#### 2.0 The guidelines/regulations for admissions are as under:-

### A. Eligibility Criteria (Educational Qualifications & Resident Status)

- (i) The eligibility criteria for admission shall be same as notified by the University (*Appendix 'A'*) and/or revised from time to time.
- (ii) For admission to the UGC (Non-AICTE) Courses, 85% seats shall be reserved for the candidates from within the State and 15% will be reserved for the candidates from outside the State.
- (iii) Admission will be made on the basis of Rank prepared based on inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination for both 85% quota for resident of Punjab and 15% quota for outside Punjab.
- (iv) Weightage of 5% in the marks obtained in qualifying examination shall be awarded to those candidates who have studied for atleast three years or have passed their +1 and +2 examination from the schools located in **Rural Area**. (Format of Rural Area is attached at **Appendix 'B'**)

### B. General Eligibility Criteria for Admissions :

Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria for admission shall be same as mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, Memo No.35/44/95/T (2) 978 dated 21<sup>st</sup> March 2003, which is attached at *Appendix 'C'* to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

#### **Exemption Under above para**

Children/wards/dependent (Whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab-cadre, serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations /Statutory

Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the respective Academic Session.

#### C. Reservation:

- (i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13 / 2/ 05 –1TE2/1987 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019, which are attached at *Appendix 'D'* to this notification or as notified by Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training from time to time. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
- (ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for online counselling. If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Candidate".
- (iii) The I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the online application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any under which reservation is being sought, so that inter se gradation can be facilitated. There sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo No.13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013 and memo dated 13th September, 2019.
- (iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make a claim for reservation in any of the reserved category. However, the procedure for a counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo No. 7/21/2004-RS1/1674-1677 dt. 20<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2004.

### D. Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme for Non-AICTE Courses:

As per IKGPTU **Notification Ref. No. IKGPTU/Reg/N/3767 dated 27/11/2018**, which is attached at **Appendix 'E'**, the Tuition Fee Waiver scheme shall also be applicable on UGC courses on the pattern of AICTE courses, as per guidelines / criteria notified by the Punjab Government from time to time. (Punjab Government notifications & Guidelines of AICTE published in its APH 2024-27 related to TFW Scheme are attached at **Appendix 'F'**).

Note: Please go through the latest guidelines i.e. "Requirements and Eligibility" and "Admission Procedure" related to Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme, issued by the AICTE in its Approval Process Handbook 2024-2027 at para 6.42 & Page No. 59 for your kind information and reference. (copy enclosed)

The institute shall publicize the notice / advertisement in the newspaper and Institute website about direct counselling of Tuition Fee Waiver Seats (i.e. Name of course & Number of Seats and dates of submission of application and allotment of seat).

The TFW seat shall be issued to eligible candidates belonging to Punjab State on merit basis. The institute shall submit the authenticated counselling status report (i.e. copy of Advertisement published, details of candidate submitted application, Merit list, allotment letters issued to beneficiaries) in the office of Dean (Academics) within 3 working days of completion of counselling of TFW seats.

#### E. Fee & Other charges:

The students shall be liable to pay Tuition Fee/ Development Fee and Other applicable Charges as notified by the I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University during respective Academic Session and / or revised from time to time.

#### G. Procedure for Admission:

- (i) The admission shall be made through Direct Counselling at Institute level. There shall be 2 Rounds of Direct Counselling, through which seats will be allocated after considering the reservation policy of Punjab Government and merit of student.
- (ii) After end of 2 Rounds of Direct counselling the vacant seats will be converted in common pool and the same will be allocated on First Come First Serve basis till the last date of Admission. If the number of applicants are more than the available number of Seats then the seat will be allocated on merit basis
- (iii) Non-refundable Admission Processing Fee of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only), will be collected by the concerned institute from each student and subsequently the same shall be deposited by the respective College in the University.
- (iv) The Colleges / Institutes shall display the dates to apply for these courses and dates of the counseling on the website of the college. Wherever possible, the counseling will be made online.
- (v) The counseling will be made purely on the basis of merit and should be displayed to the students.
- (vi) The College will submit the record (i.e. Branch wise merit list of students participated in counselling and allotment of seats) of the candidate admitted through direct counseling, (within 7 days of seat allocation) in the Admission Cell of IKGPTU for record.

