- 2. Both bids (both Technical and Financial) should be uploaded on the E-procurement portal (https://eproc.punjab.gov.in). No manual bids will be accepted.
- Corrigendum and addendum (if any) will be uploaded only on E-procurement portal (https://eproc.punjab.gov.in) and/or IKGPTU website(www.ptu.ac.in). Bidders are advised to visit web page from time to time and update themselves.
- 4. The tender document fee, Tender Processing fee and E.M.D. should be deposited/Paid through online mode as per https://eproc.punjab.gov.insystem No other mode(s) will be accepted.
- 5. Bids must be submitted online through https://eproc.punjab.gov.in before the time specified in the table (as per system clock). Department/Service provider does not take any responsibility for the delay caused due to non-availability of internet connection or network traffic for online bids.
- Bidders shall upload scanned copy of all the papers i.e. proof of PAN Card, GST No. and other documents mentioned in the subsequent pages of tender document.
- 7. Uploaded documents of valid successful bidders may be verified with the original documents. The valid successful bidder has to provide the original documents to the concerned authority on receipt of such Communication from the University, which may be sent though registered post/e-mail.
- 8. Bidders are advised to start the uploading process will in time and not leave it to the last minute as the same may take time because of the data involved.
- If the date of opening of tenders happens to be a public holiday/holiday declared by the University, then the tenders will be opened on next working day at the same time and place.
- 10. IKGPTU reserves the right to cancel the tenders or postpone the tender and to accept/reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason(s) thereof.

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- 11. Bidders may note that they are liable to be disqualified at any time during tendering process in case any of the information furnished by them is not found to be true. EMD/Performance Security of such tenderer shall be forfeited. The decision of IKGPTU in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 12. The validity of the offer shall be 120 days after the date of opening of the tender. If any bidder withdraws tender within the validity period or does not start the work within stipulated period from the date of issue of letter of acceptance, then IKGPTU shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the earnest money deposited/Performance Security by the bidder. In case of forfeiture of EMD/Performance Security, the bidder shall be debarred from bidding in case of reinvitation of the tenders.

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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Parties: The parties to the Contract are the contractor (the bidder to whom the 1. work has been awarded) and I.K.GUJRAL PUNJAB TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY
- Addresses: For all purposes of the contract including arbitration there under, the 2. address of the contractor mentioned in the tender shall be final unless the contractor notifies a change of address by a separate letter sent by registered post with acknowledgement due to the Registrar I.K.GUJRAL PUNJAB TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY, Jalandhar-Kapurthala Highway, Kapurthala (PIN-144603), Punjab. The contractor shall be solely responsible for the consequences of any omission or error to notify change of address in the aforesaid manner.

Earnest Money: 3.

Earnest money Submit as per Punjab Government e-procurement online (https://eproc.punjab.gov.in). The earnest money so deposited shall not earn any interest. Tenders without earnest money will be outright rejected. The details of Earnest money is given as under:-

The approximately monthly wages bill is Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (Hundred Lakhs Only)* May vary as per the requirement also after tender.

- No request for transfer of any previous deposit of earnest money or security 3.2 deposit or payment of any pending bill held by the University in respect of any previous work will be entertained.
- Bidders shall not be permitted to withdraw their offer or modify the terms 3.3 and conditions thereof. In case the tenderer fails to observe and comply with the stipulations made herein or backs out after quoting the rates, the afore said bank guarantee/demand draft will be forfeited.
- The bidders without Earnest Money will be summarily rejected. 3.4
- A party who does not qualify technical bid its EMD will be returned after 3.5 completion of tender process.

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4. Signing of Tender:

Individual signing the tender or other documents connected with contract must specify whether he signs as:

- (a) A "sole proprietor" of the concern or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor.
- (b) A partner of the firm, if it be a partnership firm, in which case he must have authority to execute contracts on behalf of the firm and to refer to arbitration disputes concerning the business of the Partnership either by virtue of the partnership agreement or by a power of attorney duly executed by the partners of the firm.

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- (1) In case of partnership firms, a copy of the partnership agreement, or general power of attorney duly attested by a Notary Public should be furnished on stamped paper duly sworn of affirmed by all the partners admitting execution of the partnership agreement or the general power of attorney. A Self attested copy of the certificate of registration of firm should also be enclosed along with the tender.
- (2) In the case of partnership firms, where no authority to refer disputes concerning the business of partnership firm has been conferred on any parties, the tender and all other related documents must be signed by all partners of the firm.
- A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the tender on behalf of another person should have an authority to bid such other person and if, on enquiry it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, the University may without prejudice cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs, consequences and damages under the civil and criminal remedies available.
- (4) The tenderer should sign and affix his/his firm's stamp at each page of the tender and all its Annexure as the acceptance of the offer by the tenderer will be deemed as a contract and no separate formal contract will be drawn. NO PAGE SHOULD BE REMOVED/DETACHED FROM THIS TENDER DOCUMENT.

