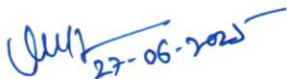

**2. Learn and Improve:** Find time with your assigned mentor and improve your solution with their feedback.

**3. Final Submission:** Submit the final solution (presentation and 5 mins demo video) in response to the email from Material POC.

This submission will be the basis for shortlisting the finalists.

**4. Final Presentations:** If selected, your team will be presenting your solution in the final round which will be conducted in the Material Gurgaon office.

## Presentations & Evaluation:

The finalist teams will present their solution to the jury while also giving a demo.

Every finalist team will have 20 mins:

- 5.** Presentation – 5 mins
- 6.** Demo – 10 mins
- 7.** Q&A – 5 mins

## Evaluation Criteria

- Impact on People/Planet/Productivity (35%) — Potential benefit and reach of the solution.
- Innovation (25%) — Originality of idea and technical creativity.
- Feasibility & Scalability (20%) — Practicality and growth potential.
- Responsible AI & Ethics (10%) — Adherence to ethical AI guidelines.
- Presentation & Technical Excellence (10%) — Clarity of demo and code quality.

## Deliverables

- Working Prototype — Functional demo of the solution.
- Technical Documentation — Architecture details and key technologies used.
- Impact Statement — Evidence or projection of social/environmental benefit.

- Mentor office hours with our Tech experts.
