Agenda Item No 15.1 Approval of Tender of Sewerage Treatment Plant

Six no. agencies as mentioned below—were pre-qualified for the work of "Design, Supply, Erection, Testing and commissioning of 30 KLD Sewerage Treatment Plant with Fab Reactor":-

M/s Archigroup Architects stated in the report that M/s Shubam Hydrotech Engineers (P) Ltd. D-202, Sector-10. Noida are at L1 position and rates quoted by them are workable. It was recommended that they may be considered favourably for the award of work at a cost of Rs. 1983900.00

Tender Evaluation committee headed by Dr.R.S.Khandpur considered the evaluation report of M/s Archigroup Architects and recommended that the work may be allotted to M/s Shubam Hydrotech Engineers (P) Ltd ,D-202, Sector-10, Noida ,the lowest bidder, for an amount of Rs. 1983900.00 (Rs. Nineteen lac eighty three thousand and nine hundred only). Minutes of the meeting are annexed at Page ... B....

The Committee may approve award of the work to M/s Shubam Hydrotech Engineers (P) Ltd D-202, Sector-10, Noida

Agenda Item No. 15-2: Approval of Detailed Estimate and Tender of Boundary Wall, Gates and Electrical Rooms.

- 15.2.1 Detailed estimate of the Boundary Wall around the campus of the University, amounting to Rs. 1.43 crores was approved in the 8th meeting of the committee. Design had to be revised in view of the approval received from PUDA and District Town Planner ,Kapurthala. The committee in its last meeting approved the revised design and decided to adopt stone cladding as provided on the exterior of the Administration Building. Length has also decreased as "PTU CAPARO School are constructing the boundary around their campus of their own. Revised detailed estimate amounting to Rs. 101.99 lacs incorporating the changes mentioned above has been prepared and is put up for the approval of the Committee.
- 15.2.2 Tenders for the work for an amount of Rs. 99.50 laes were invited to be received on 15-06-07 on the basis of conventional NFT already approved by the committee. Time limit of six months has been fixed. Three Agencies as mentioned below purchased the tender documents and submitted the tenders on the appointed date:

M/s Archigroup have recommended that the contract may be concluded with the lowest bidder i.e M/s Star Construction Co. Jandiala Guru , Amritsar. The offer gives a saving of 6-20% over the BOQ amount.



Committee may approve the award of the work as recommended by M/s Archigroup Architects to M/s Star Construction Co. Jandiala Guru, Amritsar

Agenda Item No. 15.3: Approval of Award of work of Supply and Installation of Elevators

Expression of Interest for the work was invited through Press but none of the reputed agencies like OTIS and KONE etc applied for prequalification. The Standing Building Construction Committee in its 11th meeting held on 31-10-2006, constituted the following committee to contact the reputed agencies who are Principal manufacturers of Elevators and obtain most favourable Price and Terms and Conditions after negotiations with them:-

- i) Dr. V.K.Arora, Dean (Academics)
- ii) Sh.N.S. Bhatti, Advisor, (Electrical)
- Sh. A.N.Chowdhry, Chief Engineer (Construction)
- Sh. Rajiv Aggarwal, Architect M/s Archigroup Architects

The above said committee contacted the representatives of following agencies on 13-11-06 and 14-11-06 at Delhi to ascertain their terms and conditions to evolve minimum common acceptable conditions so that they participate in tenders:

- Sh. Pawan Sharma, Engineer Sales M/s KONE Elevators India Pvt. Ltd.
- Sh Kunal Behrani, Engineer, N.S. Sales M/s OTIS India Elevator Company (India) Ltd.
- iii) Sh. Vivek Mishra , M/s Mitsubishi Corporation India Pvt. Ltd.
- Sh. Uday Raj, Manager Sales M/s Thyssenkrupp
- v) Sh. Samuel T.B. Jacob, R.M. M/s Johnson Lifts

On the basis of inputs obtained from above mentioned firms and keeping in view the sustained reputation of agencies regarding the quality of items and after sales service particularly as the site is located away from the city, the committee recommended the following firms for prequalification:

- i) M/s OTIS India Elevator Company (India) Ltd.
- M/s KONE Elevators India Pvt. Ltd.
- M/s Mitsubishi Corporation India Pvt. Ltd.