5. Technical and Financial Bid:

- b. Terms of payment as stated in the Tender Documents shall be final.

6. Validity of the Bids:

The bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days as indicated in "Notice inviting Tender "from the date of opening of the Technical Bid.

7. Criterion for Evaluation of Tender:

- **7.1** The evaluation of the tenders will be made first on the basis of technical information furnished in form given in **Technical Bid.**
- 7.2 The Financial bid of such firms found valid based on technical parameters/ technical evaluation stage will be opened on the date, time and venue to be announced after opening of the Technical Bid. The contractor who quoted the lowest service charges and fulfilling other conditions shall be considered for award of work. In case, the lowest rates quoted by two or more bidders will be same, then bidder having more average annual financial turn over in any three financial years (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and 2023-2024) will be considered for award of work.

BIDDERS TO NOTE THAT LOWEST SERVICE CHARGES QUOTED SHOULD NOT BE MORE THAN PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

8. Signing of the Contract:

The successful Bidder shall be required to execute the **Contract Agreement** accepting all terms and conditions (Including Bank Guarantee) stipulated herein on a non-judicial stamp paper worth ₹ 500/- (Rupees five Hundred only) within fifteen days from the issue of the **Letter of Acceptance of BID**. In the event of failure on the part of the successful Bidder to sign the **Contract** within the period stipulated above, the EMD shall be forfeited and the acceptance of BID shall be considered as cancelled.

9. Right of Acceptance:

- **9.1** The Registrar, I.K. GUJRAL PUNJAB TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY JALANDHAR, KAPURTHALA reserves all rights to reject all tender without assigning any reason.
- **9.2** Any failure on the part of the contractor to observe the prescribed procedure and any attempt to canvass for the work will prejudice the contractor's quotation.

10. Communication of Acceptance:

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Successful Tenderer will be informed of the acceptance of his tender.

11. Security Deposit:

11.1 The BID Security (EMD) of Rs 5 Lakh (Five Lakhs) of the successful bidder shall remain with IKGPTU as a Security Deposit and will be in force upto 3 month after completion of tender. However, the BID Security of Unsuccessful bidders/ parties will be released after completion of the tender process. No interest will be paid on the security deposit (EMD) amount by the University.

12 Bank Guarantee:

12.1 The Contractor may note that they have to submit a bank guarantee in the name of applicant firm and IKGPTU jointly of Rs. 1.00Crore as a security towards payable salary of the outsource staff. This bank Guarantee will be valid/in force upto 3 month after completion of tender.

13. Penalty:

- 13.1 In the event of the Contractor's failure to execute the work entrusted to it under this Agreement satisfactorily and the University shall have to make alternative arrangements to do it then the difference of cost incurred by the University thereby shall be recovered from the Contractor's unpaid bills and Contractor Bank Guarantee.
- 13.2 It is compulsory that wages have to disbursed to each and every employee upto 7th of every month whether upto two salary bills of the company is pending with university.
- 13.3 If the contractor fails to release the wages for the preceding month on or before 7th of every month then a penalty @ Rs. 5000/- per day for a week and Rs. 10,000/- per day thereafter will be imposed.
- 13.4 The powers of the Registrar, IKGPTU under these conditions shall in no way effect or prejudice the powers in certain events to terminate the contract vested in him as herein provided nor forfeiture of deposit mentioned under clause above.
- 13.5 Registrar reserves the right to levy a penalty, on a contractor found paying less than minimum wages prescribed by the Government of Punjab and wages decided by the University in such cases for which minimum wages are not prescribed by the government.

14. Breach of Terms and Conditions:

In case of breach of any of terms and conditions mentioned above, the Competent Authority will have the right to cancel the work order without assigning any reason thereof, and nothing will be payable by this University in that event and the security deposit in the form of Bank Guarantee/Demand Draft shall be encashed. In the event of the contractor becoming insolvent or going into liquidation, IKGPTU shall be

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entitled to treat such insolvency/ liquidation as a breach of contract from the moment it occurs.

15. Subletting of Work:

The firm shall not assign or sublet the work or any part of it to any other person or party.

