A new University has also been established by the Govt. of Punjab vide Ordinance No. 4 of 2014 dated 15 Dec, 2014 the colleges falling in the Districts Bathinda, Barnala, Faridkot, Fatehgarh Sahib, Fazilka, Ferozepur, Mansa, Moga, Shri Muktsar Sahib, Patiala, Sangrur are being transferred to the new established University.

The Chairman informed the council that such type of rules and regulations should be framed for the all the courses for such type of students instead for a particular course. Further it was decided that a committee should be constituted with the nomination from organizations/NGO's working for such type of students. The council has authorized Vice Chancellor to constitute the committee and the recommendation of the committee should be placed in the next academic council meeting.

The agenda was discussed at a length in the meeting and all the members expressed the concern and advised to expedite the evaluation process. As informed by the Dean RIC that these are the few cases, therefore it is recommended that Dean RIC may put up for this relaxation i.e. to consider the time duration from the date of synopsis approval instead from the date of enrollment from case to case basis.

45.13 Constitution of new Board of Studies for the period of July 2014 to July 2016

"UGC and AICTE would ensure that Cyber Security / Information Security is introduced as a subject in the Universities/technical institutions at the under-graduate and post-graduate level."

The council has approved the same and advised to refer the same to BOS for inclusion in the teaching scheme.

45.16 Any other item with the permission of the Vice-Chancellor.

- (1) It was decided that the University will update the list of college for counseling indicating separately the UGC Autonomous/NAAC/NBA college, for the information of the students.
- (2) It was also discussed that there should be a Guest House of PTU in Mohali/ Chandigarh in view of the requirements of PTU and its affiliated colleges.
- (3) Directors of PITs raised the issue of extension to the existing contractual faculty. In view of the limited time period remaining in starting of Academic session i.e. starting from 15th July, 2015, it was decided to give one month extension to the existing contractual faculty.
