**36.6 To inform about Revision of the Tuition Fee**

The Punjab Government has increased 10% tuition fee for all the AICTE courses. Similarly, 10% increase has also been made by the University in the tuition fee for Non-AICTE courses. A copy of the notification is enclosed as (Annexure – VII). This is to inform that the increased fee shall be implemented from the batch 2010 -11 onwards. The previous students shall be charged as per the old rates of the fee.

**36.7 To inform about the admission through Lateral Entry to BCA/BBA/ B.Sc.IT/ B.Sc. Fashion Technology and B.Sc. Biotechnology**

The Notification regarding the Lateral entry to BCA/BBA/B.Sc. Courses has been issued. Subsequently the meetings of the respective Board of Studies were held at the different times and the following decisions have been taken:

**36.8 To approve the amendment in the eligibility conditions of admission to B.Tech. Biotechnology and M.Tech. Biotechnology**

All the experts of the Board of Studies of Biotechnology and Biomedical Engineering has strongly recommended that the eligibility to take admission in the course of B.Tech. Biotechnology should be 10+2 with Physics Chemistry Mathematics and 10+2 with Physics Chemistry Biology. As B.Pharmacy is also a professional degree of four years in which this above said eligibility is



already followed with a condition that students with Mathematics background has to qualify the subjects of Biology in a course curriculum of 1st Year and students with biology background has to qualify the subjects of Mathematics in a course curriculum of 1st year. In this way students with Biology background will be equally benefitted and moreover Biotechnology is a field where the knowledge in the field of Biology is far more important than that of the Mathematics. There are several universities in India which are following the said eligibility conditions to make admissions in the course of B. Tech. Biotechnology. A list of those universities is enclosed as (Annexure- IX)

### 36.12 Mandatory Disclosure

It has already been decided in the 35<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council that all the colleges or institutions have to upload a common mandatory disclosure performa as prescribed by AICTE on their respective institutional website.

However, the institutes enclosed as (Annexure – XII) have not uploaded any information on its website till date. However, one simple Performa framed by a Committee is also forwarded to all the institutes for uploading as a mandatory disclosure; in case of AICTE mandatory disclosure Performa is not filled. All these colleges have to upload this information of institute immediately.

### 36.13 Starting of 10+1 and 10+2 (Science) classes in the Engineering Colleges

Punjab Government vide letter No. 13/65/2010-1TE2/-3474 Dated 11.06.2010 has allowed the Engineering / Pharmacy colleges to start 10+1 and 10+2 (Science) classes in the same premises. Such colleges have to seek affiliation from Punjab School Education Board, Mohali for this purpose.



Till 31 colleges have sought affiliation from Punjab School Education Board, Mohali to start 10+1 and 10+2 classes. In order to provide the quality technical education in the State of Punjab and to ensure full and effective implementation of the Punjab Government Notification, all the colleges are advised to start 10+1 and 10+2 classes in a manner that these do not interfere the regular classes of Engineering and other disciplines by using existing infrastructure i.e Land, Building, Classrooms, Equipment, Libraries, Laboratories and other facilities. Copy of Punjab Government Notification is enclosed as (Annexure- XIII) for reference.

**MINUTES OF 35<sup>th</sup> ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON 11-5-2010 AT 11:00 AM AT  
CONFERENCE HALL, PUNJAB TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY JALANDHAR**

Dr. Rajneesh Arora, Chairman, Academic Council and Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor, Punjab Technical University presided over the meeting.

Dr. Buta Singh Dean (Academic) welcomed the Chairman, Dr. Chander Mohan, BOG member and all the members of the Council.

Thereafter Sh. Chander Mohan exchanged his experience with the members of the Council and emphasised Industry-Academic interaction, setup of world class laboratories and faculty exchange programme with international institution or institutions of national importance. He expressed that we must translate ideas into practice for positive results.

The Chairman informed the Academic council regarding the recent changes in the University administration. He informed the Council about new appointments made on regular basis and the process is still continuing.

**35.1 To confirm the minutes of 34<sup>th</sup> Academic Council held on 08.02.2010**

Minutes of 35<sup>th</sup> Academic Council were confirmed .

