34.8 Grant of grace marks in one subject to pass out students.

The University has received number of requests for special grace from the pass out batch students who have only one reappear having shortage of marginal marks for completion of their degree and having job appointment letters from industries. Keeping in view the career of the students the Chairman, Academic Council has decided to grant a special grace of upto four marks to such students of pass out batches having reappear in only one paper for completion of degree in any subject / semester.

The matter is placed before the Council for ratification.

34.9 To review the eligibility criteria for M.Sc. (IT).

34.10 To inform about starting of PCI approved course Pharm'D.

The University has received an application from ISF College of Pharmacy, Moga for starting PCI approved Pharm'D course. The course is acceptable abroad and no addition paper is required to be taken in foreign countries to get registered therein.

The University has issued NOC to ISFCP, Moga for applying for this course to PCI.

Any pharmacy college interested to start the above course can apply to the PCI and University. The Scheme and syllabi has been referred to the concerned Board of Studies.

34.14 Implementation of industrial training for B. Tech degrees.

University has received complaint from Punjab State Human Rights Commission, Chandigarh about some of the colleges not arranging the industrial training program for the students. Students have to arrange their industrial training program themselves for which industries charge money from the students.

As per syllabus & Scheme the industrial training is mandatory for the 4 year degree programme students in 7th & 8th semester. Such training programmes are required to be arranged by the colleges under the supervision of the coordinator designated by the institute for the purpose of conducting and coordinating the training programmes. The coordinator is expected to interact with the industries to draw a schedule for training of the students keeping in view their stream/

course. In case of non-availability of training in industry for some students same may be given on industry live projects in the institution / college.

The students have to prepare project under the supervision of the college and after completion of the training; the college is to conduct viva-voce examination alongwith the evaluation of project report.

Keeping in view the contents of the complaint which are of serious nature, the following is proposed:

1. Colleges should arrange the industrial training of all the students
2. For each batch a coordinator of the training should be appointed as envisaged
3. The report of training should be prepared in the proforma to be supplied by the University

A report containing the information from 1 to 3 be submitted to the University alongwith the awards of industrial training.

The matter is placed before the Council for approval.

34.15 Starting of B.Tech Industrial Engineering & Management as part time at Gian Jyoti School of TQM & Entrepreneurship, Mohali.

Gian Jyoti School of TQM & Entrepreneurship, Mohali a constituent college of the University is running B, Tech. Industrial Engineering & Management in distance mode since 2004. Recently Ministry of Human Resource Development Department of Higher Education vide letter No. 6-7/2009-DL dated 29th July, 2009 has directed no university should offer any BE/B.Tech programme through distance mode. Consequently the school has requested the University to start the same course as part time course of the University.

The case was referred to the Board of Studies (Mechanical / Production and Industrial). BOS unanimously accepted the proposal of running B. Tech. in Industrial Engineering and Management as part time course. The Minutes of BOS meeting held on 25-11-09 at **Appendix – IX.**

33.7 To inform about introduction of new courses.

The revised curriculum for Management and Pharmacy was approved and it was also decided to implement the revised syllabi from the current session i.e. from 2009 – 10 onwards.

33.8 Autonomous Colleges.

It was approved that the cases for grant of autonomy to the colleges shall be dealt with according to UGC regulations.

33.9 Travel Grant for faculty / students / PTU staff.

The Council appreciated the steps taken by the University to provide travel grant to teachers, students and staff members of the colleges / University for paper presentation abroad.

PTU will provide grant to the candidates for one way travel fare and registration fee. It will be provided once a year to faculty and students of PTU affiliated college and staff of PTU. Maximum limit of providing such assistance would be Rs. 50,000/- per candidate. This will be available only for paper presentation and not for participation alone. The application for grant of travel assistance should be recommended by the Director / Principal of the concerned college. Grant will be reimbursed to the candidate after submission of claim along with the original documents.

Initially this facility shall be available once in a three years and it will be revised in due course of time. The guidelines of the AICTE shall be adhered to while implementing it.

The information regarding the above shall also be put on PTU website.

33.10 Research Projects and Govt. Schemes.

It was discussed that colleges should send proposals to different funding agencies for research & development projects. University shall provide all necessary support as and when required.


33.11 To discuss about rural area reservation in PTU affiliated Colleges.

33.12 To discuss non-conduct of CET & Admissions based on AIEEE 2010

After a detailed deliberation, it was decided that the case may be referred to Government alongwith the recommendations of the Council given as under:

1. Multiplicity of tests leads to lot of botheration to students, which could be avoided by resorting to making admissions on AIEEE merit basis which has been adopted by a large number of universities.
2. Rural area students generally do not have the exposure of competitive examinations. It was therefore decided that awareness be created amongst the students about the holding of admission through AIEEE/MAT/ for which if

- (iii) To review the even- odd examination system


Dr. N.P. Singh briefed the council about even – odd system. He informed the legal opinion was sought, accordingly to which University can amend any rules in between the course.

4. The question paper will comprise of 15 questions out of which candidate may attempt any 10
5. Duration of test will be 3 hours.

6. Questions in test paper will be based on the common contents of

- i. B.Tech and M.Tech courses of concerned disciplines of engineering
- ii. B.Arch and M.Arch Architecture
- iii. MBA

7. The paper will be designed to evaluate the comprehensive knowledge of the candidate of the basics of concerned discipline of study and the tools and techniques of analysis and design.

8. A candidate seeking admission to Ph. D program, will appear for interview before the RDC/ admission committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor.

9. A candidate admitted for PhD will have to do the following courses work in first semester:

- a. Subject 1: Research Methodology (Common to all) L=4 T=1 Max. Marks 100, Pass Marks 50
- b. Subject 2: A course, specific to research proposal (to be decided by RDC) L=4 T=1 Max. Marks 100, Pass Marks 50
- c. A Seminar on the topic related to proposed PhD research work
- d. Review of literature regarding the topic of PhD research

In case of subjects 'a' and 'b' there will be written examination at the end of the semester. Paper setting and evaluation will be done by the examiners appointed by the university.

In case of Seminar and Literature Review, candidate will be evaluated on the basis of separate presentations made before a panel comprising of;

1. Head of concerned department
2. External examiner appointed/approved by university
3. Internal examiner (Research Supervisor)

Note: Course 'b' will be decided by the RDC at the time of admission, and will be from the courses being offered to the M.Tech students of the university.






