemes.

- Secretary Planning will coordinate with all the departments to identify the areas where the above mentioned services can be used and will make efforts to get these implemented. (Action by : Secretary Planning, Nodal officer UID Punjab)

2. Aadhaar based Beneficiary Management for efficient digitization/de-duplication of data

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID Punjab informed the committee that the Food & Civil Supplies, Punjab has achieved 33% of the Aadhaar seeding into already digitized PDS database. He explained that the department carried out a comprehensive de-duplication exercise leveraging the SRDH and has identified substantial number of potentially duplicate beneficiaries. Secretary Food confirmed that the department will take action to retain only genuine beneficiaries and delete the duplicate/bogus records.


The Aadhaar seeding status of various central schemes was discussed. Scheme wise status reported is as under:

- I. Post Matric Scholarship for SC Students: Total Beneficiaries: 197406, UID Available: 106078 Aadhaar seeding: 53.74 %
- II. Post Matric Scholarship for Minorities: Total Beneficiaries: 75035, UID Available: 30036 Aadhaar seeding: 40.03 %
- III. NSAP: Total Beneficiaries: 171894, UID Available: 34365 Aadhaar seeding: 20 %
- IV. MGNREGA: Total Registered workers: 1889202, UID Available: 508695 Aadhaar seeding: 26.93 %

DDG, UIDAI, RO informed that UT administrations of Chandigarh and Pondicherry have already achieved 100% seeding milestone in all welfare schemes and seeding status in Himachal schemes is above 90%. DDG, UIDAI, RO further brought to notice of the Committee that seeding needs to be improved in all the schemes in Punjab. The Chairman instructed that:

- Aadhaar seeding in PDS data base should increase to minimum 60 % by the end of next month. (Action by : Secretary Food, Nodal officer UID Punjab)
- Complete beneficiaries data base of MNREGA scheme be seeded with Aadhaar numbers within next one month. (Action by : Joint Development Commissioner DRDP)
- ✓ For scholarship schemes the concerned departments to ensure that there is atleast 80 % Aadhaar seeding in scholarship data base and all payments are made to Aadhaar linked bank accounts. (Action by : Secretary Welfare)
- Secretary Planning should hold meetings with concerned departments to identify the schemes where Aadhaar can be linked. Some of the schemes Nodal Officer proposed where Aadhaar linkage can be done includes welfare schemes like Shagun, Scholarships, Pensions, Dhanlaxmi and Bhagat Puran Singh Bima Yojna etc. (Action by : Secretary Planning, Nodal officer UID Punjab)

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID Punjab informed the committee that his team has developed a Beneficiary Management System (BMS) tool to facilitate departments in digitization and de-duplication of beneficiaries. Chairman approved the proposal and gave a go ahead to UID Punjab to

assist the departments in such exercises and directed Secretary Planning to monitor such exercise from time to time. (Action by : Secretary Planning, Nodal officer UID Punjab)

3. Enrolment Status and PECs

Nodal Officer Registrar UID Punjab informed the committee that state has not only achieved 93.5% enrolment but also got 88% Aadhaar generated. Further, as the majority of the left out population are children and aged, he proposed that district level campaigns may be launched, through the field level staff of Department of Social Security (as the department deals with both the children and the aged), to ensure that maximum population is covered under Aadhaar. DDG, UIDAI, RO suggested that certificates may be obtained from respective schools/colleges with respect to seeding of Aadhaar numbers for respective scholarship/other welfare schemes and in case of gaps, targeted enrolments camps should be planned through mobile kits.

Nodal Officer further informed the committee that as per the decision taken in previous UIDC meeting, 127 Permanent Enrolment Centres with 166 kits have been made operational. He informed that Registrar UID has distributed around Rs.47 lacs as an advance funds across all districts to support the initial expenses for 6 months for running of permanent enrolment centre. He informed that more than 12 districts have even become financially self-sustainable.