The pre-qualified agencies were invited to purchase the tenders documents by 07-03-07. M/s OTIS and M/s KONE purchased the blank Tender Documents. Prebid conference was held on 29-04-07 in PTU Campus, Jalandhar under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.S.Khandpur, which was attended by Sh. Gagandeep Singli, Engineer, Sales M/s OTIS only. The date for receipt of tender was fixed as 20-04-07 in the office of M/s Archigroup, Delhi but had to be postponed to 02-05-07 in PTU, Jalandhar because of the following reasons:-

- M/s OTIS requested on telephone to postpone tenders as they had not been able to arrange the bank guarantee.
- ii) Sh. Vincet Nagpal of M/s KONE requested that they had not been able to obtain the rates of lift for the front block from their factory and were thus not able to quote.

Consequently tenders were received from M/s OTIS and M/s KONE on 02-05-07. The copies of the financial bids along with the terms and conditions submitted by both the agencies were sent to M/s Archigroup Architects for the evaluation . M/s Archigroup vide their reference no. 2220 dated 09-05-07 intimated that M/s KONE have quoted for three lifts only and they are prima facie rejected and recommended that M/s OTIS be invited for negotiation.

Meeting of the Tender Evaluation Committee was held on 17-05-07 under the chairmanship of Dr. R.S.Khandpur which was artended by Sh. Ripudman Singh of M/s OTIS. He was informed that conditions recommended by them had been incorporated in the N.J.T and in the Prebid meeting in consulation with Sh. Kunal Behrani of M/s OTIS and conditionless tender was expected from M/s OTIS. He was requested to withdraw the conditions put forward by them with the Tender Sh. Ripudaman Singh intimated that Mr. Kunal Behrani who was previously dealing with PTU has been transferred and he was not in a position to take any decision right then. Sh. Ravi Sharma of M/s KONE who was also present, was called and informed the position of their tender. He expressed his willingness to negotiate on the conditions. The Tender Evaluation Committee concluded as under:-

"The Tender Evaluation Committee feels that a lot of time has elapsed but proper tenders have not been received. Normal Tender Procedure has not succeeded in this case. Committee recommends that no alternative is left except to contact the Agencies and obtain offers from them as decided in the meeting held on 31-10-2006".

Sh. Ravi Sharma had discussions with the committee and agreed to withdraw most of the conditions and promised to submit an undertaking in this regard alongwith quotation for Elevator for (G+3) block in a sealed cover by 31-05-07. However, Mr. Rajiv Juneja vide his fax dated 28-05-07 requested for some more days and was requested to attend PTU Committee on 04-06-07 in Punjab Bhawan, Delhi. He accompanied by Sh. Anaud Tiwary attended the meeting but did not agree to withdraw some conditions not suitable to PTU and was not ready to supply the Elevator of the front block as per dimensions of the lift well constructed at site, M/s KONE vide their letter no. KEIPL/038/200704/036 dated 04-06-07 received on 14-06-07 and letter dated 19-06-07 submitted the undertaking for amending the terms and conditions alongwith financial bid for front block. The financial bid was opened by the committee on 20-06-07 and requested their representative on telephone to further amend the conditions and reduce the price of Elevator by 21-06-07 when the committee decided to meet again to decide further action.

M/s KONE vide their letter no. KEIPL/038/200704/036 dated 21-06-07 received through fax intimated that the price offered by them for the Elevator to be installed in the front block is higher as the Elevator Hoistway does not conform to IS Standards and they had to design the Elevator customized for PTU requirements which has a financial implication. Other conditions were agreed by them. Regarding the hoistway M/s Archigroup assured that the lift components have been designed as per IS Standards in the bid document and they have provided many lifts of this type which are functioning satisfactorily. The committee observed:-





- a. M/s OTIS had initially quoted a price of Rs. 70.25 lakhs for all the four elevators while the offer of M/s KONE is Rs. 70.95 lakhs
- b. Terms of M/s OTIS are not acceptable to the University
- e. M/s OTIS have not included the cost of automatic rescue device (ARD) for any of the Elevators. The estimated cost of ARD is about Rs. 1.0-1.25 lakhs per lift and if this is included, the price of M/s OTIS will be about Rs. 74.25 lakhs
- d. M/s OTIS do not provide Vandal proof steel finish as specified in bid documents. However M/s KONE have demanded an additional amount of Rs. 2.5 laklist over and above the price mentioned in 'a' above
- e. M/s KONE are not prepared to reduce the price further.

The Committee recommended that the offer of M/s KONE be accepted as all the possibilities of procuring the elevators from other reputed agencies have not borne fruitful results. It is mentioned here that the normal procedure of Govt, regarding tenders has also not succeeded.

The Standing Building Construction Committee may consider to approve the work of Elevators to M/s KONE at a price of Rs. 73.45 lakhs

Agenda Item No. 15.4: To decide specifications of Roads, Parking and Foot Paths around Administration Building.