16. The tender is nontransferable.

17. Terms of payment/ Payment of Contractor's Bill:

The payment of wages for the month shall be released by the contractor latest by 7th of every month and thereafter, the monthly bill shall be submitted in the University 100% of the total invoice value or admissible amount will be released by the first party in the following month provided the invoice/bill is accompanied by the proof of the following (Duly verified by CA):

- (i) Certified Attendance Sheet of month for which payment is claimed.
- (ii) Wages statement, copy of EPF challans, duly certified be submitted along with the bills submitted for the current month of payment & ESI statement showing individuals.
- (iii) Certified copy of the bank scroll showing disbursement of wages in individual accounts.
- (iv) Challans for depositing Provident Fund, ESI and other statutory deposits etc of the current month for which bills are submitted.
 - All payments will be subject to deduction of Income Tax at source as per Income Tax Act and as per Income Tax Rule.
- **18.1** No payment shall be made in advance nor any loan from any bank or financial institution shall be recommended on the basis of the order of award of work.
- 18.2 All payments shall be made by RTGS/Online etc.
- **18.3** Registrar, IKGPTU shall be at liberty to withhold any of the payments in full or in part subject to recovery of penalties mentioned in preceding paras.
- **18.4** The term "payment" mentioned in this para includes all types of payment due to the contractor arising on account of this contract excluding Earnest Money and Security Deposit governed by the separate clauses of the contract.
- **18.5** Wherever applicable all payments will be made as per terms and conditions stated in the tender.

19. Tentative scope of work

The Contractor shall provide the staff for as per requirement of the University in main campus of IKGPTU Kapurthala and its other campuses located in (Amritsar, Bhikhiwind, Batala, Mohali-I & Mohali-II, KhuniMajara, Sultanpur Lodhi, Hoshiarpur

IMajara, Sultanpur Lodni, Hoshi

and Sri Chamkaur Sahib etc.) and at any other place as per requirement of University in Punjab. The tentative requirements for manpower is about 440 persons in the following categories as Notified by Government of Punjab (Department of Labour) time to time following categories is as under:

Note: Any other appointment on fix wages will as per functional requirement with the approval of Vice Chancellor.

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The category and number of persons may vary to any extent at the time of placement of order or during operation of the contract as per requirement of the University.

20. Termination:

- 20.1 The University shall have power and authority to terminate this agreement by giving 30(thirty) days clear notice in writing in case of performance of the successful contractor is found Unsatisfactory during executions of the contract.
- 20.2 Similarly, if the contractor wants to rescind the contract, he/she is required to give at least 120 days' notice in writing for withdrawal of services and will not rescind the work till alternative arrangement is made by University, failing which performance security is liable to be forfeited.

Revision of rate: 21.

Effect of revision of State Minimum Wages as applicable with its pro rata effect as per revised circular of Office of the State Labour Commissioner from time to time will be considered subject to submission of application along with notification by the Contractor.

Taxes, Duties and Levies: 22.

All taxes, duties, levies etc. imposed by the State, Central Government and Local Bodies in connection with this contract in force at the time of submission of BIDs shall be borne by the Contractor and depositing the same with the Govt. shall be the sole responsibility of Contractor concerned.

Period of Contract: 23.

The contract shall be for a period of 02 years which can be renewed for a further period of Two years (01 +01 Year) on same rate, terms and conditions on the basis of satisfactory performance and mutual agreement.

Contractor's subordinate staff and their conduct: 24.

- **24.1** Whenever any of the Contractor's employee shall be found guilty of any misconduct or be incompetent or insufficiently qualified or negligent in the performance of their duties or that, it is undesirable for administrative or any other reason for such person/persons to be employed in the works, the Contractor if so directed / informed by the competent authority, shall remove such person/persons from employment. Any person/persons so removed from the works shall not again be employed in connection with the works without the written permission of the competent authority of University.
- **24.2** The Contractor shall be responsible for proper behavior of all the staff, employed directly or indirectly by him. The Contractors' personnel employed at IKGPTU Kapurthala shall not participate in any activity prejudicial to the interest of IKGPTU Kapurthala/ State/Govt. of India/or any Union Territory.

- 24.3 All Contractor's employees entering upon the University premises shall be properly identified by uniforms & badges of a type acceptable to the University which must be worn by them at all times during duty hours.
- 24.4 The Contractor shall furnish necessary certificate about police verification of character and antecedents of all the personnel to be engaged. He will be required to submit a copy of nominal roll post three months of the deployment.
- 24.5 In case of law and order problem created by any worker/staff, then the contractor shall take a necessary action to avoid any disturbance in the University.

