The Indian Scientists / citizens who are not more than 45 years of age (as on 31.12.2008) are eligible for the award. The person, nominated for SSB Prize should have made significant research contributions through work done primarily in India during the past five years. Details of this are available on PTU website. Minutes of the 31st Academic Council held on 21st January, 2009 at 11.30 AM at Conference Hall, Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala – Jalandhar Highway.

Dean (Academics) welcomed all the members of the Academic Council in its 31st meeting. He expressed that this meeting was important because of two reasons, firstly it was the first meeting of the Academic Council to be held in its own campus since its establishment and secondly ever since the taking over of the new Vice Chancellor he would be chairing the meeting of the council for the first time. He then requested the Vice Chancellor to chair the meeting. All the members welcomed Dr. Rajneesh Arora as a new Vice Chancellor and Chairman of the Academic Council.

The Chairman welcomed the members of the Council and the Dean (Academics), Dean (DEP) & Dean (Exams) to the 31st meeting of the Academic Council. He informed the Council that due to state level function at Amritsar Mrs. Sarojini Gautam Sharda Registrar and Member Secretary could not attend the meeting of the council and Dr. V. K. Arora will perform the duties of Member Secretary in her place.

Dean (Academics) informed the Council about the sad demise of Dr. S. K. Goyal, Principal, Indo Global College of Engg. & Tech., Abhipur on 14th January, 2009 and the members observed a two minutes slience in the memory of departed soul. Thereafter, he requested the Vice Chancellor to grant permission to start the meeting. The meeting started with the introduction of all the members.

31.1 To confirm the minutes of the 30th meeting of the Academic Council held on 6th February, 2008 at 11:30 am at Sant Baba Bhag Singh Institute of Engineering & Technology, Padhiana (Jalandhar)

The Member Secretary informed the Council that no comments had been received from any member on the proceedings of the 30th meeting of the Academic Council held at Sant Baba Bhag Singh Institute of Engineering & Technology, Padhiana (Jalandhar). The proceedings were taken as confirmed.

31.2 Action taken report on the 30th meeting of the Academic Council

The Council noted the action taken as specified in the agenda. It was however pointed out in respect of Item No. 30.11 i.e. to establish the common eligibility criteria in

respect of PTU course common to regular mode and distance mode the notification has not been made. The Chairman informed that the action taken shall be intimated in the next meeting.

31.3 Presentation regarding activities of the University

The Chairman gave a brief presentation about the profile of the University which comprises of two phases. The first phase focused on achieving the target of expansion while in the 2nd phase the University shall march ahead with focus on consolidation, quality and brand building of the University. He informed that AICTE has advertised that out of seven states which have seats in excess of the National average in technical education, the state of Punjab is one of them. Within 12 years of establishment, quantitative expansion of this nature is quite commendable.

Briefing the Council about the intake of students, courses and colleges under PTU, he shared with the council, the plans of 2nd phase of construction of University campus which included University Guest House, Academic Blocks, Staff Residence and auditorium etc. He informed that the University has constructed its building without any financial assistance from the government and acknowledged the contributions made by the former Vice Chancellor Dr. S. K. Salwan for giving the University its own building. The concept of the building has been designed to make it eco-friendly and extensive use of non-conventional energy sources shall be taken up.

He also expressed gratitude to all the members for extending their support and cooperation in achieving the objectives of the University and hoped to get their support in future as well. The members congratulated the Vice Chancellor for the achievements made by the University inspite of all the constraints and limitations.

31.4 Constitution of New Board of Studies

The new Board of Studies as notified was ratified. It was pointed out that separate Board of Studies of subjects like Mathematics and Nano Technology should also be constituted. Members desired that all BOS must have equal number of members and the BOS must be expanded to include more industry participation.

The Chairman informed the Council that a meeting of all the Chairpersons of Board of Studies will be called shortly and all matters pertaining to syllabi expansion of BOS shall be taken up with them.

After detailed deliberations, it was decided that the matter shall be considered on case-to-case basis by a Committee to be constituted by the Vice Chancellor in consonance with the Regulations for M.Tech.

31.10 a) New syllabi of various courses.