**35.2 Action taken report on the 34<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council**

The Council noted the actions taken on the minutes of the 35<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting.

**35.3 To approve academic Calendar for the session 2010 -11.**

The Academic Calendar for the session 2010 - 11 (Odd and Even Semester) was approved.

The council has authorised the Vice Chancellor to constitute a committee to decide the vacation / sports and cultural activities.

**35.4 To inform about all admissions and counselling (2010-11)**

The Dean (Academics) informed the Council about the dates of various Entrance Tests and Counselling.

Dr. N.P. Singh, Chief Coordinator CET – 2010 informed that the date for declaration of result for CET – 2010 was fixed as 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2010, which is being pre-pond and the result will be declared within a week's time. He also informed that few institutes have been selected to provide training for online Counselling.

He has further informed the academic council members regarding the counselling for admission to B. Arch courses.



The Chairman briefed that as per Punjab Government notification, the admission to MBA / MCA courses shall be conducted by Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar

Dean (Academics) briefed that the PTU will conduct a joint counselling with PUTIA for admission to vacant seats in other States.

- 35.5. To approve introduction of new courses: (1) B.Tech. (Aeronautical Engg.) (2) B.Tech. (Welding Technology) (3) B.Sc. (Cyber Tech.), (4) MBA (Agriculture & Food Business)**

The following courses were also added in the list of new course :

1. M.Sc. (Public Health Management)
2. B. Tech. (Petro-chemical)
3. B. Tech. (Nano-technology)
4. M.Sc. (Fashion Technology)
5. M.Sc. (Industrial Pharmacy)
6. M.Sc. (Drug Regulatory Affairs)
7. MBA( Pharmaceutical Management)

Regarding starting of new courses it was decided that only those courses will be introduced that are available on the list of AICTE and for non-AICTE course the colleges may send proposals to the Dean (Academics) to start new programme which are feasible.

- 35.6 To inform about the status of B.Tech. (TQM) to start at Gian Jyoti Institute of TQM, Mohali**

The council noted the decision of BOG to start B.Tech. Industrial Engineering & Management with specialization in TQM at Gian Jyoti Institute of TQM, Mohali. The notification has already been issued and the admissions will be started from this session.

The academic council has also approved the teaching scheme, syllabus, eligibility conditions for admission alongwith rules and regulations.

- 35.7 To inform about Lateral entry admission to 2<sup>nd</sup> year / 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of BCA / BBA and B.Sc. courses**

The council noted. It was informed that the bridge courses can be framed for such students which will be mandatory for all to pass within stipulated period.

Further council have also recommended for 10% additional seats for lateral entry students to these courses on the pattern of AICTE.

- 35.8 To decide about upgradation on 1<sup>st</sup> semester result instead of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> semester result.**

The item was deferred as the students of first year are having two group viz A & B in which the ratio of students is 50:50. The students of group A study some subjects of first year in 1<sup>st</sup> semester while the group B studies these

subjects in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. So the uniform evaluation on the basis of 1<sup>st</sup> semester cannot be made.

Students who have passed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester in first attempt will be given preference for upgradation.

### 35.9 To submit Mandatory disclosure

It was decided that all the AICTE approve institutions will submit Mandatory Disclosure on the proforma prescribed by AICTE at the earliest.

However, a separate proforma will be prepared for non-AICTE courses which will be mandatory for all the non-AICTE courses. The same can be downloaded from PTU website.

### 35.10 Eligibility of student for Ph.D who did their Master's through Distance Education

The council approved Ph.D. registration of students who have done their Master's Degree through Distance Education Mode provided the degree awarding University/ Institute is approved by joint Committee of UGC /AICTE/DEC.

### 35.11 To approve amended Ph.D. Regulations.

The council approved the amended Ph.D. Regulations.

Council member have appreciated the efforts made to prepare the detailed regulations.

Further any suggestion given by Council members can be considered as an amendment in the future.

It is known to us all that the advance / grant given by PTU is very nominal as compared to the actual expenses. The PTU gives a portion of the total expenditure. 