Estimate and tender documents for the construction of Black topped roads and parking and footpaths with Paver Blocks was put up to the committee for approval in the 14th meeting held on 03-05-07. It was discussed in the meeting that for road construction and parking. Paver blocks be used instead of adopting black top road specifications. It was decided that the Architects will consult the scientists of Central Road Research Institute (CRRI) Delhi and put up the proposal in the next meeting of the committee.

The Architects have consulted the Scientists of CRRI and have submitted their report vide their letter no. AA(R)/PTU/2232 dated 14-05-07 (copy annexed page 16.). Scientist dealing with Rigid Pavement Division does not recommend Paver Blocks for Road Construction. Scientist dealing with Paver Block Division recommends in favour of Paver Blocks. Since It is a specialized work, he has offered to provide consultancy on normal charges upto tender stage and later for Supervision. He has recommended IRC & ISI codes for this purpose. The codes have been studied and the Architects have recommended to adopt conventional road construction in view of the following:-

- Recommendations contained in the IRC code are based on the research conducted abroad and much work has not been done in India.
- Riding quality is reasonably good for slow traffic but is inferior to machine laid bituminous road.
- iii) Skilled labour and qualified Agency is not available in the area.



- Site staff has limited experience for supervision.
- v) Duplicate Drainage system shall have to be provided.

The committee may resolve the issue so that estimate is prepared and tenders are called accordingly.

Agenda Item No. 15-5: To consider the request of M/s IVRCL for Time Extension

The work for the construction of Wings A,B & C at PTU Site on Jalandhar-Kapurthala road was allotted to M/s IVRCL I &P Ltd , Hyderabad vide PTU reference no. PTU/Const/001/378-380 dated 20-01-06 for Rs. 29.72 erores with a time period of 10 calendar months for Front Block (G+3) and 18 months for complete work. M/s IVRCL I &P Ltd could not complete the work in time and extension was granted for completing the Front (G+3) Block upto 30th April, 2007 and complete work up to December 12th, 2007 as approved in the twelveth meeting of the Standing Building Construction Committee held on 26-12-07. The work for the Front Block has been structurally completed and the finishing is in progress. The construction in the Rear Block is going on in the seventh floor.

M/s IVRCL I&P Ltd have now applied for time extension up to 30th October, 2007 for the construction of Front Block and up to 30th June, 2008 for complete work vide their letter no. IVRCL/PMC/PTU/CM/2007-08/8957 dated 28-04-07 (photocopy annexed on Page 18) without imposing any liquidated damages. Comments were sought from M/s Archigroup Architects and they have submitted their report vide reference no. AA(R)/PTU/2224 dated 22.5.2007 (annexure page 35) Comments by the Superintending Engineer . PTU in annonated form on the application are annexed at page 27 . He has recommended the time extension on following grounds:-

- i) Time required to complete the balance work is justified
- ii) Decisions regarding finishes etc have been finalized in the month of May, 2007
- iii) Works of other Agencies like A/C, Electrical, Sewerage, Water Supply etc are scheduled to be completed by October end.
- Works of Roads, Sewerage Treatment Plant and Elevators are yet to be awarded.
- V) Arrangement of Power Supply is getting delayed.
- vi) Architectural/Structural details have not been issued completely.

The committee may consider the time extension.



Minutes of the Tender Evaluation Committee for the Supply, Testing and Commissioning of Elevators held under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.S.Khandpur Director General, PGSC, in his office at Chandigarh on 17-05-07.

The following were present:

i) Sh. N.S. Bhatti, Advisor (Electrical), PTU

ii) Sh. A.N.Chowdhry, Chief Engineer, (Const.) PTU

iii) Sh. Rajeev Aggarwal, Architect, M/s Archigroup Architects, Delhi

iv) Sh. T.L.Dhall, Superintending Engineer, PTU, Jalandhar

 Tenders were invited to be received on 20-04-07 at Delhi from the three prequalified Agencies viz M/s Mitsubhish Ltd., M/s OTIS Elevators Pvt Ltd., M/s KONE Elevators (India) Pvt. Ltd. Tender documents were only purchased by M/s OTIS and M/s KONE.

