(IT) through lateral entry.

36.13 Starting of 10+1 and 10+2 (Science) classes in the Engineering Colleges

Dean (Academics) informed the Council that as per Punjab Government letter letter No. 13/65/2010-1TE2/-3474 Dated 11.06.2010 colleges have been allowed to start 10+1 and 10+2 (Science) classes in the Engineering / Pharmacy colleges.

Some of the colleges have raised the issue that fee is very less.

The Vice-Chancellor has informed that the spirit of this scheme is to educate rural youth, therefore, the like in fee can not be considered. It is an optional scheme.

36.14 Implementation of 6th pay commission for faculty.

Dean (Academics) informed the Council that the 6th pay commission for faculty has been implemented by the Punjab Government in its colleges. The same is required to be implemented by the Private colleges also.

Some of the members showed their concern over implementation of 6th pay commission and requested to have a meeting of Managements of the Colleges on this issue.

The Chairman informed that a meeting of Forum of Managements of the Colleges has been scheduled to be held on 2nd December, 2010 where the matter of fee enhancement and implementation of 6th pay commission for faculty shall be taken up.

36.15 Amendment in regulations regarding Prevention, Punishment and Procedure concerning cases of misconduct and use of Unfair Means in or in Relation to Examination.

Item was deferred.

36.16 Signing of MoU between PTU, Jalandhar and PAU Ludhiana for collaborating research and teaching in Engineering & Technology.

Dean Academics informed the Council that the University is in process of signing MoU with PAU, Ludhiana for collaborative academic and research programme.