**1. Eligibility for admission to B.Tech. Biotechnology Students:**

1. All the M. Phil degree holder candidates will have to appear in the Entrance Test for Enrolment in Ph.D. irrespective to their admission through entrance test or on merit basis to the M. Phill programme.
2. Keeping in view the acute shortage of supervisors, the maximum number of candidates, those can be registered for enrolment to Ph.D. Degree under a Supervisor/Co-supervisor has been reviewed. The maximum limit is kept according to UGC guidelines and is as follows:

3. The subjects for course work will be allotted to the provisionally registered candidates by the committee of Supervisor, Chairman BOS or Senior member of BOS and the Dean Research or his Nominee. *(min prof level)*

This committee will complete all the formalities of the research work of the candidate, from synopsis evaluation till final submission including yearly evaluation of candidate performance.
5. **Submission of Expert Panel for Thesis Evaluation:** When the RDC will allow the candidate for the submission of thesis, the Supervisor would submit a panel of minimum eight examiners, out of which, at least half will be from within India and rest half from abroad to obtain the prior consent for thesis evaluation. Panel should include the full particulars containing designation, area of specialization, E-mail ID, Complete Address, Contact Numbers etc. of the members. The panel should accompany five copies of long abstract of thesis and the list of major references. The supervisor should preferably recommend only those examiners, whose research work is referred by candidate in his/her research work under evaluation.



The Governor of Punjab is pleased to allow starting of 10+1 and 10+2 classes in all institutes of technical education as approved by All India Council of Technical Education in the State of Punjab from the academic session 2010-11.

2. These institutes, to begin with, would offer 10+1 and 10+2 classes for non-medical subjects but there would be no bar on starting classes for medical subjects, if existing infrastructure and teachers of the institutes justifies to do so.

3. These institutes would admit students on the basis of their merit in school examination at 10<sup>th</sup> standard. Initially, these institutes would start two sections of 40 students each at 11<sup>th</sup> standard in year-I i.e. 2010-11 and they would have two sections each at 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard of 40 students in a section in year-II i.e. 2011-12.

4. These institutes will be affiliated with Punjab School Education Board on fulfilling the following conditions:-

- i) Depositing the fee as prescribed by the Board;
- ii) Providing two class rooms exclusively for 10+1 and 10+2 classes; and
- iii) Appointing a Principal for 10+1 and 10+2 classes.

5. These institutes will charge fee as prescribed for 10+1 and 10+2 classes in government schools.

6. These institutes will utilize existing infrastructure i.e. land, building, class rooms, equipment, libraries, laboratories and other facilities subject to the conditions specified in para 3 above.

7. These institutes will run 10+1 and 10+2 classes in a manner and at time that these do not interfere in regular classes of engineering. This, however, shall not mean that 10+1 and 10+2 classes will not be held regularly. The flexibility with regard to timing of classes means that the institutes will need to set up timings for 10+1 and 10+2 classes in a manner that as far as possible they utilize available men and material with least inconvenience either to the existing students or to new science students at 10+1 and 10+2 level.

8. Subject to the fulfillment of conditions as stated above, the Punjab School Education Board would expedite affiliation of these institutes.

Having regard to decision of the Government of India conveyed vide notification no.1-32/2006-U-II-U.1 (i) dated 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2008 and 23-1/2008-TS.II and dated 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2009 (copy enclosed) and subsequent notification no. F.No.37-3/Legal/2010 dated 05<sup>th</sup> March, 2010 of All India Council for Technical Education (copy enclosed), the Governor of Punjab is pleased to revise the pay scale of the teaching staff of Government Promoted Engineering Colleges, and other degree level technical Institutions such as Architecture, Town Planning, B-Pharmacy, Applied Arts & Crafts etc. w.e.f. 01.01.2006 as per detail given below:-

1. The pay structure for different categories of teachers and equivalent positions shall be as indicated below:

(a) Assistant Professor/Associate Professors/Professors In Technical institutions