The Chairman approved the proposal and directed to:

- Constitute of District level committees under respective DCs with DSSOs/CDPOs and DFSCs as members, to monitor the progress of enrolment of left outs. Secretary Planning will write to DCs and well as hold a meeting with Director, Social Security to get this implemented. (Action by : Secretary Planning, Nodal officer UID Punjab)
- Start targeted enrolments camps in the schools/colleges after assessing the requirements from the certificates obtained from respective schools with respect to seeding of Aadhaar numbers for respective scholarship/other welfare schemes. (Action by : Administrative Secretary Higher Education, Administrative Secretary School Education, Registrar UID Punjab)
- Setup at least 1 machine per Suwidha centre and Tensil Office to further step up enrolments. (Action by : Registrar UID Punjab)

4. Pilots for ICT Applications

Nodal Officer briefed the Committee that the ICT Proposal has been revised based upon the recommendations of the committee formed during the previous UIDIC. He explained that five applications i.e. PDS, Transport, Education, Revenue and Suwidha will be developed as Pilot Projects for Aadhaar based service delivery under ICT funds. Nodal Officer further informed the Committee that UID Punjab team has already tested the Point of Sale (PoS) devices (including Android and Web Applet) and State is ready for doing Aadhaar authentication based pilot for Food Distribution in PDS. DDG, RO explained that the learnings from these pilots that will help departments take policy level decisions after including adequate exception handling mechanisms in the system for state wise roll-out.

ICT proposal was discussed and it was decided that pilots of Aadhaar enablement of PDS, Registration and Suwidha applications will be executed after inserting due exception handling mechanisms. Though the representatives from Transport and Education Departments were not available in the meeting, the Committee approved the ICT proposal in principle subject the consent of both the departments. The Chairman directed Secretary Planning to hold a meeting with

Administrative Secretaries of Transport and Education Departments and get their formal consent on the proposal as to whether they intend to develop UID integrated ICT applications by themselves or with the help of UID ICT End to End to Solution Provider. Accordingly, the approved ICT proposal will be forwarded to UIDAI with in two weeks. (Action by : Financial Commissioner Revenue, Principal Secretary Governance Reforms, Secretary Planning, Secretary Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs cum Registrar UID Punjab)

5. Sub-AUA and KUA

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID, Punjab proposed the Chairman to issue instructions to the respective state departments to become sub-AUA and sub-KUA of State Nodal Agency i.e. Department of Food, Civil Supplies, Punjab as this technical requirement is mandatory to start Aadhaar based services. The committee approved the said proposal. (Action by : Respective Administrative Secretaries, Nodal Officer, Registrar UID Punjab)

6. Steering Committee to oversee Aadhaar enablement of departments

Nodal Officer explained that due to busy schedule of worthy Chief Secretary and other Administrative Secretaries, it becomes difficult to get routine decisions ratified under UIDIC and proposed that a steering committee may be set up to periodically review the progress of Aadhaar related initiatives across the departments. Chairman UIDIC formed a committee under the chairmanship of Secretary Planning with Director Welfare, Director Social Security, Director Food, Director Governance Reforms, Director Transport and Director Land Records as members. The steering committee will take all routine decisions and monitor digitization/seeding/de-duplication exercise of all welfare/beneficiaries oriented or DBT schemes and Aadhaar enablement of ICT/ Departmental applications. Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID, Punjab will assist Secretary Planning for the same.

Minutes of meeting of UID Implementation Committee held under the chairmanship of Worthy Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab on 17/06/2013 at 11:30 AM in Committee Room, 6th Floor, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh.

A meeting of UID Implementation Committee was held under the Chairmanship of Worthy Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab on 17/06/2013 at 11:30 AM in Committee Room, 6th Floor, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh. The list of participants is attached as annexure 'A'.

The following issues were discussed during the meeting and decision taken thereof:

1. Enrolment Status

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID Punjab briefed the committee on the enrolment progress. Committee was informed that state has already enrolled 77% of total population and Registrar UID Punjab has target to cross 80% within three months. The committee showed its satisfaction on the progress. Committee was also informed that the contract of one Enrolment Agency CSS Technergy Pvt. Ltd., which was looking after Amritsar, Tarn Taran, Gurdaspur (including Pathankot) and Hoshiarpur districts, has been terminated because of non-payment and the outstanding work has been distributed among existing Enrolment Agencies. In addition, DAI Regional Office has been requested to depute more Non State Registrars for these districts.