#### (vii) Preparation of Merit list

- (1) There will be a common merit lists for General and Reserved categories / subcategories (if applicable) candidates belonging to Punjab State Quota (85%) and Other State Quota (15%).
- (2) The merit list shall be prepared based on percentage of aggregate marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination.

In case of tie in the merit, the following criteria will be followed for tie breaking:

- (a) The candidate securing higher aggregate percentage marks (in compulsory subjects) in the matriculation examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
- (b) In the case of tie in (a) above, the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in order of merit.
- (viii) Counseling for 85% seats of Punjab residents and 15% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously. However, the reserved category candidates shall be considered in general category, first before being considered in the respective category.
- (ix) The college will issue a public notice on official website to this effect indicating clearly the number of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category in all the rounds of counseling.
- (x) Institute must complete atleast two rounds of counseling based on rank in inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination considering the respective reserve category, as applicable

- by Punjab Govt.
- (xi) After following above said procedure, if still the seats remaining vacant in reserve category, the college can fill these from candidates belonging to general category in subsequent step at the end of counseling.
- (xii) The last date, upto which students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason will be same as notified by the UGC / IKGPTU in its Academic Calendar from time to time. No student should shall be admitted in any institution after the last date under any quota. Hence admission to these courses shall be allowed only once in an academic session.
- (xiii) The whole process will cease on the last date of admission as finalized by Regulatory Body i.e. UGC/IKGPTU/State Govt. etc.
- (xiv) The candidate must have passed qualifying examination at the time of admission.
- (xv) The admitting students shall be liable to pay applicable Semester Fee to the concerned College as notified by the University from time to time.
- (xvi) The candidate seeking admission shall submit the application form (specimen attached at Appendix 'G') in the respective college at the time of admission and will also require to produce all the requisite academic certificates in original, for eligibility verification.
- (xvii) The college will verify the original documents of the candidates at the time of admission and ensure that the eligibility is fulfilled before making admission.
- (xviii) The College/Institute must upload the details of all the admitted students on the webportal of the University upto the last date of admission.
- (xix) Colleges shall deposit the non-refundable Admission Processing Fee of Rs. 2,000/- w.r.t. each student (except admitted through IKGPTU Counselling) enrolled on the webportal.
- (xx) The concerned college will require to produce the documents of admitted students in original to the University for Eligibility Verification as per schedule notified by University.
- (xxi) For International Students, admission guidelines and fee structure notified by the University vide notification No. IKGPTU/REG/NF/AC/2039 dated 30.10.2023 shall be followed. (Copy attached at *Appendix 'H'*)
- (xxii) The guidelines for admission of Foreign National / Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) shall be as per notification issued by the Punjab Government from time to time.
- (xxiii) In case a student surrenders his / her seat within 7 days of the end of the Direct Counseling, he / she must submit application to the College and colleges must refund his / her full fee after deduction of Rs. 1,000/- only and the original documents will be returned immediately.
- (xxiv) In keeping with the direction of Ministry of Human Recourse Development Department, Govt. of India all Institutions and Universities shall in public interest, maintain a waiting list of students/candidates. In the event of a student/candidate withdrawing before the start of the course, the waiting list candidates should be given admissions against the vacant seat. The entire fees collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for institutions and universities to retain the certificates in original. If a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant gets filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the institution must return the fees collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable and the original documents will be returned immediately.
- (xxv) All Institutions affiliated to I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall follow 'Fee Waiver Scheme' as prescribed by AICTE and notified by Government of Punjab vide its notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/1797, dated 23rd May, 2011, Notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/2007 dated 31.5.2012, Letter No. 751-752/S-I/ECC/2015 dated 13.05.2015 and Letter No. 428-430 dated 04.04.2020.