- i. Persons entering the teaching profession in Technical Institutions shall be designated as Assistant Professors and shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs.6000. Lecturers already in service in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 8000-13500, shall be re-designated as Assistant Professors with the said AGP of Rs. 6000.
- ii. An Assistant Professor with completed service of 4 years, possessing Ph. D Degree in the relevant branch / discipline shall be eligible, for moving up to AGP of Rs. 7000.
- iii. Assistant Professors possessing Master's degree in the relevant branch / discipline as defined for technical education shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7,000 after completion of 5 years service as Assistant Professor.
- iv. Assistant Professors who do not have Ph.D or a Master's degree in the relevant branch / discipline of a program shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7,000 only after completion of 6 years' service as Assistant Professor.
- v. The upward movement from AGP of Rs. 6000 to AGP of Rs. 7000 for all Assistant Professors shall be subject to their satisfying other conditions as laid down by AICTE.
- vi. The pay of the incumbents to the posts of Lecturer (senior scale) (i.e. the pre-revised scale of Rs. 10,000-15200) shall be re-designated as Assistant Professor, and shall be fixed at the appropriate stage in Pay Band of Rs.15600-39100 based on their present pay, with AGP of Rs. 7000.
- vii. Assistant Professors with completed service of 5 years at the AGP of Rs. 7000 shall be eligible, subject to other requirements laid down by the AICTE, to move up to the AGP of Rs. 8000.
- viii. Posts of Associate Professor shall be in the Pay Band of Rs.37400-67000, with AGP of Rs.9000. Directly recruited Associate Professors shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with an AGP of Rs. 9000, at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band in terms of the conditions of appointment.
- ix. Incumbent Assistant Professor and Incumbent Lecturers (Selection Grade) who



1.1.2006 shall be placed in Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000 and shall be re-designated as Associate Professor.

- x. Incumbent Assistant Professor and Incumbent Lecturers (Selection Grade) who had not completed three years in the pay scale of Rs. 12000-18300 on 1.1.2006 shall be placed at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 8000 till they complete 3 years of service in the grade of Lecturer (Selection Grade), and thereafter shall be placed in the higher Pay Band of Rs.37400-67000 and accordingly re-designated as Associate Professor.
- xi. Lecturers (Selection Grade) in service at present shall continue to be designated as Lecturer (Selection Grade), as the case may be, until they are placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400-67000 and re-designated as Associate Professor in the manner described in (x) above.
- xii. Assistant Professors completing 3 years of teaching in the AGP of Rs. 8000 shall be eligible, subject to other conditions, that may be prescribed by AICTE as applicable, to move to the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000 and to be designated as Associate Professor.
- xiii. Associate Professor completing 3 years of service in the AGP of Rs. 9000 and possessing a Ph.D. degree in the relevant discipline shall be eligible to be appointed and designated as Professor, subject to other conditions of academic performance as laid down by the AICTE. No teacher other than those with a Ph.D. shall be promoted, appointed or designated as Professor. The Pay Band for the post of Professors shall be Rs.37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 10000.
- xiv. The pay of a directly recruited Professor shall be fixed at a stage not below Rs. 43000 in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, with the applicable AGP of Rs. 10000.
- xv. Ten percent of the posts of Professors in a AICTE approved Institution shall be in the higher AGP of Rs. 12000, however, teachers appointed to the posts shall continue to be designated as Professor. Eligibility for appointment as a Professor in the higher Academic Grade Pay shall be as may be laid down by the AICTE, and such eligibility conditions shall, inter alia, include publications in peer reviewed/ refereed Research Journals, and the requirement of at least 10 years of teaching as Professor and post-doctoral work of a high standard. No person appointed directly as Professor in the AGP of Rs. 12000 shall be fixed at a stage less than Rs. 48000 along with the AGP.
- xvi. For initial direct recruitment at the level of Associate Professors and Professors, the eligibility conditions in respect of academic and research requirements shall be as may be or have been prescribed by the AICTE, through Regulations and as may be laid down by the AICTE.
- xvii. Discretionary award of advance increments for those who enter the profession as Associate Professors or Professors with higher merit, high number of research publications and experience at the appropriate level, shall be within the competence of the appropriate authority of the concerned University or recruiting institution while negotiating with individual candidates in the context of the merits of each case, taking into account the pay structure of other teachers in the faculty and other specific factors.
- xviii. All advancements to higher grade pays in various cadres will be effected subject to completion of two AICTE approved refresher programs of not less than two weeks duration each and two one week each TEQIP sponsored programs.