The syllabi were ratified. With reference to the suggestions made regarding rationalization and revision of syllabi, the Chairman informed that the matter shall be taken up with the respective Board of Studies. It must be "Medium of Instructions and Examination is English" instead of "Medium of Instructions is English"

31.13 Relaxation of passing marks from 50% to 40% for B. Pharmacy course.

It was explained that as per Academic Regulations 2004, the pass percentage for all courses was uniformally decided as 40% already. However, old students who were admitted under 2001 Regulations were still considered pass at 50% as per the old regulations, even after they had opted for 2004 Regulations, as per directions of University through an affidavit. Since the decision of the Hon'ble High Court had directed the University to revise the results of old students also as per new regulations. The Council decided that the same may be extended to all similarly placed students, so that they do not have to approach the Hon'ble High Court for redressal of the issue individually.

31.14 To discuss about the affiliation fee and other related fee to be charged from the institutions affiliated to PTU.

The members noted the decision of the Board and assured early reconciliation and settlement of pending dues.

The Academic Council / Board of Governors must take firm stand on the issue of academic calendar. The University must ensure that all regular admissions are completed well before the beginning of the odd semester.

31.18 Revision of fee structure

Technically and legally the University opinion regarding the revision of fee structure may be correct. However, it is felt that the University cannot absolve itself from a moral responsibility that the colleges affiliated are not at a disadvantage vis-a-vis competition. For example the private universities are not only free to fix the fee structure but have the freedom to admit any number of students in any program. They have already started admissions for the next academic year.

UGC [GRANT OF DEGREE AND OTHER AWARDS BY UNIVERSITIES] REGULATIONS, 2003

UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION

New Delhi-110002, the September 2008

No. F. 1-19/2005 (CPP II).—In exercise of the power conferred by clause (f) and (g) of Sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the UGC Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission makes the following regulations namely:—

- 1. Short Title, Application and Commencement :
 - 1.1 The Regulations may be called the UGC [Grant of Degrees and Other Awards by Universities]
 Regulations, 2008;
- 1.2 These shall apply to all Universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial. Act, or a State/Union Territory Act and to all institutions deemed to be Universities under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956;
 - 1.3 These shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions:

In these Regulations, unless the contex, otherwise requires:

- 2.1 "Act" means the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (Act 3 of 1956);
- 2.2 "Authorities" means authorities like Executive Council and Academic Council, so defined by a University in its Act;
- 2.3 "College" means an institution engaged in higher education and/or research, either established by a University as its constituent unit or is affaliated to it;
- 2.4 "Commission" means the University Grants
 Commission, established under the Act;
- 2.5 "Convocation" means a ceremonial assembly of a University, normally held for conferring Degrees and other awards to its eligible candidates;
- 2.6 "Government" means the Central Government or the State/Union Territory Government, as the case may be;

- 2.7 "Graduation Ceremony" means a ceremonial assembly of a College, normally held for distributing Degrees and other awards to its eligible students;
- 2.8 "University" means a University so recognized by the Commission under Clause (f) of Section 2 of the UGC Act, 1956, or a deemed to be University so declared by notification in the Official Gazette by the Government, on the advice of the Commission under Section 3 of the same Act.

3. Objectives:

These Regulations shall have the following objectives, namely:

- 3.1 To ensure that each University grants Degrees and other awards to its eligible students regularly in every academic year;
- 3.2 To facilitate timely holding of a convocation or adopting any other method, for conferring the Degrees/other awards to eligible students at each University;
- 3.3 To assist the eligible students going for employment, higher studies and/or other opportunities, by giving their Degrees and other awards without delay;
- 3.4 To enhance the quality and standard of the University concerned, through its strict adherence to the academic calendar announced in advance;
- 3.5 To gain the confidence, goodwill and respect of stake holders, particularly students, through timely and orderly functioning of the University.

4. Procedure to be followed:

Each University shall follow the following procedure, namely:

- 4.1 At the beginning of each academic year, the University shall announce its academic calendar, giving the schedules for all its activities during the year;
- 4.2 In addition to the schedules for academic activities like courses and examinations, the calendar shall also include the date/s for Degree awards:
- 4.3 If necessary, the University may schedule Degree awards more often than once in year and the same shall be included in its academic calendar;
- 4.4 The Degree award date/s shall be within 180 days of the date/s by which the students are expected to qualify and become eligible for them;
- 4.5 The University shall notify a programme for Degree awards at least 30 days before the date/s so fixed, so that the candidates can apply for the same;