(xxvi) As per section 7 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016, use of Aadhaar Authentication Services while identifying beneficiaries and processing the benefit under any scholarship scheme of government is mandatory. The Institutions of Universities shall adhere to the guidelines and regulations defined by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI).

#### H. Refund of Fee Guidelines:

Reference on the subject noted above. In supersession of this department memo No. 35/44/95IT (2)/738. Dated  $4^{th}$  March, 2003, the following shall be the eligibility criteria for admission to Professional/Diploma/Degree/Post Graduate level Engineering/Technical/Pharmacy and Architecture courses in Punjab State for session 2003-2004:

(i) 85% seats will be reserved for the candidates from within the State and 15% will be open to candidates on All India basis. The eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidate must be resident of Punjab State in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PPI Br.) letter No.1/3/953PP1/9619, dated the 6th June, 1996 and letter No.1/3/95PPII/81, dated the 1st January, 1999 and should have passed qualifying examination from any recognized Board/University.

In case, the residence certificate is found at any stage to be false or incorrect, the admission against Punjab quota shall be liable to be cancelled, without prejudice to any criminal proceedings that may be initiated. Furthermore, the fees or any other amount paid, including advance or security, shall be automatically treated as forfeited.

- (ii) The above condition regarding a candidate being resident of Punjab shall not be applicable to the following categories of candidates:
  - a. Candidates seeking admission under NRI quota; if eventually permitted:
  - b. Children, wards and dependents of Punjab Government employees and employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies/Companies/Cooperative Societies set up or owned or controlled by the Punjab Government, including those established by or under an Act of the State of Punjab or a Central Act, by the Punjab Government, posted within or outside the state of Punjab.
  - c. Children, wards and dependents of members of All India Services borne on Punjab Cadre, irrespective of where the officer is posted. This shall also include children, wards and dependents of members of All –India Services borne on cadres other than that of Punjab, provided the said officer is on deputation with Punjab Government or any of its Boards, corporations, statutory bodies, companies, cooperative Societies enumerated in sub para (b) above, irrespective his place of posting.
  - d. Children, wards and dependents of the Central Government employees who have served for atleast two years in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government or any of its Boards, Corporations, Statutory Bodies, Companies, Cooperative Societies enumerated in sub para (b) above out of 5 years proceeding the year of entrance examination;

- e. Children, wards and dependents of those Punjab Government pensioners settled outside Punjab.
- f. Children, wards and dependents of military/paramilitary forces personnel belonging to the State of Punjab as per record at the time of their entry in service (A certificate on prescribed proforma by the Commanding officers of the Unit has to be furnished); and
- g. Children, wards and dependents of the ex-employees of military/para military forces personnel belonging to the State of Punjab as per record at the time of their entry into service.
- (iii) A candidate must have appeared in the Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by the Punjab Technical University for admission of graduate courses and Joint Entrance Test (JET) conducted by the Punjab State Board of Technical Education.
- (iv) The guidelines issued for the grant of residence certificates/bonafide resident of Punjab by the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP2 Br.) vide No.1/3/953P2/9619, dated the 6th June, 1996 and I.D.No.1/2/963PP2/8976, dated 7th July, 1998 and No.1/3/953PP2/80, dated 1st January, 1999 and further instructions, issued by that Department, if any, will be adhered to in letter and spirit while making admission to the degree/Technological courses in the Engineering Colleges and in the University etc.
- (v) NRI seats were being previously filled as per guidelines issued by AICTE vide No.F.387/Legal/2001, dated 03.10.2001. However, the admission to NRI seats, if at all permitted by the Government of India and/or the AICTE, in light of the interpretation of the Judgement of the honourable Supreme Court of India in the case of TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others ((2002) 8 SCC 481: AIR 2003 SC 355), shall only be in accordance with the fresh guidelines to be issued by them, in due course.