#### Pay Scales of Principals/Directors in Colleges:

Appointments to the posts of Principal in Technical Institutions shall be based on the conditions of eligibility in respect of educational qualifications and teaching/research experience. The posts of Principal shall be in the

000 per month. All Principals in service shall be appropriately fixed in the Pay Band with the AGP of Rs. 10000 plus a Special Allowance of Rs. 3000 per month.

**Pay Scales and Career Advancement Scheme for Librarians etc:**

**Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian**

- (i) Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs. 8000-13500 shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 6000.
- (ii) All the conditions of eligibility and academic qualifications laid down by the AICTE shall be applicable for direct recruitment of Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian.

**Assistant Librarian (Sr. Scale)/ College Librarian (Sr. Scale)**

- (i) The posts of Assistant Librarian (Sr. Scale)/ College Librarian (Sr. Scale) in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs. 10000-15200 shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 7000.
- (ii) Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian possessing Ph.D. in Library Science at the entry level, after completing service of 4 years in the AGP of Rs. 6000, and if otherwise eligible as per guidelines laid down by the AICTE shall be eligible for the higher AGP of Rs. 7000 with in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100.
- (iii) Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian not possessing Ph.D. but only M.Phil in Library Science at the entry level after completing service of 5 years in the AGP of Rs. 6000, if otherwise eligible as per guidelines laid down by the AICTE, shall become eligible for the higher AGP of Rs. 7000.
- (iv) After completing service of 6 years in the AGP of Rs. 6000 Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian without the relevant Ph.D. and M. Phil shall, if otherwise eligible as per guidelines laid down by the AICTE move to the higher AGP of Rs. 7000.
- (v) The pay of the existing Assistant Librarian (Sr. Scale)/ College Librarian (Sr. Scale) in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs. 10000-15200 shall be fixed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 7000 at an appropriate stage based on their present pay.

**Deputy Librarian / Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade) / College Librarian (Selection Grade)**

- (i) Deputy Librarians who are directly recruited shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-32100 with AGP of Rs. 8000 initially at the time of recruitment.
- (ii) On completion of service of 5 years, Assistant Librarian (Sr. Scale) / College Librarian (Senior Scale) shall be eligible for the post of Deputy Librarian / equivalent posts in Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100, with Academic Grade Pay of Rs. 8,000, subject to their fulfilling other conditions of eligibility (such as Ph.D. degree or equivalent published work etc. for Deputy Librarian) as laid down by the AICTE. They shall be designated as Deputy Librarian/ Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade)/ College Librarian (Selection Grade), as the case may be.
- (iii) The existing process of selection by a Selection Committee shall continue in respect of promotion to the post of Deputy Librarian and their equivalent positions.
- (iv) After completing 3 years in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with an AGP of Rs. 8000. Deputy Librarians/ equivalent positions shall move to the Pay



- (v) Assistant Librarians ( Senior Scale) in universities/ College Librarians (Senior Scale) in the AGP of Rs.7000 not possessing Ph.D. in Library Science or equivalent published work but who fulfill other criteria prescribed by the AICTE, shall also be eligible for being placed in the AGP of Rs. 8000.
- (vi) Incumbents to the posts of Deputy Librarian/ Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade) / College Librarian (Selection Grade) who have completed three years in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 12000-18300 on 1.1.2006 shall be fixed at an appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with an AGP of Rs. 9000. They shall continue to be designated as Deputy Librarian / Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade) / College Librarian (Selection Grade)
- (vii) Incumbents to the posts of Deputy Librarian / Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade)/College Librarian (Selection Grade) who have not completed the requirement of three years in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 12000-18300, for being eligible to be placed in the higher Pay Band of Rs. 37400-57000, shall be placed at an appropriate stage with Academic Grade Pay of Rs.8000 till they complete three years of service as Deputy Librarian/ Assistant Librarian (Selection Grade)/ College Librarian (Selection Grade).
- (viii) Pay in regard to the directly recruited Deputy Librarians shall be initially fixed in Pay Band Rs. 15500-39100 with AGP of Rs. 8000. They shall move to the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000 after completing three years of service in the AGP of Rs. 8000.
- (ix) The existing conditions of eligibility and academic qualifications prescribed by the AICTE shall continue to be applicable for direct recruitment to the post of Deputy Librarian.