2. Permanent Enrolment Centres

Nodal Officer, Registrar, UID Punjab informed the committee that as per the decision taken in previous UIDIC meeting, 200 Permanent Enrolment Centres are being set up in all the districts. Nodal Officer further explained the financial viability of Permanent Enrolment Centres and assured the committee that UID Kits will be available in all the districts and enrolment process will be started soon thereafter. Principal Secretary Government Reforms raised a concern that returns will diminish for District Sukhmani Societies as the enrolments will reach towards its end. Nodal Officer explained that the cash flow will be maintained by additional services like E Aadhaar and Aadhaar update which are paid services. Chairman observed that if the revenue stream comes down, decision can be taken at that stage.

3. ICT Applications

Nodal Officer briefed the Committee that the whole PDS system has been digitized in the form of a database which will be unified/Aadhaar based in the whole state. Nodal officer further informed the Committee that UID PDS team has already tested the Point of Sale (PoS) device connection for Aadhaar Authentication and State is ready for doing Aadhaar authentication based pilot for Food Distribution in PDS. Committee gave its go ahead on the issue.

In addition, Committee decided that 'SRDH based Web Verification Services' and 'Aadhaar Authentication Services' should be started for Registration service in Department of Revenue, in districts where UID coverage has crossed 80%. In such cases, Aadhaar numbers of the parties concerned (e.g. Buyer/Seller etc.) will be taken as proof for verification. Nodal Officer requested the Chairman to give time till 15/08/2013, so that backend changes in prevailing departmental software can be done to make a smoother transition, which was granted.

Committee further decided to make Aadhaar provision mandatory in Arms License services. Going forward all new applications, renewals etc. would happen only on furnishing Aadhaar numbers.

Nodal officer further elaborated the utility of Aadhaar number for Suwidha Services rendered by District Sukhmani Societies. PS Governance Reforms clarified that his department has already kept a provision for UID field in e-District application and online Suwidha Application being developed through NIC. Accordingly

Committee decided that 'SRDH based Web Verification Services' and 'Aadhaar Authentication Services' should be incorporated to Suwidha/CSC Services like issuing Licenses, Certificates etc.

On the request of Nodal Officer to have single point of contact in respective departments, Committee decided that departments will appoint nodal officers and convey the name, number and email id of that officer to UID Punjab.

4. DBT Portal

Nodal Officer explained the currently prevailing Direct Benefit Transfer process in detail. He further explained the utility of DBT Portal developed by UID Punjab for seeding Aadhaar to Bank A/Cs of DBT beneficiaries. Chairman advised that provision should be kept in the portal for login-ies of controlling officers of respective banks in addition to LDMs as it will help us in pushing the seeding efforts at senior level.

Secretary Welfare expressed his concerns about the workflow being proposed under Punjab DBT Portal stressing the need to capture documentary proofs like Caste/Income Certificate as well as keeping mandatory provisions for respective sanctioning authority. Chairman advised the Nodal Officer to keep in mind the internal processes of the respective Administrative departments while assisting them for Aadhaar enablement of their applications. He directed that a sub-committee consisting of PS School Education, Secretary Welfare and Registrar UID will jointly work out the processes for Aadhaar enablement as well as usage of Welfare and DBT Portals.

5. Micro ATMs

Nodal Officer explained the vision concept of small local level entrepreneurs as Business Correspondents to offer Financial Inclusion services using micro ATMs in villages and towns. He suggested that Aadhaar based micro ATMs will assist in Financial Inclusion as well as Direct Benefit Transfer. Chairman suggested the feasibility of this concept warrants deeper deliberation with SL&C/UIDAI in the context of existing banking laws and to understand the nationally recommended approach.

6. Central Database for the state

Nodal Officer UID shared its vision to interlink all departments based upon one common ID i.e. Aadhaar. Chairman along with some other committee members flagged the concerns related to security of data as well as privacy concerns of residents. Chairman advised that such policy level decisions are to be taken in Cabinet Meeting. Nodal officer was asked to raise this matter through proper channel for taking it up in inter-department coordination committee.

Meeting ended with thanks to the chair.