Prebid meeting was held in PTU ,Jalandhar under the chairmanship of Dr. R.S.Khandpur No representative of M/s KONE attended the meeting. However Sh. Gagandeep Singh Engineer (Sales) attended the meeting on behalf of M/s OTIS Elevators Pvt Ltd. Minutes of prebid meeting were issued vide PTU/XEN/Elevators/38/16602 dated 12-04-07 to both the Agencies. On the date of receipt of tenders all the four members of the committee were present at Delhi, but requests were received on telephone from both the Agencies for postponement of the tenders for which they put forwarded following reasons;

a) M/s Otis Elevators (India) Ltd., could not prepare the Bank Guarantee for Earnest Money

b) M/s Kone Elevators India Pvt. Ltd, could not obtain rates of lift in the front block from their factory.

2. Date of receipt of tenders was postponed to 02-05-07, when tenders were received from both the Agencies and were forwarded to M/s Archigroup for processing and submission of report which has been received vide their reference no. AA(R)/PTU/2229 dated 14-05-07 (copy enclosed). They have recommended that M/s KONE have quoted only for 3 of total 4 elevators included in the render document, thus their bid is incomplete and has not been considered for further evaluation. They have recommended that the committee may negotiate with M/s OTIS for deviations mentioned in their offer

3. The committee observes that offer of M/s OTIS is also not proper as it is accompanied with many conditions which have financial implications. Some of the conditions are not possible to be accepted. The Agencies were supposed to submit a complete tender without any condition so that negotiations could be carried out with L1 agency. Sh. Ripudaman Singh of M/S OTIS was called upon to withdraw all conditions but be replied that it is not possible for him to do so. informed that committee PTU had consulted He Was οť Sh. Kunal Behrani, Engineer (Sales) at Delhi and NIT was based upon the conditions largely acceptable to him. Then in the pre-bid all the remaining queries were answered and decisions were taken to which their Representative extreed



after consulting Sh.Kunal Behrani many times on telephone right during the meeting. As per the adopted tender—procedure, tender should have been conditionless. Sh Kunal Behrani was requested by Sh. T.L.Dhall on telephone on 14-05-07 to attend this meeting personally so that tender can be finalized. He expressed his inability to attend personally but assured that his representative who has the authority to negotiate shall attend the meeting. Sh. Ripudaman Singh was unaware of the prebid meeting and informed that Sh. Kunal Behrani has been transferred and he cannot take any decision right then.

Sh. Ravi Sharma of M/s KONE who was also present, was called and informed the position of their tender. He expressed his willingness to negotiate on the conditions.

It was reported in the 11th meeting of the Standing Building Construction Committee held on 31-10-06, that no reputed Agencies have applied for prequalification and the committee deliberated on the issue and constituted a further committee and desired it to contact reputed Agencies, who are the Principal Manufactures of Elevators and obtain from the most favorable Price and terms and conditions after negotiations the same with them. The committee contacted the Agencies and recommended for the pre-qualification of the Agencies as mentioned above and recommended to incorporate conditions demanded by them in the tender documents so that the Agencies are able to participate. Standing Building Construction Committee in the 12th meeting held on 26-12-06, accepted the recommendation of the committee.

The committee feels that lot of time has elapsed but proper tenders have not been received. Normal tender procedure has not succeeded in this case. Committee recommends that no alternative is left except to contact the Agencies and obtain offers from them as decided in the meeting held on 31-10-06

The road work in the campus - Concrete Pavers.

Sir.

This has a reference to the 14th meeting of the Standing Building Committee, in which it was decided that the architect will visit the CRRI in Delhi to discuss the suitability of concrete pavers for road construction in the PTU campus. Following are the findings from the 2 meetings at CRRI (drawings of the road lay out were shown during the meetings):

Meeting on May 4th 2007: A meeting was held with Mr. R.K. Maheshwari and Mr. J.B. Sengupta, scientists in the Rigid Pavement Division. They both opined that the concrete pavers are suitable for shoulders of the roads only.

Meeting on May 8th 2007: A meeting was held with Mr. S.D. Sharma, a scientist in the concrete paver division of the CRRI. He recommended that the concrete pavers are acceptable for roads of different types and suggested that:

The codes IRC - SP63-2004 and IS 15658:2006 in this regard may be studied. Copies of these codes are attached with this note;

b., Their department in CRRI specializes in road construction with concrete pavers and will be willing to provide its technical input as a consultant upto preparation of tender stage at about Rs. 50 - 60,000/-. They can also provide supervision during construction and charges for the same can be negotiated based on the Terms Of Reference.

