- (x) The information about the eligibility for admission to degree courses in Pharmacy and also about the institution/category-wise availability of seats and reservation of seats for various categories shall be made available by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar on website www.ptuadmissions.nic.in.
- (xi) The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/PIO shall be the same as was in vogue for NRI candidates.
- (xii) The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/PIO shall be as per **Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.**
- (xiii) The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per **Punjab Government Notification No. 35/44/95-ITE2/3244 dated Chandigarh the 30th August 2001.**
- (xiv) Non refundable counseling fee of Rs. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand & Five Hundred only) will be collected by the University as counseling fee from each student one time only.

- (xv) In case a student changes his / her / college / University during Second centralized counselling conducted by PTU his / her fee shall be refunded by the previous Institution after deduction of Rs. 1000/-only and the original documents will be returned immediately.
- (xvi) In case a student surrendering his / her seat within 7 days of the end of the online counselling, he / she must submit application to the college and register online on PTU website www.ptuadmissions.nic.in. PTU shall only forward such cases to the concerned colleges / Universities and colleges must refund his / her full fee after deduction of Rs. 1000/-only. The surrender of seat thereafter shall be governed by notification regarding refund of fee issued by AICTE vide letter no.AICTE/Legal/04(01)/2007 shall be followed strictly.

E. OVER-RIDING PROVISION:

Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down in the judgement of the honorable Supreme Court of India in the case of **TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others** (2002) 8SCC 481:AIR 2003 SC 355). Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.