- 1. Reference to Punjab Government, **Memo**. No. 13/2/05–1TE2/410 **Dated** 20.02.2006, on the subject noted above.
- 2. The aforesaid Reservation Policy has been reviewed and it has been decided to retain the previous policy in terms of substantive percentages of reservation for the various categories. The percentage of reservation for each of the categories shall be as under:-

(If suitable candidates are not available in anyone of these sub-categories, the seats so available will be filled up by the candidates from the other sub categories of disabled candidates and if they are not available in any sub-category then seats shall be filled up from general category candidates).

- (vii) Children/widows of defence personnel killed or disabled to the extent of 50% or more in action, wards of gallantry awardees, children of serving defence personnel/ex-servicemen (2%). The priority to this category is given as under:
  - (a) Killed in action
  - (b) Disabled in action & Boarded out of service.
  - (c) Died while in service & death attributable to military service.
  - (d) Disabled in service & Boarded out of service with disability attributable to military service
  - (e) Gallantry award/other award winners both serving/retired.
  - (f) Serving Defence Personnel/Ex-servicemen.
- (viii) Children/widows of Para-military forces personnel, Punjab Police, PAP and Punjab Home Guards killed or disabled in action to the extent of 50% or more; and children of paramilitary forces personnel/ex-paramilitary forces personnel, wards of Punjab Policemen decorated with Gallantry Medals (2%).

- (ix) November 1984 riots-affected displaced persons, children of the Army deserters Killed/100% physically disabled, children of the families of persons killed as a result of terrorist violence or by security forces acting in aid of civil authorities and the children of innocent civilians who have sustained 100% disability in terrorist violence or during operation by Security forces acting in aid of civil authorities (2%).
- (x) **Sibling (Single) girl child** or one of the girl of parents having two or more girls and having a no male child (an affidavit on a stamp paper worth Rs. 20/- duly attested by 1<sup>st</sup> Class Magistrate to obtained from the parents of the girl child) (1%).
- (xi) The reservation of T-sunami affect person shall be available for the children/grand children of original ex-serviceman settler of Campbell bay Island only **OR** Students suffering from **Cancer/AIDS/Thalassemia** (The claimant candidate will have to submit a certificate as a proof from the National Medical Institute like PGI, AIMS etc. in support of his/her claim) (1%)
- 3. The aforesaid percentage reservation in respect of each category shall, however, be subject to the detailed clarifications and *inter se* gradation criteria as decided in the meeting chaired by Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2003, the minutes of which are appended. These minutes and the decisions recorded therein shall be treated as a part and parcel of this communication.
- 4. Nothing in the aforesaid policy shall apply to the courses run by the three universities in the state, other than Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, in respect of the courses offered by them in their campuses or their regional centres. Admission to these courses shall be governed by the reservation policy framed by the respective University.
- 5. These policy instructions shall be subject to the law laid down by the honourable Supreme Court of India in the case of <u>TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others</u> (2002) 8SCC 481: AIR2003 SC 355).

You are requested to implement the above reservation policy in all the Professional/Engineering Colleges/Polytechnic Institutions/Industrial Training Institutes and Technical Institutes in the State.

With regard to above subject it is directed that all the Universities and institutions under Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training shall implement the provisions of relevant sections of The Right of Persons With Disabilities Act, 2016 as mentioned below:-

- Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Act:- The Universities and the institutions apart from implementing these provisions will also ensure to carry out special sensitization drives on their campuses for the benefit of all the students. They will also put up banners and flex boards at common places to spread awareness among students regarding rights of persons with disabilities.
- Section 22 of the Act:- As per provisions of this section all
  institutions and Universities are directed to maintain records of
  persons with disabilities in detail as mentioned in the sub-sections
  of this section.
- 3. Section 23 of the Act:- All universities and institutions are directed to create a Grievance Redressal Cell and to appoint a grievance redressal officer.
- 4. Section 28 of the Act:- Under this section all universities under the Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training are requested to initiate research activities in the field of enhancing habilitation, rehabilitation and other issues concerning empowerment of persons with disabilities.
- Section 32 of the Act:- All the Universities and institutions under the Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training shall

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reserve 5% seats for persons with benchmark disability for the purpose of admissions at the entry level classes with the immediate effect from the date of issuance of this letter, however this reservation percentage is revised from 3% to 4% for admission in certificate courses in ITIs in the State of Punjab as per the Directorate General of Training, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Government of India letter no.MSDE-19/02/2018-CD (pt) dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2019. They will also give relaxation in the upper age limit by 5 years in admission to courses being run in these institutions.

