The Swachh Bharat Mission was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in 2014 with the objective of achieving a clean and open defecation free India by 2nd October, 2019, the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

- The Swachh Bharat Summer Internship (SBSI) was launched in 2018 to intensify the involvement of the youth with the Mission. This initiative was a major success, with thousands of students from across the country participating in the internship.
- As we agreed during our meeting on 30th May 2019, we may jointly launch SBSI 2.0, specifically for the members of youth organizations like NYKS and NSS. The members of these organizations may contribute towards Plastic waste and Organic waste management in rural areas.
- 4. Each eligible intern will perform Swachhata related activities for the duration of atleast 50 hours during the period starting from 10th June 2019 31th July 2019 (guidelines of proposed activities is enclosed). A portal (https://sbm.gov.in/SBSI2019) has been developed for online registration and reporting for the interns.
- I request you to issue necessary instructions to the organisations to enroll the maximum possible number of interns to contribute towards Swachh Bharat Mission, and make the SBSI 2.0 a success.

Swachh Bharat Summer Internship (SBSI) 2.0

Following the success of SBS1 2018, in association with the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, and Ministry of Defence "Swachh Bharat Summer Interriship 2.0 – 50 Hours of Swachhata" is to be launched. The program aims to engage youth across the country, develop their skill and orientation for Solid Waste Management (SVM) work and make Swachh Bharat Mission a true jon ondolon.

Components of the Swachh Bharat Summer Internship 2.0 (5BSI 2.0)

The 50-hour internship program would require the intern/interns to visit one or more villages and conduct activities of their choice to contribute to the cause of Swachh Sharat Mission.

- 1. Duration: At least 50 hours in the period of 10th June to 31th July 2019.
- 2. Who can apply:
 - Youth enrolled in NYKS/NSS/NCC may apply through an online application form made available on the website https://sbm.gov.in/s85/2019. Offline application in case of NYKS may be done but same to be validated by D/O Youth Affairs
 - · Candidates to Indicate the location of internship (village)
 - Candidates may participate individually or in teams. Team size may be decided depending on the nature and scope of their activity, <u>subject to a maximum limit of 10 members in a team</u>.

3. Internship Process:

- Intern/Interns to devote at least 50 hours conducting Swachhata-related activities, specifically
 on Plastic Waste and Organic Waste Management in villages selected by them and approved
 by NYKS/NSS/NCC
- NYKS/NSS/NCC to organize necessary logistics for the activities

4. List of suggested activities: Appendix A

5 Reporting: An Internship Report needs to be submitted by the intern/inters on the online portal in the prescribed format within 15 days of completion of fieldwork. Note: For the offline reports of PNYS intern/interns to be submitted to the concerned NYKS units.

6 Rewards and Recognition:

- All participants will be given a Swachh Bharat Internship Certificate on completion of their Internship and its approval by the concerned NYKS/NSS/NCC units
- b. The Best interns will be recognized at District, State and National levels as follows:
 - Cash Awards in addition to certificates*
- Awards amount at District Level: ist Rs 30,000, lind-Rs 20,000, lind-Rs 10,000
- Awards amount at State Level: 1st- Rs 50,000, find- Rs 30,000, filed- Rs 20,000
- Awards amount at National Level: lst- Rs 2 lakh, llnd-1 lakh, llrd- Rs 50,000

*Note: the above fund will be provided to the concerned Ministry/Department by the Ministry of Jal Shakti

The selection of awardees at various levels i.e. district, state and national will be done by the competent authority as decided for various levels.

Role of the NYKS/NSS/NCC Units

- Yo ensure that all interns submit their reports on the portal https://tbs.sbmg.inp ntme (within 15 days of completion of fieldworkland for offline only for NYKS reports to be submitted to the concerned NYKS units.
- The top three awardees at each level should be forwarded to the next level for consideration of awards at that level
- Submit the details of the name of the awardees to the next level of authority
- Responsibility for safety and security of the interns during village vibits lies with the parent units
 of NYKS/NSS/NCC, hence the location should be chosen appropriately and liaison done with local
 administration wherever encossary

Role of State Government and District Administration

- State Government/District Administration will provide necessary support to the units of NYKS/NSC/NCC as and when requested to the extent possible
- ✓ Collected Plastic Waste in villages are to be shifted to the nearby Recycling plant.

APPENDIX A: List of Suggested Activities

As part of the internship, the activities that participants may conduct have been categorized into two clusters:

information-Education-Communication (IEC) activities: IEC activities are oriented towards increasing the awareness of people about sanitation related issues and trigger a change in sanitation health of the village. IEC activities undertaken by the interns can target behaviour change of peopleon two particular issues "Plastic Waste Management and Organic Waste Management".

Under this, the interns may:

- Organize awareness campaigns around better Plastic Waste Management and Organic Waste Management, Practices i.e. segregation of weste as biodegradable and non-billedegradable
- Conduct Door-to-door campaign for Waste Segregation and best practice
- Make wall paintings in public places (more specially panchayat affices) on the theme of clean village, promotion of Compost pit, proper management of Plastic waste
- 4. Plastic free village campaign and declaring Plastic free zone

Plastic and Organic Waste Management (POWM) related activities: POWM activities target generation of awareness around waste collection, segregation, disposal and waste-free environment.

- 1. Organize Waste collection drives in households and common or shared spaces
- 2. Volunteer for segregation of solid waste into non-biodegradable and biodegradable waste
- Mobilize community and panchayat to build compost pits, where organic matter decomposes to form manure