The following issues emerge from perusal of the 2 codes:

- Both the codes are recently formulated in years 2004 and 2006 respectively; 1
- 2. The IRC code specifies that:
 - the recommendations contained in it are based on the research conducted abroad as not much work has been done in India on pavers for roads;
 - pavers are acceptable for in-city roads but have certain limitations in the form of:
 - a. Higher noise level @ about 5-8 dB (may be acceptable in our case);
 - b. Riding quality is reasonably good for slow speed traffic but is inferior to machine laid bituminous road (is a part limiting factor);
 - c. A very good attention is to be paid to storm water drainage as the water can percolate through the open gaps in the pavers. To achieve this, a perforated

drainage pipe is to be provided along the road-side with connections at appropriate locations to the main storm water drainage. (is a limiting factor due to required technology and economics of duplicate drainage system);

d. The road has to be constructed by skilled workers due to precision required in the drainage of the sub-grade and the pattern of the blocks in plan (is a limiting

factor); etc.

 For the 80 mm thickness specified in the IRC code for in-city roads, a minimum crushing strength of M40 is specified in the IS code.

Like in any other type of construction, skilled labor and the quality of materials (pavers in this case) are the key components in making a long lasting road. However, it may be ambitious to get the desired results given the infantile stage of the technology in the country due to which:

a. relatively less skilled labor is available for execution. No qualified agency will be available in the region which may result in poor response / higher quotation from out

of the region agencies; and

the site staff will have limited experience in supervising such construction.

The reservations were expressed in the Standing Building Committee meeting that pot-holes develop in the conventional roads over a period of time. In this regard, kindly note that these develop as the water accumulates on surface due to poor slopes / construction. These potholes worsen with time due to movement of vehicles. If the roads are properly specified and constructed, these should not develop specially in the context of a campus measuring only 80 acres. Unlike vehicular movement on city roads, the speed, weight and frequency of the vehicles is not expected to be high with in the campus.

Therefore, it may be appropriate to resort to conventional road construction in the campus rather than venturing into relatively new technology.

Dear Sir.

In connection with the subject, we invite your kind attention to your letter cited under reference 2) above, granting us extension of time—i) up to 30th April, 2007 for the construction of Wing 'C' and ii) up to 31th December, 2007 for the construction of Wing 'A', 'B' and Core for the reasons not attributable to us.

With a view to complete the above said works within the extended time & also to avoid further time & cost overrun, we took all the necessary steps including augmentation of additional resource mobilisation. But even after our serious & sincere efforts, the works could not be completed within the revised time frame for the reasons totally beyond our control & not attributable to us. In this context, we would like to submit the following points, explaining the major impediments faced by us and the reasons, which are warranting requirement of additional time for completion of works.

1. Delay in receipt of various Structural & Architectural Drawings:- Since inception, we have not been receiving the good for construction drawings in time. Due to non-availability of the above drawings in advance before commencement of various activities, we are unable to carry out the forward planning for proper resource mobilisation to complete the job within scheduled time frame & ultimately the completion of the works is getting extended. Thus the late receipt of the required structural & architectural drawings for all the wings resulting in frequent interruption in the work progress & leading us to demobilize & remobilize of the resources for many items of works. At present, the works is standstill in many fronts like casting of slabs, electrical conduiting, floor finishes, stone cladding, false

ceiling & etc. for want of approved drawing & details. The details of drawings issued to us after 31st October, 2006 are attached herewith as Appendix 'A' and the details of drawings yet to be issued are also attached as Appendix 'B' for your kind attention & reference. On account of non-issue of good for construction drawings in time, the project requires an additional time of around six months. .

- 2. Suspension of work due to Revision of Drawings for Floor Finishes:- You necessitated the change in original pattern/design of expensive decorative floor finishes (comprising of combination of different flooring material with ornamental work) to ordinary floor finishes to avoid extra expenditure in the project. We were issued drawings for the changes in floor finish pattern in a phased manner. The floor finish work was put on hold for this change for almost three months. Revised set of drawings for the same up to 3ed Floor of Wing 'C' was issued only on 3ed April. 2007. Thus the commencement of this item of works got delayed approximately by 90 days, warranting requirement of additional time for completion.
- 3. Suspension of work due to likely Revision of Stone Cladding details: You are aware that we mobilized stores and specialized crew for the above stone eladding work. However, we have been instructed by your good self to hold the stone cladding work till further order. In this connection, please refer to our letter No.IVRCL/DZO/8893 dated 19th April, 2007. Good for construction drawings for stone cladding works are yet to be issued to us, this works requires around three months time to complete after issue of good for construction drawings.
- 4. Delay in A.C. Ducting Work: A.C. ducting work is in the scope of another agency. We approached your good self number of times in the past to direct AC ducting Agency to complete their work so as to enable us to start false ceiling work & floor finish work. In this connection please refer to our letter No.IVRCL/DZO/8459 dated 10th March, 2007, No.IVRCL/PTU/06-07/288 dated 15th March, 2007, No.IVRCL/DZO/8607 dated 21th March, 2007 and No.IVRCL/DZO/8897 dated 19th April, 2007. However, in spite of our repeated persoasion, the AC ducting work could not be completed till date. As a result of this, front for our activities of false ceiling & subsequently floor finish is not made available to us in Wing 'C'. Hence, almost entire internal linishing work is held up on G.F., 1st Floor, 2nd Floor & 3nd Floor in Wing'C' due to non completion of AC ducting work by other Agency.. We require an additional time of 90 days to complete this false coiling, flooring and internal finish items of works after the fronts are made available to us.
- 5. Interruption in Work Progress in Wing 'C' :- We mobilized our all resources to complete the work in Wing 'C' within the extended period. However, we could not proceed as planned to complete the above said Wing due to the following reasons which are beyond our control.