- Section 33 of the Act:-All the Government universities are directed to identify posts which can be held by respective category of persons with bench mark disabilities in respect of the vacancies reserved in accordance with the provisions of section 34 of the Act, 2016.
- Section 34 of the Act:-Every appropriate Government shall appoint in every Government establishment, not less than four percent of the total number of vacancies in the cadre strength in each group of posts. with respect to letter issued to from Punjab Government vide letter no.1/1/2017-3DS/1543557/1 dated 06.08.19.

All concerned are directed to implement the act in letter and spirit, especially above mentioned provisions of the Act.

In supersession of earlier Notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/2650 dated of 24.6.2010, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to re-notify the **Fee Waiver Scheme** as below in keeping with the guidelines of All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) as contained in the Approval Process Handbook (2011-2012):-

- i) The Scheme shall be applicable to all approved Technical Institutions offering Bachelor Programmes, Diploma and Post Diploma Programmes of Three/Four years duration.
- ii) These seats shall be 5% over and above sanctioned intake.
- iii) The Competent Authority for admissions shall be the same as for regular admission and eligibility criteria with regard to qualifications shall be the same as notified for other categories.
- iv) The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institutions approved by the AICTE.
- v) Sons and daughters of parents whose annual income is less than Rs. 2.50 Lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for seats under this scheme.
- vi) The Waiver shall be limited to the tuition fee as prescribed by the State Government. All other fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.
- vii) The admission shall be made by Punjab Technical University for degree level programmes in colleges affiliated to it and by Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training for diploma level courses in institutions affiliated to it.
- viii) In the event of non-availability of students in this category, the same shall not be given to any other category of applicants.
- ix) The Punjab Technical University & the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training shall invite applications under this category, make a separate merit list and effect admission on the basis of the merit list so generated, through a separate counselling which shall be held prior to regular counselling for admissions to various other categories.
- x) The Institutions shall publish in their brochure and web site the details of this scheme.
- xi) The Punjab Technical University & the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training shall submit a separate list of the students admitted under this category to the Institution to which they are admitted for compliance.
- xii) The Punjab Technical University & the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training shall issue a letter to each of the beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and such a beneficiary shall not be allowed to change Institution or Course under any circumstances. In case a selected beneficiary intends to forego the benefit of fee waiver to take admission in any other category, he shall be allowed to do so provided that the seat vacated by him shall go to the next eligible candidate under this scheme.
- xiii) All Institutions shall display information regarding candidates admitted under this scheme on their websites for information of general public and send a copy thereof to the Punjab Technical University and the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, as the case may be.
- xiv) The amount of fee thus waived off will not be claimed by any institution from the Government or any other authority in any context.
- xv) The fee waiver to a student shall be for the complete duration of the course.
- xvi) The student availing fee waiver seat will not be entitled to avail financial assistance under any other Government Scheme what so ever. However, he/she shall be eligible for any scholarship available on competition/merit basis.
- xvii) The implementation of this scheme shall be subject to any amendments/charges or orders of the State Government as may be issued from time to time.
- 2.0 This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.

