

Discipline problem is probably Higher Education's foremost concern today. Most faculty are, at best, only marginally involved in day to day matters of student conduct and discipline. Even administrators are ambivalent about their overall duty for student behavior.

Adopting a code of conduct and publicizing a laundry list of prohibited behaviors is not enough. Higher Education Institutions must adopt a comprehensive approach involving the entire institution. The disciplinary problems within the colleges are not confined to individual cases of student misbehavior. The principal problems that universities and colleges must address are the problems of society as a whole. An educational institution is a microcosm of its wider society. Therefore, it has the responsibility to nurse the causalities of social decline.

Traditional approaches to discipline are no longer effective. Higher Education Institutions would benefit by approaching the topic of student discipline in less adversarial and more developmental ways. There is a great need to search for practical and positive solutions to this burning issue of student discipline.