We could not east third floor slab of Wing 'C' in time for want of structural drawings. The same was issued to us only on 22nd December, 2006, Good for

construction drawings for construction of mumty, staircase and parapet beams were issued to us on 21st February, 2007. The revised drawings for floor finish pattern in Wing 'C' were issued on 3rd April, 2007. We are not in a position to start the roof insulation as well as roof water proofing work since construction of parapet wall in southern side Wing 'C' is under hold for want of revised drawings of parapet. Pending decision on brick work on terrace and terrace flooring will further delay the water proofing and plumbing work in Wing 'C'.

In view of the above your good self is requested to resolve the pending issues on priority,

- 5. <u>Unprecedented Rains</u>:- Due to change in climatic conditions in the Northern Region, there had been unprecedented & unseasonal heavy showers in Jallandhar during March, 2007. Due to these heavy rains, the entire project schedule was affected unexpectedly & resulted in set back in the progress of work. In this connection please refer our letter No.IVRCL/PTU/06-07/290 dated 14th March, 2007. (Copy enclosed).
- 6. <u>Delay in Release of Payments</u>: As per the contract, 70% of the certified RA Bill amount shall be paid to us within seven working days from the submission of bills and the balance 30% payment shall be paid within 21 days. However, release of RA bill payments have been delayed beyond above stipulated timings in many occasions. The details are attached as Appendix 'C'. It is needless to mention that our work involves regular payment to labourers as well as various vendors/suppliers for the purchase of construction material. Non-receipt of RA Bills payments in time has affected the progress of work to certain extent.

In light of the above said facts, as the reasons for requirement of additional time for completing the project are completely beyond our controls and not at all attributable to us, we request your good self to grant us judiciously an extension of time for further 180 days i.e. up to 30th October, 2007 for construction of Wing 'C' and up to 30th June, 2008 for the construction of Wing 'A', 'B' & Core, without imposing any Liquidated Damages.










With regards to the above mentioned reference along with its attachment, kindly see below our point wise responses to the issues mentioned by M/s IVRCL in their letter:

- Delay in receipt of various Structural and Architectural Drawings: While the dates of the drawings submission are correct, it should be noted that the drawings are being submitted ahead of relevant stage of work at site and the work at site has never suffered for want of drawings. The case in point is that while only 4th and 5th floor slabs are being currently east in the rear block at site, the relevant structural drawings upto 7th floor have already been submitted.
- 2.0 Flooring Pattern: The flooring pattern drawings had been submitted from 30.11.2006 onwards. Subsequently the University decided to review the patterns, which were discussed in our office on March 16th 2007. The revised drawings based on the decisions made in this meeting were issued from 26th March 2007 onwards.
- 3.0 Stone Cladding: M/s IVRCL requested to increase the stone size from 5"X22" (in the tender) to larger size to expedite the cladding work. Their request also included cost implications. During the process of these discussions, the University decided to review the fundamental decision of stone cladding and explore other possible options. The matter was included in the agenda of the 14th Standing Building Committee meeting held on May 3rd 2007. Now that the Committee has decided to change the size of stone for cladding and the types of clamps, relevant details will be issued shortly. However, in the mean time, contractor has been given sufficient verbal instructions to continue with the work.
- 4.0 Delay in A/C ducting work: This point does not pertain to us. It may however be noted that the drawings for the false-ceiling had been submitted on 19.09.2006 / 20.11.2006 onwards.
- 5.0 Interruption in progress of work: It may be noted that there are sufficient 'fronts' on which the contractor can proceed in a building as large as the PTU building. The small issues mentioned by the contractor will not add to the completion schedules.

