Sir/Madam

To align Indian technical education for the global standards and to give hands-on exposure to students, All India Council for Technical Education has come up with new internship policy that mandates internship as a part of curriculum for technical institutions across India. The main aim of this initiative is to enhance the employability skills of graduating students. Now, AICTE is providing opportunity for AICTE approved Institutes to nominate its students for internship at District Magistrate office in all districts of the country. The Internship experience with government organizations will help a student in understanding the planning and implementation of various initiatives of state and central government. AICTE has decided that 5 selected students from AICTE approved institutions will be given an opportunity for internship in the office of District Magistrate in respective districts.(Details Attached)

They will also be awarded with the "Certificate of Excellence" by AICTE. A faculty mentor/Supervisor has to be allotted (by the College/Institute) to these students for guiding, monitoring and evaluation of internship of these students.



The main aim of this initiative is to ensure hands-on exposure to graduating students on the industry trends and enhance their employability. It is also felt that internship experience with government organizations can be equally beneficial and enriching to the students especially in understanding the planning and implementation of various initiatives of state and central governments.