25. Accident or injury to workmen:

The University shall not be liable for any damage or compensation payable in respect of or in consequence of any accident or injury to any workman or other person in the employment of the contract.

The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the University against all such damage and compensation whatsoever in respect or in relation thereto.

Workmen/staff should be insured against personnel accidents arising out of and in the course of their duties by the contractor at its own cost.

26. Damage to property:

The Contractor shall be responsible for making good to the satisfaction of the Officer in charge/Estate Officer any loss or any damage to all structures and properties within the University premises. If such loss or damage is due to fault and/or the negligence or willful acts or omission of the Contractor, his employees/staff, agents, representatives or he/she shall make good the loss as assessed by the University.

27. Jurisdiction:

The contract shall be governed by and executed according to the law in force in India. The Contractor shall hereby submit to the jurisdiction of the Courts situated at Kapurthala for the purpose of actions any proceedings arising out of the contract and the Courts at Kapurthala only will have the jurisdiction to hear and decide such actions and proceedings.

28. Arbitration:

Any claim, dispute or difference relating to or arising out of this tender shall be referred to the Arbitration, of a sole arbitrator. The arbitration shall be subject to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as may be amended from time to time. IKGPTU will appoint the Sole Arbitration and will conduct the Arbitration in

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accordance with its rules for conduct of Arbitration proceedings then in force and applicable to the proceeding. The seat and venue of arbitration shall be decided by IKGPTU. The proceedings shall be undertaken in English. The arbitration award shall be final and binding on the parties.

29. GENERAL RULES:

- a. Smoking and consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substance within the entire area of the Institute is strictly prohibited. Violations of this rule shall be dealt with as per the law and **defaulter** will be discharged immediately.
- b. The Contractor employee will NOT indulge in political activities within campus premises.
- c. The Contractor employees will not seek any personal favours from IKGPTU Kapurthala and its constitutes campuses staff or management or students.
- d. Lending and borrowing is strictly prohibited.
- e. Sitting idle or in groups is strictly prohibited during working hours.
- f. Two ways communication with IKGPTU Kapurthala and Contractor will be through single point of contact (SPOC). The SPOC will be nominated by designation in the form of Escalation Matrix by the Contractor.

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TENDER FOR MANPOWER SERVICES GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Canvassing in connection with the tenders is prohibited and the tenders submitted by the Contractor who resort to canvassing are liable for rejection.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for all his/her employees in observing security and safety regulations and instructions as may be issued by the University from time to time.
- The Contractor shall employee only adult trained, efficient and responsible staff with good health and sound mind for relevant services. The workers should not be below 18 years and above 60 years of age.
- 4. The Contractor shall provide Identity-cards to its staff and in case of any change of staff, the Officer in-charge should be informed in advance.
- The contractor shall be responsible for maintaining the decorum of IKGPTU
 Kapurthala in main campus and its constitutes campuses upkeep and maintenance
 of premises, punctuality, discipline and work output.
- 6. The University premises are the property of the University and the Contractor is only permitted to manage the premises as long the Contract remains valid. Whenever the contract is terminated or the contract is concluded and the University decides that the Contractor should not be allowed to run the service, the University will be entitled to restrain the Contractor from entering the campus.
- 7. Reservation policy of Punjab Welfare Department be implemented for the appointment of staff.
- Contractor shall follow Punjab Civil services (General and common conditions of services) rules, 1994 by which every outsource staff compulsory to pass at least Punjabi language upto the metric level.
- 9. The number and category of persons required is tentative and may vary from time to time as per needs. IKGPTU Kapurthala reserves the right to reduce or increase the manpower, if considered necessary. In either case the contract amount payable to the Contractor shall stand modified under the Contract on pro-rata basis.
- Manpower shall be deployed on the basis of test as per the posts categorized. ie typing (Punjabi & English), drafting test for the post of clerk, skill test for the post of Attendant/ Helper, driving test for the post of drivers, trade test for technical categories and where test is not required, the credential of the individual deployed shall be taken into consideration by the contractor.
- 11. The Contractor shall maintain the Minimum Wages as per Punjab Govt. and in the tender application the categories of the staff to be engaged should be specified. The Contractor will make payment to his staff engaged in the University as per the minimum wages rates for these categories, as specified from time to time by the Labour Commissioner and follow the Contract Labour Act, 1970 and Rules 1971 in this respect. The categories which minimum wages are not prescribed by the Government, the staff deputed in these categories will be given annual enhancement @2%per annum of last wage. However, higher wages with the permission of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor may be given to outsourced staff.