Mostly the finishing items are being currently executed at site, which warrant certain execution time for the desired outcome. Given the current status of the work at site where many agencies are working simultaneously, co-ordination between agencies is most critical. While we assure you of one best input, the contractor may be urged to speed up the work in right earnest and complete the building as soon as possible.

	In connection with the subject, we invite your kind attention to you letter cited under reference 2) above, granting us extension of time i) up to 30th April, 2007 for the Construction of Wing 'C' and ii) up to 31 December, 2007 for the construction of Wing 'A', 'B' and Core for the reason not attributable to us. With a view to complete the above said works within the extended time and also to avoid further time & cost overrun, we took all the necessary steps including augmentation of additional resource mobilization. But even after our serious & sincere efforts, the works could not be completed within the revised time frame for the reasons totally beyond our control and not attributable to us. In this context, we would like to submit the following points, explaining the major impediments faced by us and the reasons, which are warranting requirement of additional time for completion of works.	was not in pace with the work programme submitted by them and is far behind the targets. The points raised by M/s IVRCL I& P Ltd are commented as under: Comments were sought from M/s Archigroup and have been received vide their memo AA(R)/PTU/2224, May 12, 2007 and have been incorporated in
1	Delay in receipt of various Structural and Architectural Drawings: Since inception, we have not been receiving the good for construction drawings in time. Due to non-availability of the above drawings in advance before commencement of various activities, we are unable to carry out the forward planning for proper resource mobilization to complete the job within scheduled time frame and ultimately the completion of the works is getting extended. Thus the late receipt of the required structural and & architectural drawings for all the wings resulting in frequent interruption in the work progress and leading us to demobilize & remobilize of the resources for many items of works. At present, the works is standstill in many fronts like casting of slabs, electrical conduiting, floor finishes, stone cladding, false ceiling & etc, for want of approved drawing & details. The details of drawings issued tous after 31st October, 2006 are attached herewith as Appendix 'A' and the details of drawings yet to be issued are also attached as Appendix 'B' for your kind attention and reference. On account of non-issue of good for construction drawings in time, the project requires an additional time of around six months.	The Good for construction drawings are always issued as per the execution and no drawings were delayed and their work never stopped. The fact is that the required shop drawings for conduits were submitted very late by M/s IVRCL and shop drawings for the Aluminium Joincry and structured Glazing are yet to be submitted by M/s IVRCL. The details of pending drawings have been admitted by the Architect. But these are always paced with the construction which was never interrupted because of non supply of drawings and decisions.
	Suspension of work due to Revision of Drawings for Floor Finishes: You necessitated the change in original pattern/design of expensive decorative floor finishes (comprising of combination of different flooring material with ornamental work) to ordinary floor finishes to avoid extra expenditure in the project. We were issued drawings for the changes in floor finish pattern in a phased manner. The floor finish work was put on hold for this change for almost three months. Revised set of drawings for the same up to 3 rd Floor of Wings 'C' was issued only on 3 rd April, 2007. Thus the commencement of this item of works got delayed approximately by 90 days, warranting requirement of additional time for completion.	The floor pattern drawings were issued to M/s IVRCL on 30-11-06, but they submitted quite late vide their reference no. IVRCL/DZO dated 01-03-07 that the flooring is a N.S. hem. PTU immediately got the drawings revised as per BOQ and the flooring drawings were issued in third week of March and the !* week of April, 2007

