### About the Seminar

The one-day seminar on Exploring Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) with Special Reference to Sapt Sindhu aims to highlight the rich intellectual, cultural, and spiritual traditions of ancient India, particularly the Punjab region. It examines the evolution of knowledge from the Vedic period to medieval and modern times, focusing on oral traditions, literary contributions, healing practices, and philosophical texts like the Vedas, Upanishads, Bhagavad Gita, and Guru Granth Sahib. The seminar seeks to challenge the dominance of Western educational frameworks by reviving interest in indigenous knowledge and fostering a dialogue between the past and present. Through expert discussions and research presentations, it will explore Punjab's historical significance as the cradle of the Indus Valley Civilization, its role in early education systems like Takshashila, and its continuing influence on Indian thought.