- 6.39 All the AICTE Approved Institutions /Universities shall mandatorily upload **Affidavit 2** as specified in the Approval Process Handbook on the AICTE Web-Portal in an e-stamp paper with digital signature of the authorized signatories.
- 6.40 In case of any litigation pertaining to the penal action initiated by the Council for an Institution, for the contravention of any of the relevant Regulations, such Institution shall have to apply as per **Clause 7.11** (as applicable) on AICTE Web-Portal, in the absence of any specific court order to the contrary.
- 6.41 The **Clause 1.5.4** of the Approval Process Handbook does not permit Self-financing Institutions to use 'Indian', 'National', etc. in the Name of the Institution. The Institutions which were already given approval with those words shall change/ drop the word from the Name of the Institution, as the Stakeholders may misinterpret them to be Government/ Government Aided Institutions. ## 6.42 Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme

- b. The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institutions approved by the Council.
- c. Requirements and Eligibility
  - i Student's parents annual income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 8.00 Lakh.
  - ii The Waiver is limited to the Tuition Fee as approved by the State Level Fee Committee for Self Financing Institutions and by the Government for the Government/ Government aided Institutions. All other Fees except Tuition Fee shall have to be paid by the beneficiary.

#### d. Admission Procedure

- i Under this Scheme, up to a maximum of 5% of "Approved Intake" per Course shall be available for this admission. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature. These supernumer ary seats shall be available only to such Course(s) in an Institution, where a minimum of 50% of "Approved Intake" are filled up in the last Academic year.
- ii The Competent Authority to effect this admission is the State Government/ UT or its designated authority.
- iii In the event of non-availability of students in this category, the same shall not be given to any other category of candidates.
- iv The State Admission Authority shall invite applications under this category; make a separate merit list for this category and effect admission on the basis of the merit list so generated.
- v The Institutions shall publish all the details of this scheme in their Brochure and Web site.

- vi Competent Authority for admission shall submit a separate list of the students admitted under this category to the Institution to which they are admitted for compliance.
- vii A letter in this respect shall be issued by the Competent Authority for admission to each beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and he/ she shall not be allowed to change the Institution/ Course under any circumstances.
- viii The Institutions shall also display information regarding admitted candidates on their Web site for information to the students and other stakeholders.
- 6.43 Supernumerary seats for the Union Territories J&K and Ladakh under Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan Yojana (PM-USPY)
  - a. This scheme shall be applicable to selected approved Technical Institutions having NIRF ranking and offering Bachelor Programme(s). Diploma holders in Engineering are eligible for Lateral Entry under the provisions of these Programme(s).
  - b. 2 seats per Course shall be available for these admission with the maximum of 10 seats per Institution. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature and shall be available to such Course(s) in an Institution.
  - c. The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institutions approved by the Council subject to the changes suggested by the Inter-Ministerial Committee of MoE from time to time.
  - d. Requirements and Eligibility
    - i All students of J&K and Ladakh are eligible for seats under this scheme.
    - ii The student passed Higher Secondary Examination (12th Std.) from the schools located in J&K and Ladakh.
    - iii Student's parents annual income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 8.00 Lakh.
  - e. Admission Procedure
    - i. AICTE shall invite applications under this category, make a separate merit list for this category and effect admission based on the merit list as generated through Counselling or otherwise as decided from time to time.
    - ii. In the event of non-availability of students in this category, the same shall not be given to any other category of Applicants.
    - iii. A letter in this respect shall be issued by the Competent Authority for admission to each beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and he/ she shall not be allowed to change the Institution/ Course under any circumstances without permission from AICTE.

### 6.44 Supernumerary seats for Gifted Children's

- a. This scheme shall be applicable to AICTE approved Technical Institutions offering Bachelor Programme(s) in Technical Courses.
- b. Two (2) seats per College/Institute shall be available for these admission. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.

- 2. In addition, foreign students admitted / sponsored by/ through the Ministry of Human Recourse Development (MHRD), Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) or any such other Government agency, for any course shall be admitted (over and above 15% quota).
- 3. Admission Schedule as per the Information Brochure 2022 of I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University Main Campus and Constituent Campuses.
- 4. For fee structure and detail on the number of seats in this category please refer to admission brochure.

- 6. For admission of Foreign Nationals / International candidates to different courses, the following rules shall apply.