- 12. After releasing of monthly wages to the deployed staff soft copy in excel format for each employee be provided along with the monthly wage bill.
- 13. Bonus will be disbursed to the deployed staff every years as per Govt, Norms.
- 14. Where ever and when ever staff will be required on daily wages, be provided by the manpower supply contactor.
- Dues of the concerned staff will not be cleared till the time No dues certificate of the concerned staff from his parent department will not be submitted.
- The Contractor's staff shall not be treated as the University staff for any purpose whatsoever. The Contractor shall be responsible for strict compliance of all statutory provisions of relevant labour laws applicable from time to time in carrying out the above job. The University shall not be liable, to any penalty under relevant rules, enactment or related regulations for which Contractor is responsible under the law.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for fulfilling the requirements of all statutory provisions of relevant enactments viz. Minimum Wages Act, Payment of Wages Act, Industrial Disputes Act, Gratuity Act, Contract Labour Act and all other labour and industrial enactment at his own risk and cost in respect of all staff employed by him and keep the university indemnified for any action brought against it for any violation/noncompliance of any of the provisions of any of the Acts/Rules/ Regulations etc. The Contractor will abide by all the rules and regulations of the labour laws and rules framed there under and maintain all the Registers and display notices as required under the above mentioned Acts /rules and regulations and the Registrar or his authorized representative shall be entitled to inspect all such records at any time.
- The contractor will also ensure statutory compliance of the Acts/Rules and Regulations framed by the Government of Punjab including Reservation Policy, as applicable.
 - 19. The Contractor shall disburse the wages to the workers latest by 7th day of every month through cheque/bank transfer and subsequently raise the bill for reimbursement which will be verified on the basis of attendance by the In charge concerned and the actual amount disbursed etc. Non-payment of wages by due date and any malpractice if noticed, will invite a penalty which may lead to termination of contract & blacklisting of the firm or any other decision deemed fit by the Competent Authority. The Contractor will also be liable to pay the disputed outstanding amount. The University shall not be directly responsible for the payment of wages to the employees. It will be the responsibility of the Contractor to make regular payment to the workers engaged by him as per the State's minimum wages.
 - 20. The Contractor will provide salary slips to all the outsource employees.
 - The Contractor shall in no case pay its employees less than the minimum mandatory rates as specified by the State Authority per month. The payment should be made by cheque or e-transfer and a record of that should be kept in a register which may be examined by the University at any time. In case the Contractor fails to make timely payments to its employees, or any employee of the Contractor reports to the University regarding non-payment of dues, the University on being satisfied of the complaint shall pay the employees of the Contractor

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directly and suitable deductions shall be made from the amount to be paid to the Contractor. In case of EPF, the Contractor shall produce original challans/ receipts along with the scroll of the employees, whose_EPF stands deposited by the Contractor duly verified by CA to the Registrar of the University for Reimbursement.

- 22. The contractor shall submit ESIC and EPF challan along with the outsource staff deduction detail in excel format exclusively for the IKGPTU.
- 23. The Contractor must have registered/Branch office at Jalandhar or Kapurthala.
- 24. Bidder should have Training facility infrastructure and capability to trained manpower on/in site with a dedicated training officer along with a full–fielded certificate training center that is fully owned by service provider with infrastructure that spans extensive training room and other requirements. Documentary evidence to be submitted.
- 25. The contractor provider should not assign or pass or sub contract the services to any other contractor.
- 24. The Contractor shall submit their firm Labour License within 60 days after award of work, if applicable.
- 25. The contractor himself or his representative shall remain available all the time for solving any grievance and shall be answer able to the authorities of the University for which he has to earmark a dedicated resource at own cost in IKGPTU Kapurthala Campus.
- 26. None of the employees of the Contractor shall enter into any kind of private work at any locations of the University and its constituent campuses.
- 27. The Contractor shall take day-to-day instructions from the authorized Officer-incharge of the University or his/her deputy in his/her absence.
- 28. The employees of this University and their near relatives (meaning wife/ husband, parents, grandparents, children, brothers, sisters, cousins and their corresponding in- law) shall not be permitted to submit the tender. If such case is observed the BID is liable for rejection.
- 29. The Contractor shall provide online attendance system for their employees with the control of HR Department.
- 30. Appointed outsource employees can be deployed anywhere in the department/campuses by the University.
- 31. Only qualified (As per eligibility) employee shall be appointed by the outsource contractor.
- 32. Salary will be made on the basis of online attendance only.
- 33. Age of retirement will be 60 year.