**Pay Scales and Career Advancement Scheme for Physical Education Personnel:**

- (a) Assistant Director of Physical Education (Assistant DPE) / College Director of Physical Education (College DPE)
  - (i) The Assistant Director of Physical Education/ College DPE in the pre-revised pays scale of Rs. 8000-13500 shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs.15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 6000.
  - (ii) Pay of incumbent Assistant Directors of Physical Education / College DPE shall be fixed at an appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with an AGP of Rs. 6000, in accordance with the 'fixation formula' of the 6th CPC.
  - (iii) All existing conditions of eligibility and academic qualifications laid down by the AICTE shall continue to be applicable for direct recruitment of Assistant Director of Physical Education / College DPE.
- (b) Assistant Director of Physical Education (Senior Scale) / College DPE (Senior Scale)
  - (i) Assistant Directors of Physical Education (Senior Scale) / College DPE (Senior Scale) in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 10000-15200 shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 7000.
  - (ii) Assistant Directors of Physical Education (Senior Scale)/ College DPE (Senior Scale) possessing Ph.D. in Physical Education at the entry level of Assistant DPE/ College DPE in the AGP of Rs. 6000 shall, after completing service of four years in the AGP of Rs.6000, and if otherwise eligible as per guidelines prescribed by the AICTE, move to higher AGP of Rs. 7000 in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100.



Assistant Directors of Physical Education/ College DPEs without the relevant Ph.D. and M.Phil shall, after completing service of six years as Assistant Director of Physical Education/College DPE in the AGP of Rs. 6000, and if otherwise eligible as per guidelines prescribed by the AICTE, be eligible for being placed in the AGP of Rs. 7000.

Pay of incumbent Assistant Directors of Physical Education (Senior Scale)/ College DPE (Senior Scale) shall be fixed in Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 at an appropriate stage in the AGP of Rs. 7000, as per the 'fixation formula' of the 6:h CPC.

Deputy Director of Physical Education / Assistant Director of Physical Education (Selection Grade) / College Director of Physical Education (Selection Grade)

After completing service of five years in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 with the AGP of Rs. 7000 and subject to satisfying other eligibility conditions laid down by the AICTE, Assistant Director of Physical Education (Senior Scale)/ College DPE (Senior Scale) shall move to AGP of Rs. 8000 in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100. They shall be designated as Deputy Director of Physical Education/ Assistant DPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade), as the case may be.

i) After completing service of three years in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 and the AGP of Rs. 8000 and subject to eligibility laid down by the AICTE, Deputy DPE/ Assistant DPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade) shall move to the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with the AGP of Rs. 9000. They shall continue to be designated as Deputy DPE/ Assistant DPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade)

iii) All Incumbents to the post of Deputy DPE/ Assistant DPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade) who have completed service of at least three years in the un-revised Pay Scale of Rs. 12000-18300 as on 1.1.2006 shall be eligible to be fixed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000.

iv) All incumbents to the post of Deputy DPE/ Assistant DPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade) whose services in the un-revised Pay Scale of Rs. 12000-18300 fall short of three years which would have made them eligible to move to the higher Pay Band, shall be placed at an appropriate stage at the AGP of Rs. 8000 in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 till they complete the required service of three years as Deputy DPE/ ADPE (Selection Grade)/ College DPE (Selection Grade) in the un-revised Pay Scale.

v) Pay of the directly recruited Deputy DPE shall be initially fixed with the AGP of Rs. 8000 in the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100, and after completing 3 years of service directly recruited Deputy DPE and equivalents shall move to Pay Band Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000.

Incentives for Ph.D. / M.Tech. and other higher qualification:

i) Five non-compounded advance increments shall be admissible at the entry level of recruitment to persons possessing the degree of Ph.D. awarded in the relevant discipline by a university following the process of registration, coursework and external evaluation as prescribed by UGC.

ii) M.Phil degree holders at the time of recruitment to the post of lecturer shall be entitled to two non-compounded advance increments.

