**Subject: Invitation for proposals regarding Technical Book Writing/Translation of AICTE Model Curriculum.**

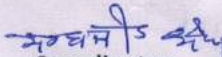
The AICTE has taken an initiative of Technical Book Writing/Translation Scheme for the AICTE Model Course Curriculum 2018-19, in regional languages. The responsibility of the technical book writing/translation in Punjabi has been assigned to the IK Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala.

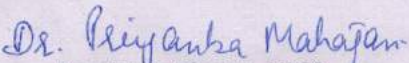
The University is going to start the technical book writing/translation project for the first-year undergraduate courses prescribed by AICTE. Proposals are invited for the technical book writing/translation strictly as per AICTE Model Curriculum. The essential eligibility for the allocation of said project, is as below.

1. The writer/translator should be academically oriented.
2. He/she must have adequate teaching experience of the concerned subject.
3. The Writer/translator should have proficient in Punjabi & English language.
4. The writer/translator must have in-depth knowledge of the concerned subject.
5. He/she must have already contributed to writing or translating the book(s).

The willing subject experts may apply with simple application to the **Faculty In-Charge, Department of Humanities, Languages and Cultural Studies, First Floor, CB-II, IK Gujral Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar-Kapurthala Highway, Kapurthala 144603** by February 22, 2021. The complete proposal must have included the scope of the project along with few pages of proposed book/translation. The application must support the necessary documents/testimonials.

The incomplete applications will be rejected without any communication. The Expert Committee is the final authority to allocate the projects and the Committee may nominate any eminent scholar for the technical book writing/translation.