3	Suspension of work due to likely Revision of Stone Cladding details: You are aware that we mobilized stores and specialized crew for the above stone cladding, work. However, we have been instructed by our good self to hold the stone cladding work till further order. In this connection, please refer to our letter No. IVRCL/DZO/8893 dated 19th April, 2007. Good for construction drawings for stone cladding works are yet to be issued to us, this works requires around three months time to complete after issue of good for construction drawings.	The stone cladding drawing was issued on 21-02-07 and M/s IVRCL submitted for change in specifications of the cramps and the size of tiles because of the economy and faster construction in the 2 nd week of April The decision was conveyed to them by the PTU in the first week of May, 2007 after approval of the Standing Building Construction Committee.
4	Delay in A.C Ducting Works: A.C ducting work is in the scope of another agency, we approached your god self number of times in the past to direct AC ducting Agency to complete their work so as to enable us to start false ceiling work and floor finish work. In this connection please refer to our letter no. IVRCL/DZO/8459 dated 10thMarch, 2007, No. IVRCL/PTU/06-07/288 dated 15th March, 2007, No. IVRCL/DZO/8607 darted 21st March, 2007 and No. IVRCL/DZO/8897 dated 19th April, 2007. However, in spite of our repeated persuasion, the AC ducting work could not be completed till date. As a result of this, from for our activities of false ceiling and subsequently floor finish is not made available to us in Wing 'C'. Hence almost entire internal finishing work is held up on G.F 1st Floor, 2nd Floor and 3nd Floor in Wing 'C' due to non completion of AC ducting work by other Agency. We require an additional time of 90 days to complete this false ceiling, flooring and internal finish items of works after the fronts are made available to us.	It is correct that AC ducting work is in the scope of other agency but they are doing the work as per planning and there is no obstruction to the work of M/s IVRCL I&P Ltd. The false ceiling work was stopped by PTU as it was decided to discuss the type of false ceiling in the meeting of the Standing Building Construction Committee. Final decision was taken in the meeting on 03-05-07 in which Sh. M.S. Rao, General Manager, M/s IVRCL was present.
5	Interruption in Work Progress in Wing 'C': We mobilized our all resources to complete the work in Wing 'C' within the extended period. However, we could not proceed as planned to complete the above said Wing due to the following reasons which are beyond our control. We could not cast third floor slab of Wing 'C' in time for want of structural drawings. The same was issued to us only on 22 nd December, 2006. Good for construction drawings for construction of mumty, staircase and parapet beams were issued to us on 21 nd February, 2007. The revised drawings for floor finish pattern in Wing 'C' were issued on 3 nd April, 2007. We are not in a position to start the roof insulation as well as roof water proofing work since construction of parapet wall in southern side Wing 'C' is under hold for want of revised drawings for parapet. Pending decision on brick work on terrace and terrace flooring will further delay the water proofing and plumbing work in Wing 'C'. In view of the above your good self is requested to resolve the pending issues on priority.	The structural drawing of the 4th floor i.e. roof slab for the wing C was issued on 22-12-06 but the drawing for detail of shuttering and reinforcement was handed over to Sh.Umesh Singh, Project Manager,M/s IVRCL I&P Ltd on 29-11-06 and 10-12-06 respectively at the time when slab of 3th floor was just laidRegarding revised drawing of the floors., the reasons have already been explained under para (2). The leak proofing of the roof was reviewed on 03-05-07 in the meeting of the Standing Building Construction Committee. The parapet wall was stopped as its structural safety was to be ensured from the Architects and the design has been changed. However revised drawings stand issued.
6	Unprecedented Rains: Due to change in climatic condition in the Northern Region, there had been unprecedented and unseasonal heavy showers in Jalandhar during March, 2007. Due to these heavy rains, the entire project schedule was affected unexpectedly and resulted in set back in the progress of work. In this connection please refer our letter no. IVRCL/PTU/06-07/290 dated 14 th March, 2007 (copy enclosed.)	Rains have not been un-precendets though work remained suspended for a few days due to rains.





Delay in Release of Payments: As per the contract, 70% of the certified RA bill amount shall be paid to us within seven working days from the submission bills and the balance 30% payment shall be paid within 21 days. However, release of RA bill payments have been delayed beyond above stipulated timings in many occasions. The details are attached as Appendix 'C'. It is needless to mention that our work involves regular payment to labourers as well as various vendors/suppliers for the purchase of construction material. Non-receipt of RA bills payments in time has affected the progress of work to certain extent.

It is correct that 70% of the RA bill amount is to be paid in 7 working days and balance 30% in 21 days. This is subject to the condition that The information regarding folfillment of statuary requirements shall be supplied by the company along the bill. Some of the bills have been received in complete and have been returned for amendments vide letter no. 219-220 05-09-06, 271-272 dated 03-10-06 and 296-297 dated 13-10-06. The delay in 70% of the payments of the bills is very minor but remaining 30% payments have been delayed:

The comments are concluded as under :-

- The reasons given by M/s IVRCL I&P Ltd are not completely sufficient and they could have executed the work at a better place.
- it) The time requested by M/s IVRCL to complete the balance work is justified
- Decisions regarding finishes etc have been finalized in the month of May, 2007
- Works of other agencies like A/C. Electrical, Sewerage, Water Supply are scheduled to be completed by October end.
- Works of Roads, Sewerage Treatement Plant and Elevators are yet to be allotted.
- vi) Arrangement of Power Supply is getting delayed
- vii) Architectural/Structural details have not been issued completely.

In view of the above, it is recommended that extension may please be granted to M/s IVRCL i& P, Ltd upto 30-10-07 for the front block and upto 30-06-08 for the rear (G ± 7) block in the interest of work.