Post Graduate degree in a professional course such as



- (iv) Teachers who complete their Ph.D. degree while in service shall be entitled to three non-compounded increments if such Ph.D. is in the relevant branch / discipline and has been awarded by a university complying with the process prescribed by the UGC for enrolment, course-work and evaluation etc.
- (v) However, teachers in service who have been awarded Ph.D. at the time of coming into force of this Scheme or having been enrolled for Ph.D. have already undergone course-work, if any, as well as evaluation, and only notification in regard to the award of Ph.D. is awaited, shall also be entitled to the award of three non-compounded increments even if the university awarding such Ph.D. has not yet been notified.
- (vi) Teachers in service who have not yet enrolled for Ph.D. shall therefore derive the benefit of three non-compounded increments on award of Ph.D. while in service only if such enrolment is with a university recognized by UGC.
- (vii) Teachers who acquire M.Phil degree or a M.Tech degree in a relevant Branch / discipline recognised by a Statutory University while in service, shall be entitled to one advance increment.
- (viii) Five non-compounded advance increments shall be admissible to Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian who are recruited at entry level with Ph.D. degree in the discipline of library science from a university complying with the process prescribed by the UGC in respect of enrolment, course-work and evaluation process for the award of Ph.D. in library science.
- (ix) Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian and other Library personnel acquiring the degree of Ph.D. at any time while in service, in the discipline of library science from a university complying with the process prescribed by the UGC in respect of enrolment, course-work and evaluation shall be entitled to three non-compounded advance increments.
- (x) However, persons in posts of Assistant Librarian/College Librarian or higher positions who have been awarded Ph.D. in library science at the time of coming into force of this Scheme or having been enrolled for Ph.D. in library science have already undergone course-work, if any, as well as evaluation, and only notification in regard to the award of Ph.D. is awaited, shall also be entitled to the award of three non-compounded increments even if the university awarding such Ph.D. has not yet been notified by the UGC as having complied with the process prescribed by the Commission.
- (xi) In respect of every other case of persons in the posts of Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian or higher positions who are already enrolled for Ph.D. shall avail the benefit of three non-compounded increments only if the university awarding the Ph.D. has been notified by the UGC to have complied with the process prescribed by the UGC for the award of Ph.D. in respect of either course-work or evaluation or both, as the case may be.
- (xii) Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian and others in higher Library positions in service who have not yet enrolled for Ph.D. shall therefore derive the benefit of three non-compounded increments on award of Ph.D. while in service only if such enrolment is with a university which complies with the entire process, including that of enrolment as prescribed by the UGC.
- (xiii) Two non-compounded advance increments shall be admissible for Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian with M.Phil degree in Library Science at the entry level. Assistant Librarian/ College Librarian and those in higher positions acquiring M.Phil degree in Library Science at any time during the course of their service shall



- (xv) For posts at the entry level where no such advance increments were admissible for possessing Ph.D / M. Tech, under the earlier scheme, the benefit of five advance increments for possessing Ph.D./ M. Tech, shall be available to only those appointments which have been made on or after the coming into force of this Scheme.

Other terms and conditions:

Increments:

- (i) Each annual increment shall be equivalent to 3% of the sum total of pay in the relevant Pay Band and the AGP as applicable for the stage in the Pay Band.
- (ii) Each advance increment shall also be at the rate of 3% of the sum total of pay in the relevant Pay Band and the AGP as applicable and shall be non-compoundable.
- (iii) The number of additional increment(s) on placement at each higher stage of AGP shall be as per the existing scheme of increment on promotion from lower Pay Scale to higher Pay Scale; however, in view of the considerable raise in effective pay between the two Pay Bands, there shall be no additional increment on movement from the Pay Band of Rs. 15600-39100 to the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000.

2. The above pay scale shall be implemented keeping in view the following conditions:-

1. These Engineering Colleges shall have to pay the 20% of the balance share on account of revision of pay scales from their own resources (80% being given by Government of India). They shall do so after receiving 80% of the payable amount from MHRD/GOI.
2. It is made clear to the management of these colleges that the State Government shall not bear any liability whatsoever resulting as a result of this revision (either arrears, current or infuture)

3. AGE OF SUPERANNUATION

The age of superannuation of faculty in Technical Institutions shall remain as earlier

4. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF TEACHERS

Other terms and condition of services of teachers shall be applicable as would be notified by the State Government from time to time.


